WHAT A TURNABOUT

STALIN CITY have been turning the heat up winning games while others falter and were aware that this set of games could be crucial. A Derby match against second place SEASIDE TOWN gave them the opportunity to pull away but they were thoroughly outplayed by their opponents who played with confidence and style showing the home fans that winners are constant and consistent. STALIN lined up with an attacking 2-4-4 but were hit by the 3-5-2 formation of their opponents who really grabbed the midfield snuffing out a lot of STALINS attacking intent. With good marking from both sides it came down to moments of individual quality and ESPOSITO was almost unplayable for SEASIDE evading his marker and finding space all around the pitch. He ended with a hat-trick as SEASIDE cruised to victory and closed the gap. STALIN knew they had to get a result in their second game but despite out shooting WRAITH they found themselves on the end of a 2-1 defeat with UMLAZIs magnificent half-volley flying in and despite rushing forward found them up against the old granite WRAITH who gladly take the points. No points for STALIN who now know that if SEASIDE win their game in hand they will take over at the top but as LAWTON says there are many points still to be won or lost. HAILS knew that it was vital for SEASIDE TOWN to back up that win and were convincing winners away at PLUTO PIRATES in what could be the LEAGUE Cup Final in a few weeks. It was that man ESPOSITO again who muscled in from close range and then chipped the keeper for his second to finish with 2 from the final 4-0 and SEASIDES confidence and belief continues to grow. Manager ENGSLEV will be pleased with the 6 point haul from his MIDGARD VIKINGS side this week. They dominated the midfield and were looking comfortable after COLLINS close range finish gave them the lead. SUTTON pushed NEW LORDS forward but a late challenge from FORGE saw him red-carded and MIDGARD were able to hold on without breaking a sweat. In their second match they were faced with a normally attack minded AQUALINA playing defensively and matching the 3-5-2 formation of the home side. In a game of few chances it was always going to be one goal that settled this and when TROON glanced a corner into the top corner you sensed that was game over. ENGSLEV happy and pushing hard for a European spot. AQUALINA had employed the same tactics at home to WRAITH and were very happy to hold out for a draw while HUMPHRIES declared himself frustrated but at least it was one point closer to STALIN. ESCHTERGOM have made themselves competitive this year and manager MANSELL declared himself satisfied with his sides 4 point haul this week. DE SANTOS was the star of the first match hitting 4 in 15 minutes to swamp beleaguered PSV BARKING. 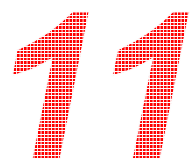

COMICS were determined to kick on again in their second match and were faced by an unconfident LILYPUTT side who were playing young ZAYN in goal and he was faced with waves of attacks from the off. BOUCHE opened the scoring after 8 minutes and then COMICS continued to score with LILYPUTT dropping further and further back to protect the keeper but ending up letting in

LILYPUTT were not expecting much here but would have been much more worried in the manner of their other defeat as 3rd bottom FOREVER UTD gave them a footballing lesson. The Derby encounter was one sided with HUDSONS boys first to the ball and faster and stronger in all areas. They raced into a 4-0 lead with MASAI MARAs second and frustrations boiled over as TRUFFLE punched the goal-scorer as he jogged back to the kick-off and was given a straight red. With no way back the game was played at a snails pace and LILYPUTT and MINZER need to believe that they are being dragged into a relegation battle. Biggest smile of the day saw MILLERS BORDERS turn recent form on its head to pick up a very welcome 4 points in their relegation battle. A first game away at CANARINHO saw them under the cosh for long periods with the home fans expecting the victory when SOCRATES put them one up after the break. BORDERS however dug in and KULTURNY produced a sublime chip over the keeper to equalise and then his team-mates scrapped and snarled their way to a point. At home to powerful ROCKODROMO nobody expected anything but were heartened to see untried PUMPIDO in the visitors goal. EVERTON had shown a lot of steel in their derby encounter with SILENT RUNNINGS but were defeated when BOCHCO arrived late to head in at the far post. SILENT are moving quickly into contention and added another 3 points with a good win away to FOREVER UTD. The frozen pitch made good football impossible but SILENT and manager ABRAHAM showed they can scrap as well with BOUDICAs neat finish enough to get the win to move them into the promotion places more of this please say the fans. Another side to have an excellent week are YOUNG LIONS who easily dispatch bottom club CASTLE DULOC 5-1 at home and follow this with a good win at home to the dour CANARINHO. The away side took the lead through GERRARD but STEVENS had a nice balance to the team today and they continued to make chances 3 goals in quick succession the best being OKOCHAS 25 yard strike was enough to see the LIONS creep to the edge of promotion can they show pride and roar some more. CONCORDIANS made it a good session for BREZNITZ with a comfortable home win against unmanaged CASTLE DULOC with young forward ROB doing his confidence a world of good by netting his first hat-trick.

CHASERS PUT IN PLACE

Having put the young MOORE in his place last week NEW CATTON were looking to stretch their advantage at the top of the division this week. In their first game they faced CRANFIELDS RANGERS 68 who have been slowly developing their squad over the season but were faced with 3 of their squad out with injuries. FRASERBURGHGS 1st minute 20 yard drive gave NEW CATTON the lead but despite buzzing around the goal for the rest of the game the valiant rear-guard of RANGERS kept the score down with ANDERSEN in goal having a terrific game. Their second match was the banker of the day as TURIN TIGERS limped into town and with SMOODGE hitting a brace and STARK helping himself to a hat-trick it was an easy 7-1 home win that give the leaders a maximum of 6 points. With CRANFIELD still missing two key players

they played 5 in midfield to try to dictate the pace of the game and chances were few and far between but it was that man O'REILLY again who found himself unmarked in the 6 yard area to finish from close range for the second win of the week and allow the fans to believe in their new manager. BALAMBANs caretaker manager was delighted with the 0-0 result at home to the demoralised READIEONIANS and then produced a bigger shock by beating the promotion hopefuls CEREAL KILLERS by 2-1 to finish a very miserable week for them. BALAMBAN rely on being solid and it certainly paid off this week. In the final game of the session PRESLAND asked for a response and was satisfied as his side despatched OAKLEY RANGERS by 4-0 with Forward WALTER hitting a brace to put him on 6 for the season and APPLEJACK still believing they can chase the top 3 down..

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

also, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

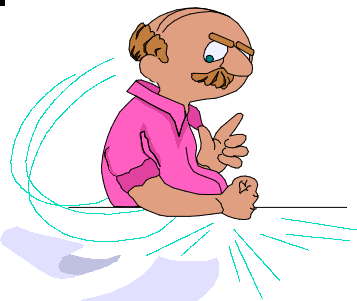

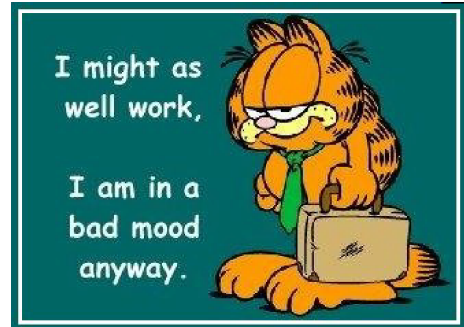
