



ALMOST THERE

Champions **Netherton FC** look as though they are going to hold onto their crown again this season, leading **Dore Utd** by three points going into the final round of matches, with only an unprecedented catastrophic result being able to prise the trophy away from them. Six points from two games this week leaves them clear, the first a routine derby drubbing of poor **Aliens Utd**, 5-0 it finished with QUAQQOV claiming the matchball and the plaudits with his wonderful hat-trick. That result was matched by Dore Utd who put **CFC Santos** to the sword and came away with a comfortable 3-0 victory. The second round of matches in midweek, was similar, Netherton notching a 2-0 win over **Elterwater Rvrs** with Dore Utd having the same score against Danetown FC. It has been Netherton and Dore all the way over the last few weeks, and they meet next week on Netherton's turf, and I can't really see Dore Utd making the 8-0 win they need to claim the title (sorry Craig!)

At the bottom there is still at least one relegation place to play for (or avoid!). **Ackworth** and Aliens Utd are both surely down, although they both have games in hand, leaving CFC Santos and **Nacional** battling it out to stay up. Santos struggled this week, going down 1-0 to Ackworth, who notched up only their second win of the season. At the same time, Nacional beat fading **Bugman** 1-0 to give themselves real hope of staying up now. For so long, they have looked like the team to drop, but now? This victory follows a goalless draw with **Northern Town**, 4 points putting them above Santos into 9th place. The two play next week, and Santos also have a game in hand, so who knows what will happen?

DUMNONIA DOWNER

Have the wheels come off at long time leaders **Dumnonia City**? This week, they only picked up one point from a possible six, as **Yorkshire Rams** closed the gap to just one point at the top. Could the Rams even still top spot away next week? In the first round of games, Dumnonia were held to a goalless draw by the brick wall of **FC United Boys**. The Boys were prepared to defend, which they did admirably to prevent Dumnonia from scoring at all. At the same time, Yorkshire Rams were winning 2-1 against **Uranium Youth**, though they did have to rely on a late BROWN strike to give them the victory. In the second round of matches the top two were pitched together, with the Rams coming out surprisingly as 3-0 winners. It was a fairly even game, the only weak link for the visiting City was in goal, where young MCSAMSON had to take the place of the injured BANQUES. He did what he could, but was no match for the guile of the

Yorkshire strikers, as FRED, HERFORD and NUELLAR scored to give the Rams the win. To make matters worse for Read, two of his top players were left nursing injuries, making his job next week even harder.

Coming into these two crucial matches at the end of the season, **AFC Lowfields** were looking in a strong position for promotion, in second place, three points clear of **Marx Men** in fourth. However,

Lowfields were missing two key players, and Mansell must have picked up on this, sending his charges out fired up, searching for victory. They were really the only team in it, their two goals just before half time being small reward for their dominance. LAKATUSH got the first, and then PASTEUR got his first for the club, giving a glimpse of a bright future to come. Meanwhile, Margate Beach were dismantling **Golf City** 9-0 to cement top spot, six different scorers on the scoresheet to put a big smile on KP's face. The managerial changes at the top of this division, rather than upsetting the clubs concerned, seem to have fired them on with greater determination, as manager Hails saw his new club **Crimson Kings** edge out his former club **Wansbeck Rovers** by 3-0 to stay well in the hunt.

In the second round of matches, Lowfields again went down, this time to a rampant Margate Beach in a derby encounter that saw five goals. It was all over by the time Lowfields got on the scoresheet with an 80th minute CONNAR penalty, as Margate were already 4-0 up and coasting then. BAROTELLI's 51st minute goal gave Crimson Kings the win over **Denmrak Arsenal**, while LAKATUSH's second goal of the week saw Marx Men defeat Wansbeck Rovers 1-0 to climb into third place above Lowfields. Lowfields are now three points behind Marx Men, but knowing that they have to play Margate Beach again will not give them any confidence of picking up those points. Marx Men have an eminently winnable match against **Colour Athletic** and so have probably done enough to go up to Division 2. Denmrak Arsenal look to have just about done enough to stay up now, as they maintain the three point lead over **Crewe Alexandra** with just the one match remaining.

WHO WANTS IT? ERR, NO-ONE

Rotorua Mist FC and **Samdoria** have sealed promotion from division four, as champions and runners-up. But behind them, who knows what will happen? Rotorua started off against the team I tipped last week as an outside bet for promotion, **Scarif Rangers**. However, this seems to have served simply to inspire Rotura to really show up for this one. Being fair to their opponents, first choice keeper SAVEITSSON was suspended, and STOPITSSON in his place was just not up to the challenge. He only managed to save one shot out of eight, so Rotorua won 7-0. Of the other contenders, **Fujian Pirates** continued their dubious team selections, no fewer than five reserves featuring, and went down 10-0 to Samdoria. **Broughton Villa** went down 2-0 against **Inter-Orlando** and **Connacht Celts** were held to a 0-0 draw by **Hyde Citizens**.

The second round saw some similar results, Broughton Villa losing 8-0 to **Warton Pirates** and Fujian Pirates going down 3-0 to Hyde Citizens, despite which, if they chose to, they could both get promotion next week! However, there were also some surprises. First up, Connacht Celts have now moved into the promotion spot courtesy of a 1-0 win over leaders Rotorua Mist. The result was a fair one, as Connachts midfielders had the room to get forward and support their three man front line, and were just too strong for the Mist. There was just the one goal in it, an 11th minute volley from POUNDER, his 25th of the season. Another surprise was the stunning 7-4 victory for Fun Fair FC against Samdoria. Fun Fair poured forward, using the long ball to good effect, bypassing Samdorias talented midfield time and again. SUNG-YOO set the tone as he ran forward straight from kick-off, picked up the long ball from RISE and cracked it home with just 27 seconds on the clock. Samdoria showed elements of their true strength, but with two players sitting this one out, they were always second best. Humphries showing glimmers of hope for better times ahead at the Fun Fair then.

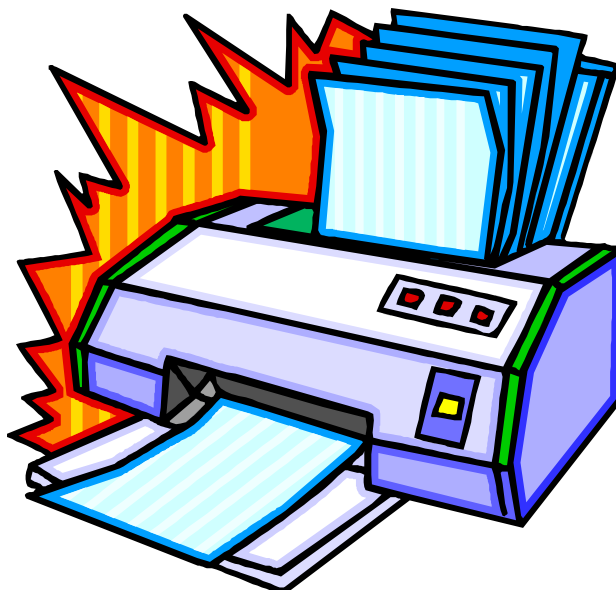

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

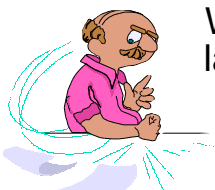

MARKING UPDATE

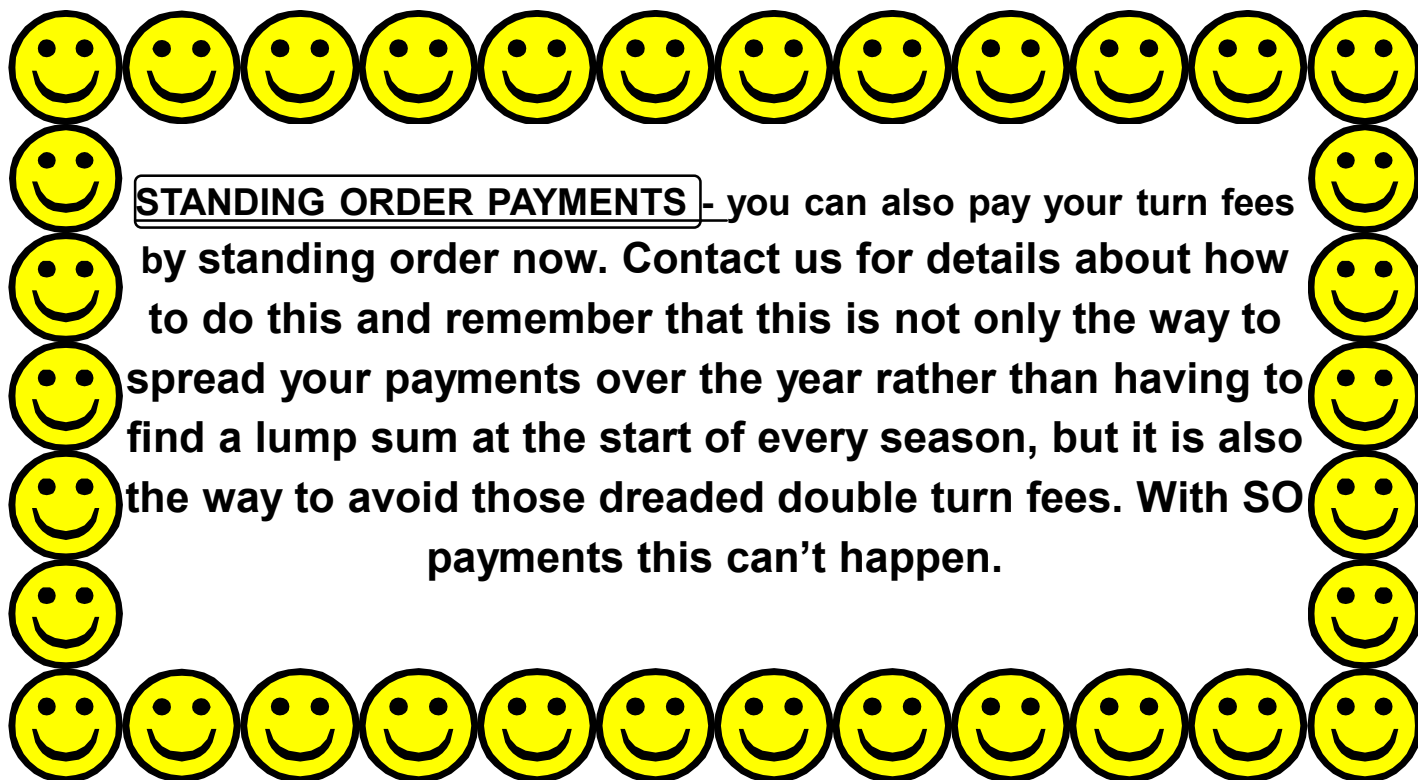

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

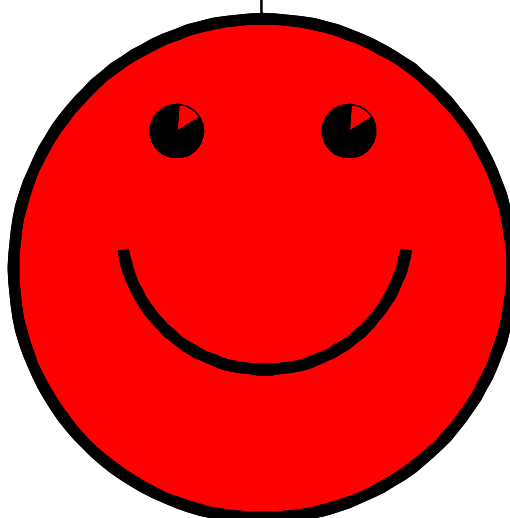
