



LEAGUE CUP FINAL

TOO DEFENSIVE

Laissez-Faire 1:1 Ameliehekeani

That is what the fans of **Laissez** thought after their league cup final against **Ameliehekeani** ended in a 1-1 draw. Their 3-5-2 had the better of the SW-2-5-2 of **Ameliehekeani**, but they struggled to make openings, whilst their opponents as always could rely on some individual brilliance to shine. **Manager McAuley** had done his homework, and the marking of **Nesbit** and **Zajackzkowski** went excellently, while the zonal marking employed by **Ameliehekeani** did help them reduce the advantage of **Laissez**. When **Purcell** got **Laissez** an early lead, already in the 3rd minute, things looked great for **manager McAuley**, but they failed to increase that lead, and when **Ameliehekeani** got the equaliser in the 63rd minute, it seemed to wipe away the belief from the **Laissez** players. Neither team really close to scoring after this, and all to do again next week.

GETTING VERY INTERESTING

As mentioned after the previous round of league games, the top four all still stood a chance of securing the league championship, and after this week it really have tightened up.

Top met 4th as **Putney** entertained **Ameliehekeani**, the hosts having to play with young **Nyland** at the back, as first choice **Montreaux** was out injured, and no decent cover for him in the team squad. The hosts lined up in their preferred 3-5-2, while manager Molloy sent his team out in their well tested SW-2-5-2. With **Stam** not finding his intended target where he was supposed to be, and **Milik** only doing a decent job on **Nesbit**, the zonal marking of **Ameliehekeani** were the one of the two marking options employed, that made the most impact. Dominating in the middle of the park, the visitors managed to create some fine openings, while the hosts did get an equal amount of chances from their dominance at both ends of the field. With the individual talent in the **Ameliehekeani** side, the teams ended up with approximately similar amount of chances resulting in a shot on the opposing goalie, and with **Nyland** at the back for **Putney**, and the reliable **Lindelof** down the other end, it doesn't take a genius to tell who the eventual winner of the match was. Six times **Nyland** had to pick the ball out of his own net, and that actually meant he almost saved half the shots at him, but those six goals were more than enough for **Ameliehekeani**, as **Lindelof** only conceded twice, to make the score 2-6. A flattering result, due to the goalie, but even with **Montreaux** at the back, I think **Ameliehekeani** can prove

a tough task when they meet in that postponed match at **Polynesia Road**.

Laissez-Faire eased to a well deserved 3-0 at home to **Flamengo RJ**, some great marking cementing their dominance in the match, and they are now only behind **Putney** on goals scored, both having the same goal difference. But ahead of both these teams, we now find **Skelmersdale**, after they cruised to an easy 5-1 win at **St Johns**. They are now at 43 points, one point ahead of **Putney** and **Laissez**, with **Ameliehekeani** 4th on 40 points. With that crucial home match for **Ameliehekeani** against **Putney**, postponed in the early stages of the season, it is now really totally open here. Who says postponed matches add nothing to the competition, at least when it comes to added excitement?

D.D.T. cement their place in the top half of the table, as they have no trouble at home to **Tudor**, and **Tudor** now look a good bet for relegation, as they have by far the worst goal difference of the three teams fighting it out for 9th place, and they are not helped one bit by their heavy defeat at **D.D.T.**, 8-1 it ended for the hosts. ***** With **Dow Crag Rovers** not getting anything at **Walton**, it is temporarily **Red Star** that climb up into that last secure spot, courtesy of more scored goals than **Dow**, as they somehow secure a point at **Wycombe**. This just lasted a few days though, as in mid-week **Dow** and **Red Star** met in a postponed match, and despite getting **Butcher** sent off early on, the hosts manage to get a just about deserved 1-0 win, to now put them three points clear of the relegation zone, with **Red Star** back down into it.

ALL DECIDED?

West London FC entertained the team in 3rd, **The Showboats**, and although they only got a narrow 1-0 win, they never were in danger of losing, and when they finally got their winner, it was thoroughly deserved. The hosts lined up in a 3-4-3, against the SW-3-3-3 of the visitors, and with excellent marking of **Ping Pong**, the too defensive **Showboats** had nothing on offer. Had **manager Barret** had more belief and played an open game, they might have had more joy here, as it was **manager Cranfield** that got all the joy, With this win, and results elsewhere, West London FC now have a four point lead, and do look likely winners of division 2.

Azalea Athletic have a mare of a match at **Royal Spurs**, as the hosts, in their 3-4-3, just blew them away, not taking their foot of the pedal before the scoreboard said 8-0! This result results in **Azalea** increasing their "against goals" column with 200%, and these sets of results leave **The Showboats**, despite their own loss, now ahead of **Azalea Athletic**, as their goal difference only suffered that single goal against, while **Azalea's** goal difference got totally destroyed from what it were, and their "meanest defence" bid in danger.

Royal Spurs also keep alive their faint hopes of promotion with that great win, leaving them four points of the teams in 2nd and 3rd, and at the same goal difference, while **Q of N** fail to take advantage of the results of those teams, as they only draw at **Sporting**. Both teams will probably still have to settle for a spot outside the top three, as **Azalea** and **The Showboats** both have a meeting with bottom team **System Lords** in the last weeks of the season, and with 3 points each from those matches, they will be close to securing their places. Big question though is what the management at **Azalea** want, as they did play a weakened team this week, was this a one off, or are they planning to forfeit promotion to continue strengthening in the 2nd division?

Walsall Swifts somehow manage to not win their match at **System Lords**, and they do now look likely to go down. They did play in a rather defence minded 3-4-3, and should surely have been more positive in their approach, against the bottom team. On another day they would probably still have gotten all three points, but in this one **Handerson** had decided to keep everything out, and made some very good saves to keep it 0-0. ***** **Kirkwood** got a very lucky point at **Zion Gardens**, and **Zions** still have work to do, as do **Sporting**, to stay above the relegation zone come

seasons end. In this match it was the 3-5-2 of **Zions** that had far the better of play, against the unorthodox SW-2-3-4 of **Kirkwood**. The visitors do manage to get some chances from individual brilliance, but it is the hosts that have much the better of play, and only a fine display from **Lindegaard** and **Tiger Shaw** keep it 0-0 here. The results for the teams in 8th to 11th leave them separated by four points, with **Sporting Stars** closest to securing survival, but they have to difficult away matches in their last three matches, and then a meeting with fellow strugglers **Walsall**.

ONE FROM SIX

That is how tight it is in the 3rd division, as apart from the top four and the already relegated **Crosspit Utd** and **Barnet F.C.** (although not completely relegated in theory), there is just three points covering the teams in 5th to 10th, and one of those six teams will end up getting relegated.

This week **Lang Gah** in 6th managed to get a 0-0 draw at home to 3rd placed **Southdown FC**, despite playing with young **Luxluxlux** at the back. The 3-3-4 of the visitors lacked the bite to take advantage of the untried goalie, not managing to get a single shot on target, down the other end the reliable **Barkley** had an equally quiet day, not having to make a single save. **Lang Gah** climb to 5th with their point, **Southdown** drop to 4th. ***** **Beruit** have a good week, as they go to **Barnet F.C.** and get a very easy win, their 3-5-2 having much the better of play against the 4-2-4 of the hosts. This especially as their midfield trash the two for the hosts, and they create chance after chance from this area, and despite **Padraicins** having a decent day between the sticks, the 3-0 win for **Beruit** not more than they deserved. The loss more or less securing relegation for the hosts, while **Beruit** climb from 8th to 6th, but are still far from safe. ***** **Sky Blue Fire** go the other way, as they drop from 5th to 7th, as their 3-3-4 are overrun in the midfield against the 3-5-2 of **Rustin Diamonds**, and the match end with a deserved 3-0 win for the hosts. **Rustin** climb above the relegation zone again, although only on goal difference, but still have work to do to stay ahead of the drop. ***** Between these two teams, in 8th, we find **Balderton FC**, this week going down one spot from 7th, after losing at home to **Terra Firma**. The 3-5-2 of **Balderton** would have benefitted from some kind of marking, as it was the attack of **Terra** had too much on offer, and they ran out deserved 2-0 winners. The win also brings **Terra** two points closer to the leaders, and with some help from **Bolton Tigers**, they can still catch



up with the leaders. ***** In 10th we find **Hatchend Heroes**. This week they got a very good point, drawing 0-0, at home to the leaders, and local rivals, **Univ. Nanterre**. Their 3-5-2 could even have been even better off here, had their management opted for some marking, but as it was, the 4-4-2 of the visitors still struggled to make many openings, and can't be too disappointed with the result. Next week **Hatchend** visit **Terra Firma**, can they do as well, or even better, in that match? Regardless of the result in that match they might still be the 3rd team going down, but there is no reason to not try their best and show their mettle.

WATH'S UP?

That is too soon to say, but at least **Wath Dearnesmen** did get a crucial win this week, as they entertained local rivals **Newark Celtic**, the team that started the week in 3rd. With the win they secured, **Wath** climbed above the visitors and up into 3rd spot, although only on goal difference. They do have a very tough task ahead of them if to keep their position in the top three, as they entertain the leaders in their last home match of the season. Before that they will also have to get a win at home to 6th placed **Newtown FC**, while **Newark Celtic** have two, at least on paper, much easier matches ahead, playing away at bottom team **Armani**, and then at home to **FC Barca**. In the match this week the hosts played in a 4-2-4, and against the SW-3-4-2 of the visitors, and as a result **Wath** had to build from the back, while the visitors dominated in the middle of the park. With **Forlan** really motivated it looked likely to end in a 0-0 draw, as down the other end **Baklava** and **Bonner** looked steady and reliable, but just on the hour mark **Polizei** got the only goal of the match, as he drifted in at the near post, and flicked a cross from **Gunter** into the net, for the winner.

Newtown FC also have a slight chance of overtaking the two teams in front of them, and this week got a 2-0 win at home to **Fenham Rovers**, their 3-3-4 just doing enough against the 3-5-2 of the visitors. I do not think the two teams ahead of them will drop enough points, but as long as there is hope there is no reason to not try. ***** **Puxi Pandas** probably had given up before their match this week, as they had to go to the leaders with a very weakened team, goalie **Cooper** having to sit the match out injured, and it ended in a 0-4 loss, to end any faint hopes of promotion. ***** Not really much to write about apart from this.

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

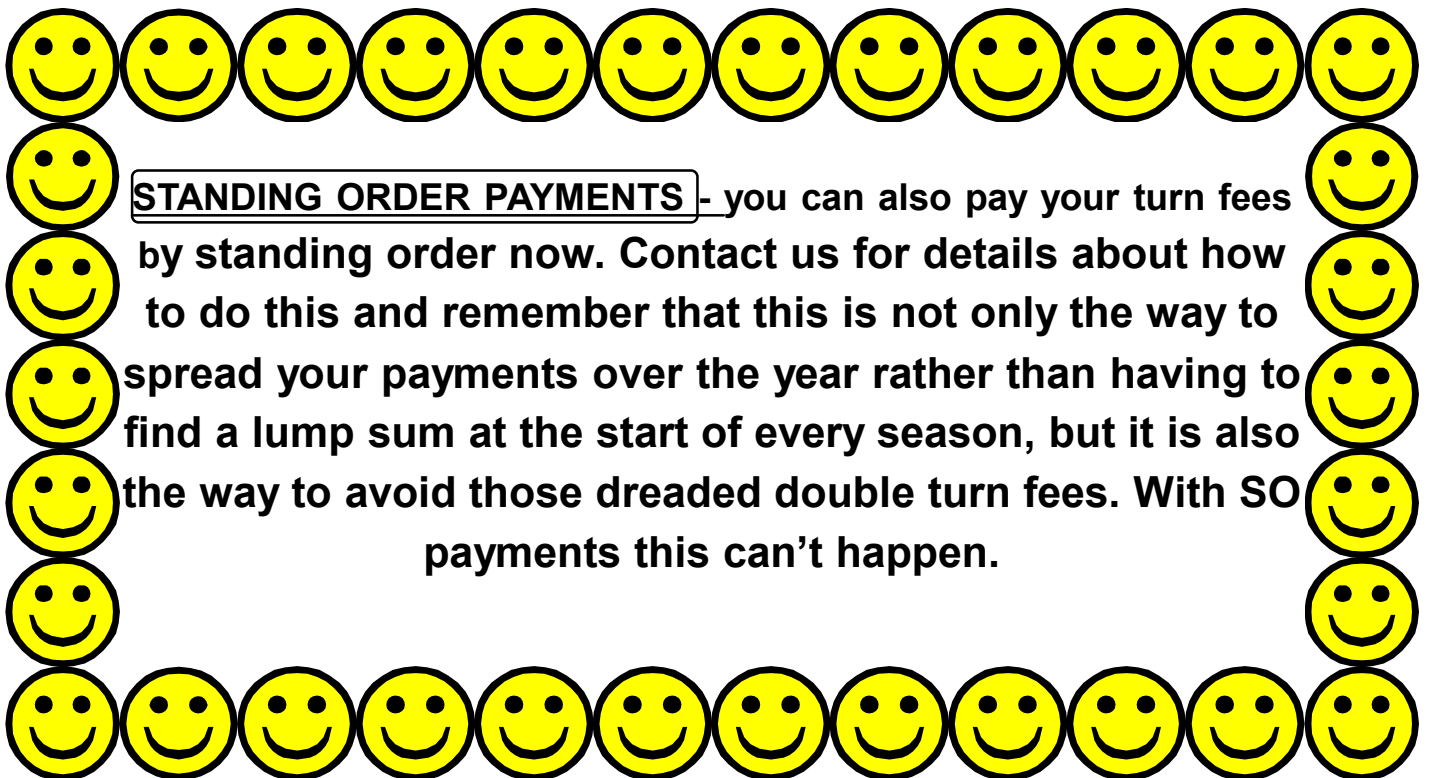

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

I have some ideas about how to use this stat in the future so watch this space
