



BOLTON CHAMPS

Bolton seal the championship early, by ensuring six points this session. A solid home win against Purple Hearts where BALKA had a great game and scored a hatrick in the home side's 3-0 victory. A worthy defensive display with some fine zonal marking made this a much harder game than expected for **Bolton**, but their overwhelming attack saw them home with great finishing by BALKA.

Their second game, again at home saw them welcome **World News**, again the visitors employed an effective zonal marking tactic, but **Bolton** marked key man KIEV well, in addition BERHOFF got forward several times to break down the visitors offside trap. So whilst the visitors competed well in the midfield, the **Bolton** forward line, supplemented with runs from the back meant that the home side created numerous shooting chances. THAASTROM performed miracles in goal snuffing out chance after chance, but the volume of chances meant that **Bolton** racked up five goals without reply, with BALKA picking up another two - what a week for him.

Croydon Flyers did their best to push **Bolton** all the way, also picking up six points this session, and cementing runners up spot in the League, Firstly they made it a week to forget for **World News**, their forward line overwhelming a decent rearguard effort by the visitors, once again the chances created meant that despite THAASTROM's efforts, the finishing of VAN DER MEJDE and JOSHUA BADNITZ meant a comfortable 4-1 win for the **Flyers** despite a consolation effort by BERNIE.

In their second game **Croydon** travelled to **Rapide Rapace**, the game was won by the double marking of MARQUIS by both SCOTT and LOMAX, it completely changed what could have been a close game and meant that the visiting forwards of JOSHUA BADNITZ and VAN DER MEJDE rained shots on MONTRWAUX in the home goal, despite his best efforts **Croydon** ran out comfortable winners 0-5.

Along with **World News**, **Charlatans** had a week to forget, narrowly missing out away to **Whitestar** they set up defensively and looking for a point, but an early goal by BLANCO for the home side put that plan to the sword, and they couldn't generate any opportunities to gain parity. Then in their derby away to **Martino** they gave a better account of themselves, generating some chances at least, but found UTRECHT in fine form to deny them, and had to settle for a draw (that was probably a fair reflection).

Whitestar meanwhile also scored a convincing win over **Purple Hearts**, certainly playing their part in their relegation confirmation. The home side's dominance was reflected particularly in their forward's domination, with SAUCE grabbing four goals in their 5:2 win.

Owlerton also picked up a few places with their six point week, firstly visiting **Cryogenix** and generating a convincing 0-2 away win. Then away again to a feisty encounter at **Crusaders** where again they dominated, and scored two again, though the injuries to KUIVASTO and EARLE will be annoying.

The bottom four teams all failed to pick up any points, so no change, except that it means **Purple Hearts** are now confirmed to join **Crusaders** in relegation, and leaving **Cryogenix** and **Rapid Rapace** to fight it out for the final spot. If **Cryogenix** can pull off a (tricky) win at home to **Whitestar** then a draw would not be enough for **Rapid Rapace** away to **World News**.

STILL UNDECIDED

St Peters take six points for the week, firstly away to **Istel Palace** a spirited performance from the home side saw them somewhat against the run of play manage to stay in the game for the full ninety minutes, but ultimately lose 3-5, followed up with a regulation 0-3 victory away to **Typhoon Loftus**.

Hannover96 started well with a dominant 3-0 victory over derby opponents **Wolfpack**, but then in another derby against **The Family Cat** they could not break down the resilient visitors defence, both sides cancelled each other out completely The 58k supporters who came to the game saw not a single shot on goal, I think the visitors will be feeling pretty please with themselves.

Hannover96 do have a game in hand over **St Peters** however, and with goal difference so close, the 2nd Division champion spot is still up for grabs.

Nelsoners lost in their derby game at home to a visiting **FC West Trip** who controlled the midfield and in a close quarters battle of a game got the deserved win. In their second game of the week they visited **Fulham Lumens** and came away with a the point they were looking for, a game of few chances, and defences on top meant a point each was a fair reflection. Despite this, promotion is assured, as **The Family Cat** got an excellent point at **Hannover96** but visiting **Wycombe Town** put them to the sword in their second game, a FRINSKI hatrick perhaps flattering the visitors in a relatively even game thanks to SCHENK's injury.

At the bottom, **Istel Palace** did pick up a single point at home to a dominant **FC West Trip** and this means they are very much in the driving seat for avoiding relegation, however they will be nervous, as looking over their shoulder **Red Star Ceville** picked up a comfortable win at home to **Anfield Stars** and the three points means they are in striking distance with their game in hand.

A win away to **Wolfpack** who are already relegated, would mean they would be safe from the **Red Star** revival train who would have to do something special to stand a chance with just their normal game away to followed up with **Wycombe** a tough ask.

ELEGANT CHAOS DO ENOUGH

Elegant Chaos utterly dominate away to **FC SKANGERS** but fail to put the ball in the net and therefore just the point from the game, and in their second game away to **Redden Court** it would be fair to say, they were by far the better side, but for some reason played defensively, perhaps expecting more of a game than they got. Chances were limited all round, and both 'keepers performed well, so again just another point for **Elegant Chaos**.

However, as it turned out, this was enough as **Viking Raiders** could only draw away to **Jovian Giants** in a very even game, and though they won comfortably at home to **Trachloe Villa** by five clear goals with none in reply, it meant the gap was too much to bridge in the final week. Therefore **Elegant Chaos** win Division 3.

The other promotion spots are very much up for grabs however.

Paris Angels thrash **Twin Peaks** in a very one sided match, the visitors very much missing BUDA, the home side's out and out attack generating a lot of chances. In their second game a canny offside trap by visitors **FC Nottingham** saw **Paris Angels** struggle to dominate as much and a draw was a fair reflection.

Chiaroscuro also picked up enough points to stay in the race too, a disappointing no score draw at home to **Walsall Heath** meant that it was all to do in the second game of the week. They obliged with a convincing 3-1 win at home to **Twin Peaks**, their forward line generating a lot of chances, LEIF and JOHNSON unsurprisingly applying the finish.

So a single point for **Viking Raiders** at home to **Redden Court** would be enough to see them promoted,

Chiaroscuro will fancy their chances for three points away to **Trachloe Villa**, and **Paris Angels** have possibly the trickier task of requiring three points from their trip to **United OB**, though they do have the slight advantage of better goal difference.

At the bottom, **Walsall Heath** picked up four points this week, with their aforementioned draw and a good home win against

Trachloe Villa giving them a chance of avoiding the drop.

FC Nottingham are in the best spot having picked up two crucial points this week, but need at least one more point to be certain, but their home game is against **FC Skangers** so will fancy their chances.

Walsall Heath would need to beat **Elegant Chaos** away, and that only assumes **Nottingham** and **Trachloe** do nothing.

Trachloe Villa would need three points from their home match to **Chiaroscuro** a tough ask indeed given they are still challenging for promotion.

BLACKBURN REMAIN UNDEFEATED

Only two points for **Blackburn** this week, as they eased off, but ensured that along with **Bolton** they remain undefeated for the season as they enter the last week.

A solid away draw to **Holland Pk West**, followed by a somewhat surprising away draw to **Cougars FC**, the visitors had much the better of the play, but KENOBI had a good day in goal and LEROUX popped up for a late and unjust equaliser!

Holland Pk West picked up a massive win away to **Dark City**, a seven goal victory a fair reflection of their dominance. But with **Coral Sea City** winning 6-0 at home to **Tiverton Tigers** with an adaptive formation that hammered the visitors, then a much closer game at home to **Old Josephians** who may have benefited from playing an offside trap, as it was the **Coral** forwards enjoyed their dominance and ran out 5-2 winners, taking second place. Can they hang on to it, we shall see, but both they and **Holland Pk West** are both promoted regardless.

4th through 7th spots are separated by just 3 points, **Bluesville** could retain 4th if they beat visiting **Real Olivero** who feel like they have improved in the second half of the season.

Travellers face **Tiverton Tigers** in a likely tight encounter, but with all these teams feeling fairly evenly matched it will be interesting which goes on to challenge next season.

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

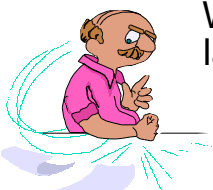

MARKING UPDATE

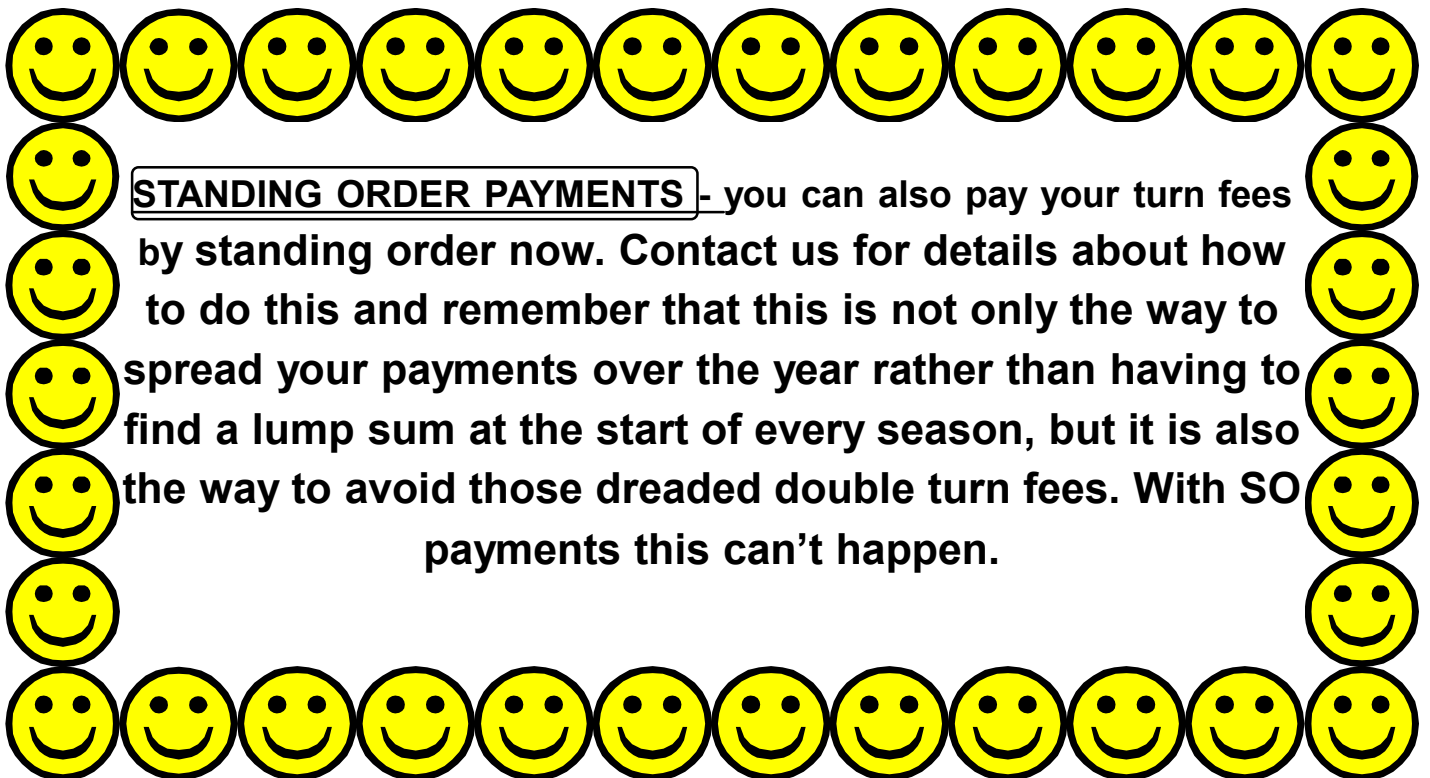

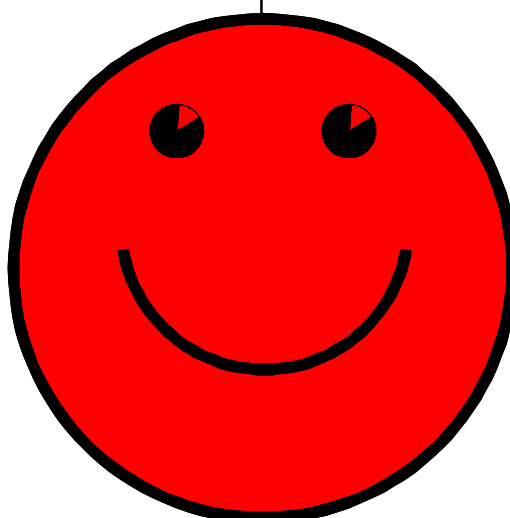

Or how about a team in the Premier league just finished. Have your own favourite side with their real-life players. Chance to build from scratch, and challenge the greats of this league (**KP&^\$**). Get to grips with new formations and rules as well!
