



IS THE WIND OF CHANGE BLOWING OR HAS SMITH JUST HAD TOO MANY SPROUTS?

For the first time in as long as I can remember, all teams in the first division have failed to win both league games in the opening session. Early days I know but judging by the results, this season could have a number of teams battling it out for the title come season's end.

Don't get me wrong, **Sprout** are still as strong as ever and must be favourites this year again but a number of sides do seem to have caught up a little bit and returners **AS Centurions** are one example; not quite in a position to mount a serious challenge I feel, they are still going to be a force to be reckoned with though. A strong midfield compliments a side that, thanks to some astute management are already well on their way to being at full strength and a solid 4 points this session underlines their potential for this year.

Toto Albini look good enough to finish mid-table again this season, perhaps even beating last year's 7th spot? Some work to be done early on for manager MILLER to get the team fully up to scratch but they already look a force going forward and should have no trouble scoring goals this season and with some cash available to spend if needed, they can look forward to a comfortable campaign this year.

Saints are another one of the 4 point clubs this session and currently sit top thanks to superior goal difference. Tipped by the GM to be there or thereabouts this year, I can have no argument with that and holding **Sprout** to a draw is testament to their ability already. Wages are a little high at the moment and could do with some trimming before they start draining the club's bank balance but apart from that, everything points to a good season ahead.

I see nothing but a season of pain ahead for **Borussia Wigan** this year. They narrowly avoided relegation last year and will almost definitely find themselves in the same situation this time around. A paper-thin squad with few players anywhere near their full potential and no cash to spend means manager GREGERSEN is going to need every ounce of his considerable acumen and then some if they are to survive this season.

Lots and lots of work to be done this year at **Wycombe**. In many ways, this season is going to be a carbon copy of last year I feel _ a struggle early on and improvement coming later, the only difference being that READ hasn't got the readies to buy that improvement a la last year and is going to have to rely more than ever on that READ witchery that has seen him get out of trouble like this so many times before. Wages are also an issue and the decision to sell DUCOS this session was absolutely the right one.

Newly-promoted **Trujillo** certainly don't look the worst in this division and should improve on a poor start to their campaign. The squad is in some need of padding out though but with manager SYMONDS running a considerable deficit that is going to be easier said than done. The necessary sale of SASKATCHEWAN this session is going to hurt the side and a decent forward to replace him is desperately needed here.

Wages under control (unbelievably under control in fact), oodles of cash in the bank and a squad that would scare Brazil, we now turn to the force of nature otherwise known as **FC Sprout**. SMITH has all the pieces in place again this year. Look out for some spending taking place as the squad needs to be expanded but they are once again going to be the team to be beaten this season and with SPUDEYESASHCINS already opening his account they are going to be as dangerous as ever.

Tipped by the GM to struggle this year, it certainly seems **Immortals** are going to. However, it is not all doom and gloom; there are some good players in the squad but they are going to need some quality around them if this side is going to stay up. There is a little bit of cash available but this will need to be spent quickly and smartly if they are to have any hope whatsoever of avoiding the drop after last season's heroics.

Daggers have come through close season in very good shape and look set to have an enjoyable season in the top flight. The squad is almost up to speed already with the key players fully or close to fully fit and the manager should have the opportunity to bring through plenty of youth in preparation for next year. All in all, it's looking very good here.

Some work to be done at **Sofia** as some key players have come back from their holidays in quite poor shape. I think a decision may need to be made now about offloading one out of two possible players and concentrating on getting the one left back in to shape while using the funds from the sale to improve the overall quality of the squad. On the whole though, the squad isn't looking that bad and very possibly, **Sofia** may surprise one or two sides this season.

Paradisio could well be up there challenging come season's end. Some work needed here first though and some early success to generate those SP's needed is certainly going to be a deciding factor in how close to really challenging for the title they are



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going to be. Overall though it is looking pretty good here, wages are a bit high and need some attention and there is cash in the club if KP feels he needs to spend it.

Have to go fully against the GM's prediction for **Botafogo's** prospects this season. A lot of work needed here if manager STEADMAN is going to emulate last season's heroics. Most of the squad is incredibly strong but, and it is a big but, all his key players require work and the need for early success here is far more crucial than **Paradisio's**. There is money to spend though and the sale of GOVERNOR INCCIE this session will bring the wage bill down but I think it's going to be a big ask for this side to challenge this year?

WALLS CLIMBING?

Not arguing at all with DEMPSEY on this one. **Spiritus Santos** are going to struggle this year. Another bare-bones squad which will need filling soon if they are to have any chance of staying up. There is money to spend though and manager SUTTON is a canny operator but something will need to be done quickly if a season of pain is to be avoided.

Potential is the buzz word down at **St Helen's Town** but will this be the year they fulfil it? Lots of exciting players in the squad but few of them yet at their full potential. Not a lot of cash to spend so manager ASHCROFT is, for the time being, going to have to work with what he's got but what he's got is quite a lot and a good season could be in the offing here.

Aqua Sulis may be another team to watch this year. STEVENS' teams always score goals and that's not going to change but early on especially, they are going to leak goals and that will need to be addressed sharp-ish if they want to have any shot at a promotion spot. As usual, the spectre of debt is haunting the club but this is the usual STEVENS M.O. and it's not going to worry him too much.

Inter Walls have to be in with a shot at the title this year. The squad is looking in really good shape, one or two players will require some attention early on but after that there should be very little to stop them making a serious challenge for the top spot. Six points this session underlines their ambition and I can only see them getting stronger. There is also the added bonus of cash to spend if SAMSON feels he needs to open the purse strings but I really think he's not going to need to.

FC Crazy Town are another side with a lot of potential in the squad. Maybe a little bit too much work to be done this year for them to mount a truly serious promotion challenge, they will nonetheless still be a difficult side to beat this season and perhaps by next year they may be ready for real?

Last year's division3 champions **City Boyz** are also looking well set for life in division 2. A solid squad which, with the exception of 1 or 2 players, is well on its way to optimum performance and could well be there or thereabout. Wages are also good and there is cash to spend if ENGSLEV really feels it's necessary.

Looks like a reasonable season on offer for **New Caldonia**. Not a squad to set the world on fire by any means and it could

do with some padding out in all honesty but cash is at a premium at the club at the moment so there's no quick fix option available. All in all though it's not too bad and I feel that once a few players are up to speed, they may have a good second half of the season.

Hawtonville are another club in a similar position. Some work needed to some key players early on which will reap benefits later and they should finish in a comfortable mid-table spot come the end.

A mixed bag of good and bad at **Wymondham Town**. They are an all-purpose side which is always a good thing but there is a considerable amount of work needing to be done if they are to be truly competitive this season. There are some good players in the squad and there is plenty of cash to spend so it's not looking all bad and they could end up having a good season if MOORE spends this cash wisely.

Potential is another word I would use to describe the squad at **Marseille**. A decision needs to be made on what category they are finally going to adopt but there are some very good players in the squad that don't need much coaching before they are truly dangerous. A goalkeeper should be a priority purchase for manager SCOTT and once that is sorted then things will definitely be looking up at this club.

Possibly a good season in the offing for **Forest Island**. A relatively young side, most of the squad is up and running but some attention will need to be paid to LECHEROIU before he is truly a force to be reckoned with. Wages are good but the side will need to be expanded sooner rather than later as it's pretty thin on personnel at the moment.

Will this be the season that manager HUMPHRIES feels his side are ready to take the step? Promotion is certainly on offer this year for **Sunderland FTM** if they want it. They have a couple of gems coming out of their youth side and waiting in the wings and although the squad needs a little bit of early season work, things look set at the club.

HARLEYS STAR STILL RISING?

Another side who should be there or thereabout come season's end are **FC Porto**. All the right players have returned fully fit and there is little for manager WELLS to do to round off the squad. Another specialist couldn't harm but that could be said for any club and with some cash in the bank, this could well be a possibility if the manager decides that's what's needed.

Loftus Olympics are tipped to go down again this season but I have a feeling they may prove the bookies wrong. Probably going to struggle a bit first half of the season I would say but they have come through the first session with a win and a draw to their credit and with plenty of money to spend, this season could definitely see a turn-around in their fortunes.

Have to agree with the GM on his prediction for the **Gooners** this year. A painfully thin squad at the moment but with plenty of talent in it. Expansion is a priority for the manager as just one injury could have serious consequences but with a



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sizeable overdraft to clear first, it's going to be a while before we see any new additions I feel?

Edoras are another side looking good early on. Perhaps not quite enough quality in the side to make a serious promotion bid (although there is a sizeable amount available for purchases) they will nonetheless, be tough opponents for anyone this year. Wages could do with a little bit of work but that's about the only negative I see at the club.

Harleys Heroes are set for another cracking season as they look to emulate last year's achievements. Strong already in all department's, there is more currently under development that will make them even stronger before season's end. Wages are excellent and there is some cash available as well. All I can say is, look out division 3.

Tipped by the GM to be amongst the front runners, **Aethul Wulf** had an indifferent opening to their season but by god, there is potential at this club and I foresee any disappointments possibly suffered early on being wiped out in a glorious second-half of the season as the squad finally reaches it's potential. The overdraft needs to be dealt with before it becomes a really serious issue and this could hamper their development early on as the manager cannot depend on bringing new blood in to the club.

The old BUTLER magic is certainly going to be needed at **Hobbiton** and the current state of their squad certainly doesn't paint a pretty picture. Decision are going to need to be made quickly on a number of players but there is a core of useful players that the manager can build on so while I see a relegation battle as a distinct possibility for them this year, things aren't all doom and gloom.

Next we come to yours truly and **Sandwich Town**. Genuinely surprised to be promoted last year, a mid-table finish is the best I can predict this year. Captain FEBREEZE is a shadow of his former self but on the whole, the squad isn't looking that shabby. Some youth is desperately needed as the squad is starting to age and "mini-rebuild" is going to be the watchword this season.

Red Star Karova are another promoted side and new to division 3 this year. The off-season hasn't been particularly kind to manager SCOTT and some decisions on players needs to be made but there is a useful core of good players still available to him. A new goal-keeper may be a priority but the manager does have cash to spend and if it is spent wisely then I don't see why **Red Star** can't finish comfortably come season's end?

Next we come to **Burnden Villa** and the enigmatic PETER BROOKS. A mixed bag of close season outcomes leaves the squad in pretty good overall shape but with some work needing to be done to some key players, who have a way to go before they are truly back to full fitness and the introduction of some youth may not be a bad idea. As always, they are going to be tough to beat this year again but I feel promotion may be slightly beyond them?

A difficult season ahead for **Snowdonia** I feel? There are some good players in the squad but overall a lot of attention needed here and I think manager HAILS needs to prepare himself for a relegation dog-fight. Wages are a tad on the high side and could do with some trimming before they eat in to the club's cash reserves.

Ulpha Rovers are another club with some work needing to be done. Levels-wise not the worst I have seen in this division though one or two players do need some attention. Of a much more serious nature is the overdraft and the wages situation. Perilously close to the 1 mill over-drawn mark and with wages the highest by far in the division, if not the league, urgent negotiations need to start taking place soon and the manager may well have to accept some players will be leaving the club.

CHEAM SET TO CHARGE

Hutnik AS look in pretty goos shape for the forthcoming campaign and a credible 4 points this session underlines that. Key players have returned fully fit and it's only going to take a little development of the other squad players before they are all running at optimum. The wages should be a concern though and some work is needed here, otherwise things are looking pretty good at the club.

Rejuv missed all the important players for **Thors Hammers** close season and the squad has returned a shadow of it's former self so plenty of work for manager STEVENS to be getting on with this season and, as per usual, no money to spend to compound the issues. Having said all that, there are still some tidy players available (if the bank manager doesn't come knocking for them) but I don't see a lot of glory for **Thors** this year.

A solid, if uninspiring squad is what we find at **IFK Didi**. Not much work to do to bring them up to full speed and this club is obviously still a work in progress having been only recently taken over by WELLS. There is definitely progress being made and that looks set to continue for the rest of this season.

Much the same can be said for **Purley Kings** as above except for 2 crucial differences _ an excellent wage bill and lots of money to spend means that the **Kings**, depending on how and if the money is spent, could be in for a good season this year. Lots of already fit players and not much work needed to be done on the rest means that REISER finds himself in quite a good position at the start of this campaign.

Sleeping Woods are also looking in better shape at the start of this season compared to the last. I do agree with the GM's pre-season assessment but there is definitely progress being made and BUTLER can count himself unlucky that GRUFF didn't rejuv as the forecast for this year would have been much different if he had but onwards and upwards is definitely the mantra for this club.

Where to start with **Walsall**? Still very much a work in



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progress under the guiding hand of yours truly, they continue to stutter along somewhat. Progress is being made, albeit slowly. Wages are good and there is a big balance available for the next manager to blow on whatever he wants but not much to look forward to this season I am afraid.

All looking good at **Redstox** and I can see no reason why they won't have a great season. A little bit of work to be done before they are firing on all cylinders and the six points this session was no less than manager STOCKS should have expected. Plenty of cash in the bank although wages are a bit on the high side but I fully expect **Redstox** to be right up there come season's end, especially if some of that warchest is expended on that one magical player?

Horizon have suffered quite badly during close season and manager JILKES is going to have his work cut out here if they are going to look like the team from last year. A little bit of money to spend though and potential here if the right players can be trained. I feel that some concentration on developing youth is needed this year but 4 points gained this session shows that they aren't down and out by any means.

Dragon are another side who have returned from close season not in the best of form. They have an excellent player in the form of SCAMBELLURI to build around but at the moment, there is not a great deal of quality from the rest of his team-mates. There is money in the bank though and lots of the players aren't THAT far off becoming viable so plenty to be optimistic about I feel. A goal-keeper needs to be a priority for the manager.

Some potential at **Flowserve** to have a cracking campaign this season. Some attention needs to be paid early on to a couple of players but there is a good core at the club and much will depend on whether manager PRESLAND can get the required SP's during the season to train the right players. Plenty to be pleased about here though.

As for **Western Raiders**, well what the GM said basically. I am assuming HAILS has a plan, of course he has a plan but what that is at the moment, I can't quite fathom. Going to struggle massively at the beginning of the season until that warchest is depleted and I look forward to re-visiting this at the mid-season round up.

Last but certainly not least is **Cheam Chargers** and boy, should they be charging this year! Plenty of real talent at the club. The squad could maybe do with a couple of new players but there is a considerable pot of cash available and **Cheam** should be right up there come season's end.

TRANSFER TRAILS

As to be expected, lots going on in the open market this session. **Harleys** make the most of **Trujillo's** money issues and ease them in the process with the acquisition of the big man SASKATCHEWAN, another quality addition to an already quality side. **Loftus** continue with their ethos of buying young

all-purpose with the acquisition of RAINFORD for a measly 50k. Certainly not immediately going to help but one for the future, they do bolster their immediate prospects however by bringing in WISLOKA. **Western Raiders** refuse to get drawn in to any sort of panic-buy for top level players as HAILS continues with his plan and brings in another youngster, this time COUVE D'BRUXELA from **Sprout** and also getting another youngster HAALAND from the **Gooners** for a price rumoured to be close to the million pound mark.

Immortals splash the cash and bring in some quality in the form of BI BI TRUMPIE and ROMARIO, two players that certainly lift their prospects for this year while LURPAK goes out to **Aethul Wulf**, in what could be a good gamble for them. Meanwhile, **Flowserve** get GOVERNOR INCCIE to add to what is already a potentially lethal midfield but will they have the SP's?

Harleys splash again to bring in DAMNATION from **Spiritus Santos** for 1.5 mill and their already considerable buying power receives a boost. Could SUTTON buy his way out of trouble this year? **Inter Walls** already planning for the future with the acquisition of youngster MEADOWS from **Flowserve** for a tasty 2850k. **Sunderlan** also plan for the future, snapping up GALADHEON from **Wymondham Town** for 3 mill.

Cheam also take a punt on an all-purpose to bring in FERNANDEZ from **Harleys** for 3.5 which is definitely going to pay dividends in the future. **Didi** continue their improvement programme, bringing in young marksman VAN DER VALK for a very reasonable 700k from **Wycombe**

In the auction, **Red Star Karova** plump for youngster BROOKLYN to solve their goalkeeper issues. Not an immediate fix that's for sure but is a sound decision over the long term. **Burnden** also go shopping for a keeper, bringing in MONTGOMERY for a sum just under the half a million mark.

Daggers look to the future, bringing in young sweeper TJ HOOKER with a perfectly eighted bid and **Burnden** again seem to be pinching other people's ideas as they bring in a sweeper, MAINE also. **Sandwich** start their mimi-rebuild with the purchase of young defender ROANOKE as they look to consolidate this year.

Sprout splash out a considerable amount for young starlet winger NICK KONAT. Will he live up to his price tag? We will just have to wait and see. While it's **Wymondham** who plunge for the gamble buying midfield boss COLLATRELLA in what could be a one season wonder show for the ageing mestro. Could this be exactly what gives them the edge for this season atleast, though?

Please note that from now onwards it is illegal to sell any player and then buy him back in the next three session FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER. If you do that player will be banned for life and you will lose him

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

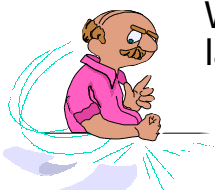

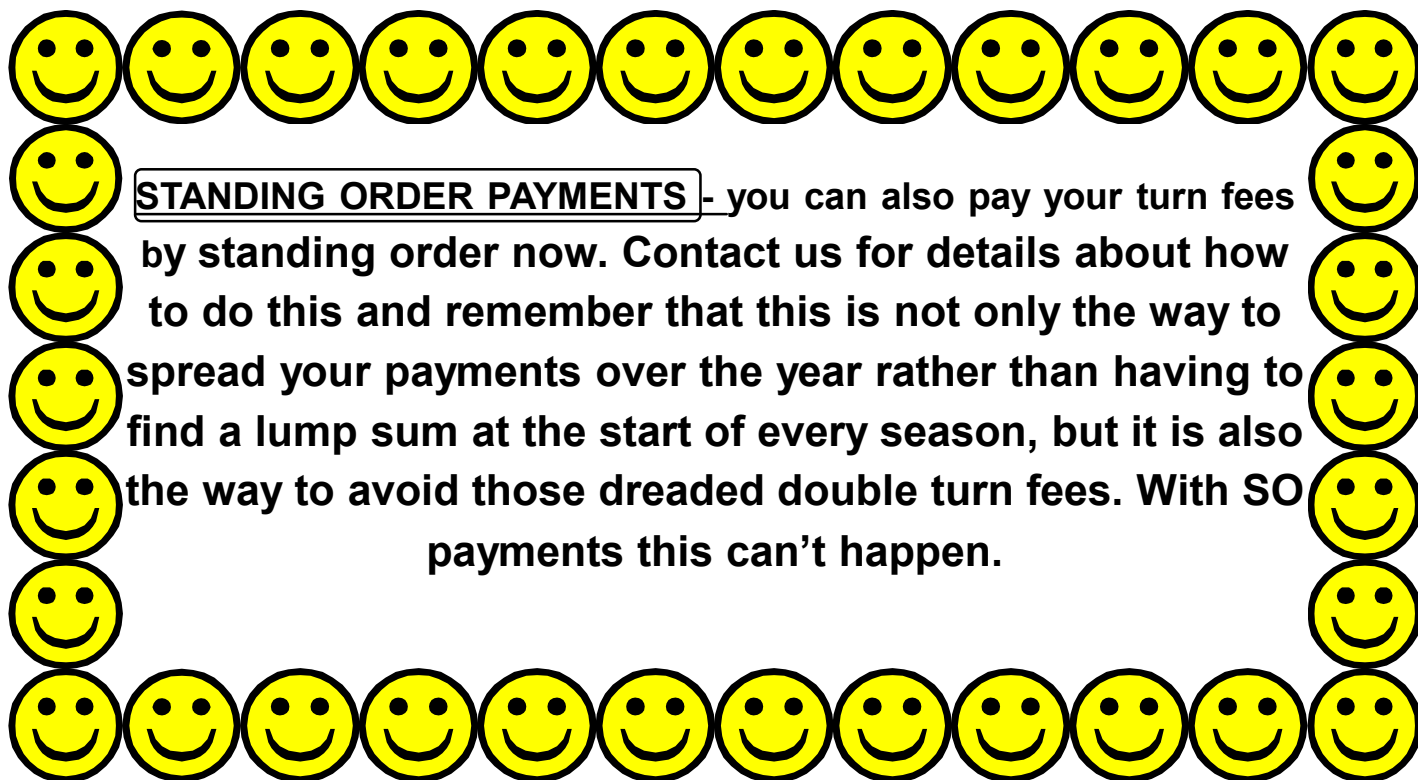
