



LEAGUE CUP FINAL

AH NON, MON SHERI!

BUGMAN RANGERS 4:0 THOMOSLAVIA UTD

A crowd of over 65,000 packed into a cold and damp Wembley for this first final of the season, with **Bugman Rangers** lining up against **Thomoslavia Utd**, but sadly, in some ways, the game was decided even before the first whistle went. This final just came too early for manager Thommo, as Thomoslavia came into this one missing two key players, SHERISSON in goal, and powerhouse DAVOS LECHEROIU in the middle of the park. With that in mind, Thomoslavia were ordered to funnel back to defend young SHERI in goal, while also having instructions to pile forward in search of goals when possible. Bugman, meanwhile, despite having STRIDER hanging back in the sweeper role, were given slightly more freedom to attack. Which they did with great aplomb, MCALLISTER having a great game with two stunning goals, either side of KEFLAVIK's scrambled finish. 3-0 at half-time and more or less all over, Thompson did manage to stir his charges to compete for a while, before KNIGHT's speculative effort took a cruel deflection off HAMBURG's back before nestling in the bottom corner, with SHERI well beaten. 4-0 it finished, much to Ashcroft's delight, knowing European football is secured again, and with another cup final to come as well.

ACKWORTH AT LAST

Where else to start but at Fothergill Park where perennial strugglers **Ackworth** managed to notch up their first win of the season over Dag's **Nacional**. It is too much for Ackworth to save themselves from relegation, but at least the fans might start to see a glimmer of hope at the end of the long, dark tunnel. Moore lined his men up in an adaptive formation, ready to rally to any part of the pitch where they were needed, while the visitors had two banks of four men, missing the influential CHUN MAD from the middle of the park, and looking to close down Ackworth when they could.

The first half was a nervy affair, very few chances, even less of them being accurate, but Nacional probably just about edged it. This proved to be the case early in the second half, when QUARESMA found himself half a yard of space in the box following a corner, and poked the ball home from three yards. The visiting fans thought from there that their team would go on and win comfortably, but it wasn't to be. Just 7 minutes later, REISER

strode forward and crashed home his first goal of the season, much to manager MOORE's delight, and his own disbelief. Even better was to come though as the game looked to be heading for a draw, when fan's favourite LLANGEWYDD got on to the end of a long ball and fired into the top corner for an 89th minute winner. That knocked the stuffing out of Nacional who spent the last minute chasing shadows as the men from Ackworth played keep-ball, desperate not to lose. Congratulations to them for a first win, and on this display, it looks like Nacional will be joining them in division 2 next season. **CFC Santos** are only two points above them, but do have a game in hand, and seem to be playing with more fight and more desire at this stage, but we will see. It may all come down to the final game of the season when the two teams face each other.

CHANGE AT BOTH ENDS?

Dumnonia City are away and clear at the top of division two, with only **Yorkshire Rams** able, but extremely unlikely, to catch them. The Rams

cemented their own promotion this week, playing a double header against fellow promotion hopefuls **FC United Boys**, and coming away with a six-point haul. The first game was tense, Yorkshire at home, and seemingly comfortable after LURSEN's early strike, until HERFORDER managed to get his feet mixed up, and sliced his clearance passed his own keeper to give the Boys hope. However, that hope was short lived as BROWN arrived in the 83rd minute to tap home after great work from BO WIN. That was how it finished - first blood to Yorkshire. The return game came along in midweek, a postponement from earlier in the season, and the Rams were ready again. Striker HERFORDER was desperate to make amends for his OG in the first match, and certainly filled his boots with a superb brace, scoring either side of the half-time interval. FC United Boys had only conceded 9 league goals before this, and were certainly given a lesson in these two games as they conceded two in each match.

Those defeats give both **Glasgow Celtic**, 2-1 winners over **Grafar Mill FC** and now level on points with the Boys, and **Anfield Rovers**, 3-0 winners over **AFC Broadway** and just a point further back, the chance to muscle in on the action. One from three, who will it be?

There is also change on the cards at the bottom as **Kirkdean Utd** continue on a great run. Off the bottom, and now climbing, they notched up a great win over fellow strugglers **Uranium Youth**, coming back from a goal down to score three times in the second half and take the points with a 3-1 win. With the quality of the likes of NEILO BADDIO and QUIZCRANS HOOP, both of whom scored today, they really should not be struggling, and are now beginning to look like safety is a real possibility, but have they left it too late?

That may depend on **Temple City**, who also picked up a win this week, 2-1 over local rivals **Limetrees Utd**. Both of these sides have the capability of making chances from nothing, and that was shown today. Limetrees were on top throughout, but MATETE and BONAPPETITE seized on half, no, quarter-chances and fired

home within minutes of each other just before half-time to give Temple City the points. There are some crunch matches to come at both ends of this table, and I think it will all go right to the wire!

MARX MEN ON THE CHARGE

The third division promotion race is looking like it will be a close finish with just five points now separating the top four teams. **Margate Beach** have long looked like they will claim the title, but uncertainty over recent weeks has led to a few stutters. Things are start to settle now, with the news of the appointment of a new manager in Kev 'KP' Presland looking to take them on to bigger and better things. KP was in the directors box for their match against **Crimson Kings** this week, joined at half-time by their opponents newly appointed manager Dave Hails. The two appointments arrived too late to affect this match, merely only able to watch on as the two teams ground out a 1-1 draw. Hails was late arriving, making the journey from Wansbeck Rovers, where he saluted the fans as a 5-0 victory signalled the end of his spell as interim manager there. Sadly for Hails, he missed all the excitement at Margate, as the goals came in a three minute spell half-way through the first half. BREXIT TUSK popped up to head home for the visitors, but DRAKE's brilliant volley levelled things up straight away. No more goals and not many chances left it all square, neither manager that happy, but not too disappointed either, as each prepare for the run-in.

Separating the two are the mean, mean **AFC Lowfields**, who were held to a gritty 0-0 draw by **Colour Athletic** this week. Lowfields do not concede many, and this might just stand them in good stead, as they have to play Margate Beach in the last two games of the season. The results of those matches will go a long way to determining the promotion places here. The fourth team involved are **Marx Men**, who are on a decent run of form at the moment, and are looking to upset the apple cart. Their four man forward line was too strong for **Denmrak Arsenal** this week, young forward LAKATUSH scoring twice to give them a



fine victory, and putting them just two points behind Crimson Kings. Denmrak's Dempsey is again looking over his shoulder, but the gap to **Crewe Alexandra** may just be big enough for them.

TIGHT AT THE TOP

Division Four is also looking close at the top, although current leaders **Rotorua Mist** are looking fairly safe for promotion, whether they can hold on to top spot may be up for debate though. This week they were up against the injury hit **Inter-Orlando**, who put up a bit of a fight, but Rotorua made it through unscathed. Even though this was a derby match, the home side played well within themselves, while Orlando's caretaker manager had sent them out with instructions to kick anything that moved. The home side did well to escape injury, and to score a goal into the bargain, with SHARP making the crucial difference after just 11 minutes. Another three points, another step closer to the title, a good day for manager Butler.

Just behind them come **Samdoria**, where Dag is transforming the team, and looking forward to a rapid rise through the divisions. Their opponents, **Warton Pirates**, are going through a transformation of their own, under the guiding hand of Danny Smith, and were worthy opponents today. The Pirates marking game worked well, holding Samdoria goalless until the last ten minutes, when concentration started to lapse slightly. First, HUMPHRIES managed to squeeze between two defenders to head home BERGE's cross, and then, four minutes from time, defender ODEGAARD found himself unmarked on the edge of the box and cracked home a vicious strike to seal the win.

Below them, it seems as though some managers enjoy the fourth division too much, and are wanting to stay longer, meaning that **Scarif Rangers**, while still in fifth, are maybe now finding themselves as the bookies favourites and in pole position for promotion, following their 2-1 win over **Connacht Celts**, though even **Grove Everton**, as low as 7th, could yet have a say in this race. Two late goals from SIDIOUS made the difference for Scarif, while

both **Fujian Pirates** and **Broughton Villa** were outclassed in their matches, both with some interesting team selections. No doubt the KFA will be watching closely as the remaining rounds of matches are played out.

Remember the transfer deadline comes into operation at the end of session thirteen ie NOW

ROLLING AUCTION LEVELS

The following are the minimum levels relating to each session for entering players into the rolling auction:-

<u>SESSIONS</u>	<u>MIN LEVEL</u>
1 to 3	5
4 to 5	6
6 to 8	7
9 to 10	8
11+	9

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

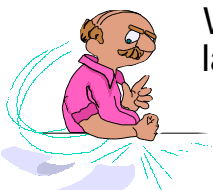

MARKING UPDATE



We have worked out a system to check on anybody who is using last season's marking numbers for the current season. Basically the program will save a list of all valid marking successes each session and if somebody cries foul, that he has been marked by somebody who hasn't scouted him, we can check and say yea or nay.

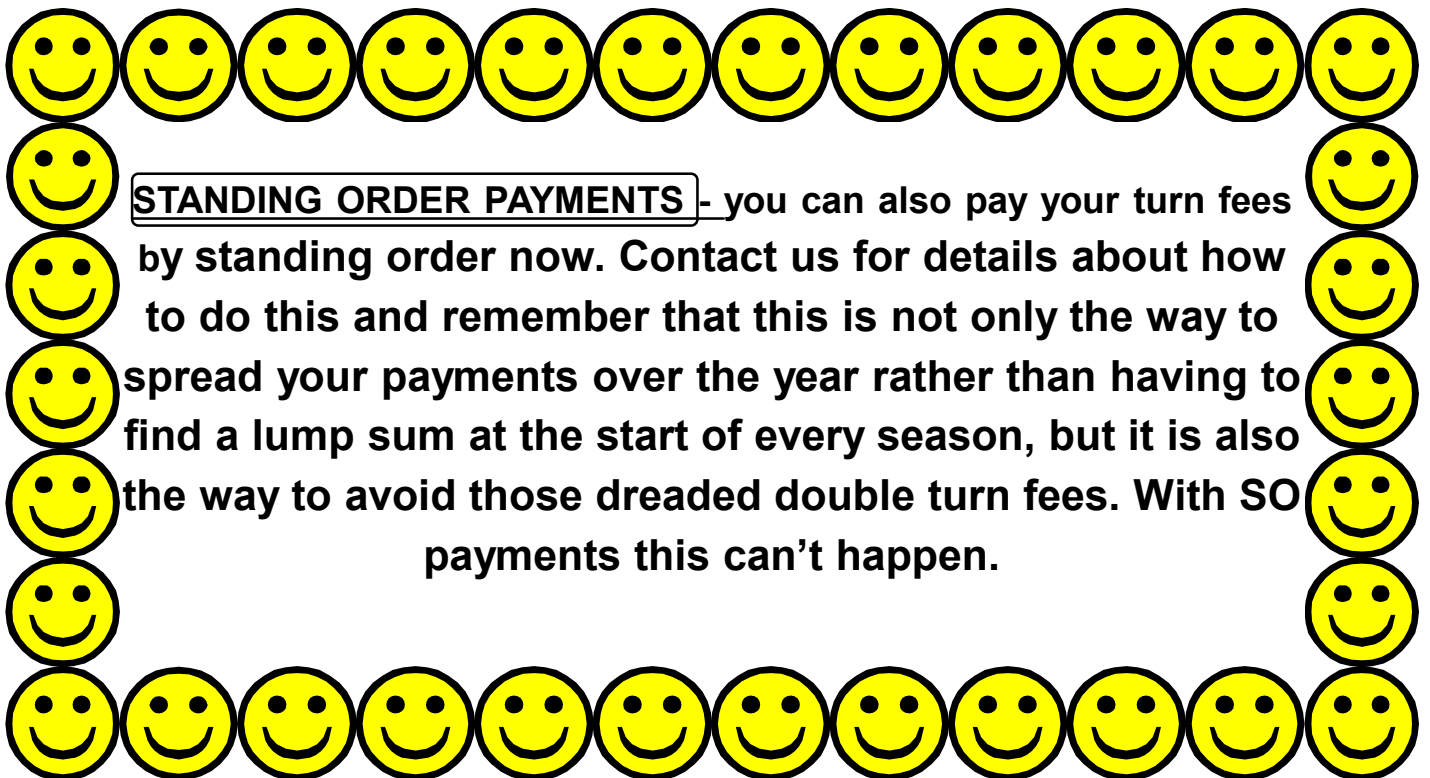

remember if you pay £59.50 at one time (which can cover more than one team) you get an extra free turn credited to your account. This offer does not include shomatch/weekend or special offers monies!



STANDING ORDER PAYMENTS - you can also pay your turn fees by standing order now. Contact us for details about how to do this and remember that this is not only the way to spread your payments over the year rather than having to find a lump sum at the start of every season, but it is also the way to avoid those dreaded double turn fees. With SO payments this can't happen.

PLEASE NOTE

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

I have some ideas about how to use this stat in the future so watch this space

KA MUSINGS & MEANDERINGS

As there are a number of leagues that will be starting a new season in the next three or four months perhaps it is time to point out the cardinal sin that often happens with a new season. That is discovering an app in your first game of the season AS A SUB and then trying to play him in the subsequent matches (this refers to teampick teams by the way). In effect if you discover somebody as a sub he doesn't actually exist and you HAVE to discover him in the normal fashion the first time you play him. If you don't get this right you incur wrong formations and NL fees, which will NOT be refunded so get it right
