From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box, **EVEN IF HE IS ALREADY A LEVEL TWELVE STAR ALREADY**, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick **EVEN IF HE IS ALREADY A LEVEL TWELVE STAR ALREADY**. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM if there is a problem!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

**In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item.** However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

**LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!**

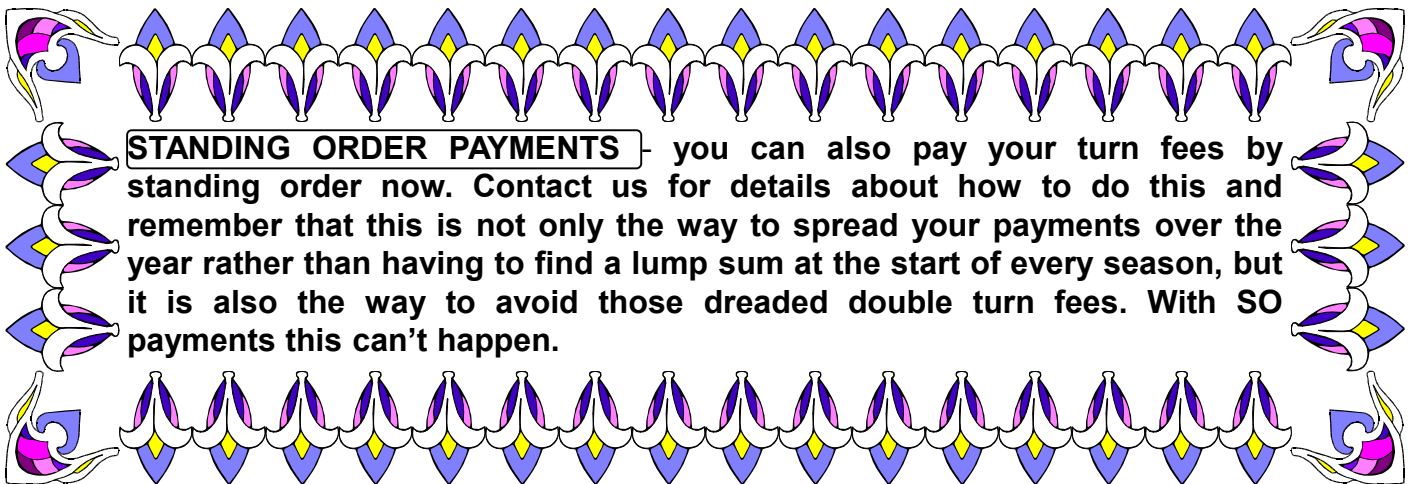
## CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

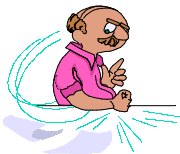
## THE KICKABOUT COMMUNITY

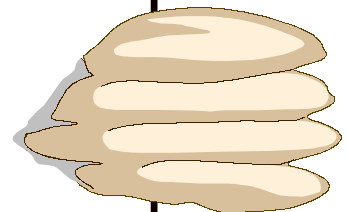
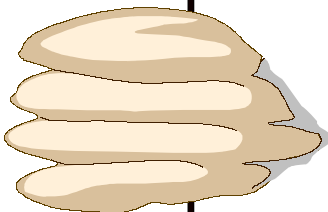

are substitutes, it only recognises  
them when discovered in a

then if you play the sub in a  
competitive game with out  
discovering him there it will be  
ignored as he doesn't exist in reality



# THE WADDERS ADVICE CENTRE

**FRIENDLY GAMES** - If you do not have **THREE OR MORE** competitive games in a session then you can play a friendly game against another managed team in the league. You have to arrange this yourself or if there is a friendly pool and you are in it, there will generally be a game arranged for you. You may only play another team twice during the season in friendly games, one home and one away, any more and they will not be played. Try to remember games that you have arranged outside the pool, you'd be amazed how many people arrange them and then forget them or get something wrong, like the venue!!!! Pool games should always be played if valid, i.e. both teams are free to play and do not have three competitive games (with the new autoinput programs though there are occasions when it might not be possible and I'm afraid you'll have to accept this!). If for some reason you realise that your pool opp has three competitive games (and you ought always to check this for sure) then you may well arrange another game. However, **BOTH** you and your new opponent **MUST** put this down in the Messages to GM section of the turn sheet to let the GM know, otherwise he is likely to try to play the original pool friendly, which of course will come up as an invalid one, and you'll both lose out!!!

**AUCTIONS** via the auction you can strengthen your squad, if you have the cash, or raise cash for your team by selling off unwanted players. Remember though that if you go into debt then you pay interest to the bank on what you are, in effect, borrowing, and that this increases the more that you owe to the bank. Also, having lots of cash in the bank might help your managerial rating, but cash in the bank does not win matches for you. Best to strike a healthy balance, you want money to buy that player who will complete your team, but paying millions in interest does, in effect, mean that you are playing without that same player as the money goes to the bank rather than strengthening your side.

Many managers find it difficult at first in working out where to pitch your bids. Perhaps the best thing to do for a new manager is to go back through past newsletters, as there is plenty of info there to let you gauge what players are worth and what managers are paying for them in any particular league. Paying over the odds happens at times and isn't a good thing so the more info at your fingertips the better.

When you put players into what is called the Rolling Auction, i.e. you put a player up for sale to the rest of the league, there is a minimum level, depending upon the session, that they must be. This is advised in the auction section of the newsletter. However, this doesn't apply to APPS/ SBYS to any player of a specialist nature. The reason for this is basically because low-level, rubbishy players don't sell and just clog up the auctions whereas there is always somebody who will have a punt on a specialist player.

Remember too that players entered in the auction remain there for three sessions and then disappear. While in the auction you can still play them and do all the things to them that you would normally do (don't train them will you!!!). Sometimes this could mean they will rise a level, which is a nice bonus for the buying player. You cannot withdraw them for this or any reason, nor can you change the reserve that you place on them. SO be careful.

The reserve should be carefully thought out. You **CANNOT** change it whilst the player is in the rolling auction, even if you subsequently realise that nobody is going to buy the player at that price. He stays at that reserve until he is withdrawn from the auction. On withdrawal he stays in your squad as a normal player, though if for some reason he has become a lower level than the minimum he can be sold automatically to the non-league so be careful, especially if he is a specialist and remember that MF specialists are only treated if they are an ordinary MF for this and many purposes, i.e. a level 4 MF is the same as a MF/A/D.

One final thought on transfers here. It is up to managers to decide how much they pay for another player when they are dealing with managers. However, the GM is eternally vigilant that is for sure and if a transfer appears in some way dodgy (i.e. somebody paying over the odds for some reason, a great player being given away for peanuts, etc., ), then it will be disavowed. Honesty is the watchword here and the GM is the final arbiter. Also, there are no such things as loans, buy now play later or transfers that are completed over more than one session, it is always now or NEVER!!
