



DIV I

Previous champs **Skelmersdale** and **Laissez-Faire** both lost last time out, but in different fashion, as **Laissez-Faire** got edged out by **Ameliehekeani** in a narrow match, while **Skelmersdale** lost despite total dominance at home to **Q of N**. This week both teams needed a win to not fall further behind the top two, especially **Skelmersdale**, having three points from their three opening matches. **Laissez-Faire** entertained a **Showboats** team that came to try getting a draw against their local rivals, but they never stood a chance, as the strong hosts created chances throughout the match, and already in the 7th minute had gone 2-0 up. The final 5-0 score was just, and should probably have been some more goals for **Laissez**, but **Longshanks** managed to keep everything out in the last half an hour. **Skelmersdale** on the other hand, without the injured **Is**, looked vulnerable at **Wycombe Falcons**. Their manager had even decided to field his team in a rather negative SW-3-3-3, with strict orders to keep behind the ball at all time. This meant they struggled to create any chances from open play, while their hosts did create a decent amount. What did save the visitors was once again their individual talent, as they managed to get three shots off after some brilliant moves, and to the dismay of the home manager, goalie **Andersen** managed to let in all three, and in the 23rd minute **Lund** also managed to lob his own keeper, after completely miss-kicking the ball, trying a clearance. The hosts had started out taking an early lead, in the 6th minute, but before **Lund** helped the visitors cause, **Athabasca** and **Bentino** had turned the match around. Then **Culwch** pulled one back straight from the restart, but in the 59th minute **Bentino** got his 2nd to make it 4-2 for **Skelmersdale**, and despite some decent openings, the host could not get another goal here. ***** Top two **West London FC** and **Putney Celtic** met in London, and the question here was whether one of the teams would manage to keep the 100% record, or if we would see a draw between them. The host lined up in rather negative looking 3-5-2, and looked set up to settle for a draw, while the 2-5-3 of **Putney** were rather balanced, and more positive looking. The zonal marking of the hosts did harm **Putney** quite hard, and meant they despite their set up had to build all the way from defence when venturing forward, while **West London** dominated in the middle of the park. Neither team managed to create many openings, but around the 70th minute the hosts had a good spell, and **(J) Benson** twice netted, as the big man shook off the oppositions defenders, and twice towered above all others to head home from corners. No way back for **Putney** after this, and it is **West London** that keep their 100% record to open up a gap at the top. ***** Could **Q of N** get another big win as they this week entertained local rival **Ameliehekeani**? They certainly couldn't, as their SW-3-4-2 never really looked likely to score, while the visitors in a SW-2-5-2 dominated the match, especially in the middle of the park. Add to this their individual talent, and no one would be surprised to see them running out deserved winners, the only surprise being they only managed three goals here. ***** 4th placed **D.D.T.** entertained **Dow Crag Rovers**, in another derby match, and their 3-5-2 had lots of bite up front, with their midfield adding to their attacks. Chance after chance they created, and visiting manager **Moller** couldn't have complained had his team lost with four-five goals, but somehow goalie **Lux** managed to keep a clean sheet, to get his point a very undeserved point. ***** Bottom battle at **Walton**, as the hosts entertained 11th placed **Flamengo RJ**. The hosts lined up in a SW-2-5-2, while the visitors came in a 3-5-2. Not many chances here, but it was the visitors that got the winner, as **Norseman** stole in to pick up the ball as goalie **Lindegaard** and sweeper **Mild** both looked like they thought the other would go for the ball, and **Norseman** could then round the goalie and coolly slot it into the open net.

DIV II

The league leaders **Univ. Nanterre** this week went to 3rd placed **Southdown FC** in the big match of the day. **Southdown FC** lined up in a rather negative looking 3-5-2, while the SW-3-3-3 of the visitors was balanced, and looked rather uninspiring. Had the marking of **Morten Bo-Jens** and **Cleary**, from **Basil** and **Morgan**, did help the visitors, as it meant the hosts had to build from the middle, with their top two restricted, and this did limit their chances. Still they did take the lead in the 14th minute, and had it not been for **Oleg's** own goal in the 44th minute, this would have ended in a win for the hosts, as **Univ. Nanterre** never looked likely to score a goal on their own. The draw enough to keep both managers relative happy, although manager **Ashcroft** the happier. *****

Terra Firma, sitting in 2nd, just like **Univ. Nanterre** had won all three matches so far, and with at least a point at **Royal Spurs** would go top. Their SW-3-4-2 lacked any bite up front, but did dominate in the middle, against the hosts SW-2-4-2. Both teams struggled to create any chances at all, and the match ended in a rather boring 0-0. Still **Terra** do go top, but will need to produce better football than this to stay top. ***** 4th placed **Tudor Avenue** went away to bottom team **St Johns** this week, and the 4-4-2 of the hosts pretty much matched the 3-5-2 of **Tudor** all over, although looking rather weak up front. This allowed the visitors to build a some moves from the back, and from one of these they created the only goal of the match, as **Gameiro** in the 50th minute got the ball into the net after he ran onto a pass from **Zeus Deewater**, with only the goalie to beat. ***** **Arsenal 1866** entertained

With the visitors 1-0 up it looked to be all over for the hosts at that time, but the team looked to be galvanised by the dismissal, and in the 76th minute they got the equaliser, and then managed to hold on to the point. ***** **Red Star** went to **Sporting Stars** this week, and their 3-5-2 had much the better of play against the SW-4-3-2 of the hosts, but against the run of play it was the hosts that took the lead in the 13th minute, as **O'Shay** lobbed the ball over **Zubizrrreta**. This was from their first real chance, and while **Red Star** time and again tried to beat **Gweneth**, the hosts only managed to test the visitor's goalie once more, but he was not to be beaten again. Down the other end **Gweneth** and sweeper **Niedermayer** had a fine match, but in the 36th minute had to succumb, as **Pilsner** managed to get the ball into the net following a goalmouth scramble. But in the 2nd half they stood firm throughout, and the match thus ended 1-1, despite the **Red Star** dominance. ***** **Zion Gardens** hadn't picked up a single point from their opening matches, but this week had high hopes as they entertained 9th placed **Faarevejle Utd**. They lined up in a slight defensive 3-4-3, while the 4-4-2 of the visitors looked very defensive. Despite having the slightest of edges possession wise, the hosts struggled to create good openings, and would probably have benefitted if they had drawn **Hambo** or **Kraay** back into the middle of the park, to get a better hold here. As it was they ended up without managing a single shot on target, while **Faarevejle** twice got a shot off towards **Van Kuipers**. From one of these **Van Kuipers** didn't manage to keep hold of the ball, and **Amazonia** reacted quickly and managed to sidefoot the ball into the empty net, for the winning goal.

DIV III

No team had managed to win all three opening matches in the 3rd division, with leaders **Wath Dearnsmen** on six points. They entertained bottom team **Kirkwood Albion** this week. Surprisingly there wasn't a big gap in quality between the teams, the 2-3-5 of the hosts naturally dominated, and their five man forward line did create a lot of chances, but **Tiger Shaw** and **Lindegaard** only twice got beat. The more balanced SW-2-4-3 of **Kirkwood** took advantage of the weak midfield and defence of **Wath**, and got some good openings as well, although far less than the hosts. When **Stroutz** in the 24th minute gave the hosts a 2-0 lead it all looked to go according to the pre-match predictions, but the hosts failed to add to their tally. When **Kirkwood** got one back in the 71st minute you could notice the hosts getting a bit edgy, and when **Gaul Crixus** got the ball into the net, with a header from a corner ending at the far post, it wasn't that big a

surprise. This is how the match ended, in a 2-2 draw. ***** With **Beruit** visiting the always struggling to score **Rustin**, having played out 0-0 draws in all opening three matches, it wasn't too surprising to see the match ending in yet another 0-0 for the hosts. **Manager Hugo** looks like he has abandoned ship at **Rustin**, a new man should be getting this team to perform better than they do in front of goal, while **manager Smith** at **Beruit** will be pleased enough with the draw. ***** **Fatal Flops** could go top, and with them entertaining **System Lords**, placed down in 11th spot, the hosts were big favourites for their match. The SW-3-4-2 looked a tad defensive, but as they still took the lead in the 5th minute, with **Dramvquist** flicking in a cross from close range, it looked to go as predicted. But from here on and in they never really looked likely to score again, despite making some chances, as most of them ended as long range efforts, not really testing **Handerson**. Still it looked like the hosts would get their win, as **System Lords** hardly looked to threaten, but in the 88th minute they got the equaliser from their one and only chance, as **Hoijdonky** rounded **Nogood** and struck the ball into the top left corner, with **Boa Morte** grounded. ***** With the top three all failing to win **Sky Blue Fire** could climb to the top of the division. To do this they needed a win at **Crimson Dynamo**, and with the hosts playing in a defensive SW-4-3-2 the balanced 3-4-3 of **Sky Blue Fire** looked in control from the start of the match, with the hosts only able to get forward from defence once in a while. With the visitors dominating proceedings it was deserved when they in the 17th minute got the opener, **Moor** scoring with a long dipping drive, and **Smy** added a second in the 54th minute, poking the ball home following a corner. It took until the 72nd minute before they did make their dominance count though, but when **Sansum** struck the opener, it was no way back for the defence minded visitors, and 1-0 it ended. ***** At **Hatchend** it was also the hosts that had the better of play, their 3-4-3 being in control against the SW-2-4-3 of **Walsall Swifts**. But as with **Bolton**, also **Hatchend** struggled to make their superiority count, and it took until the 77th minute before they finally got their winner. Two teams with a 100% record after three matches down in the 4th division, **Barnet F.C.** and **Puxi Pandas** the frontrunners. This week the local rivals met at **Barnet**, with the hosts being slight favourites due to them playing at home. **Barnet** lined up in a rather balanced 3-4-3, while **Puxi** came

in a slightly more negative 3-4-3, but not too much between the teams here. With some good goalkeeping from **Valdes** the visitors never found their way back, and against the run of play it ends in a second win of the season for **Real Santiago**. ***** **Newtown FC** have the better of play at home to **Luton Lions**, but the SW-3-4-2 is too negative to take full advantage of this, and their visitors SW-3-3-3 holds on to a 1-1 draw, with **Soixante** in the **Luton Lions** goal being man of the match for the visitors. ***** Bottom team **FC Barca** have a long way to go before being competitive it seems, this week trashed 0-8 at **Crosspit**, and should really been more. ***** **Fenham Rovers** entertained **Ord Mantell**, and it is the visitors that had the better of play, their 3-3-4 having more to offer than the 3-5-2 of the hosts, especially up front. Despite this it was the hosts that took an early lead, **Samba** dancing the ball into the net in the 6th minute, and **Ord** had to wait, and wait, until they finally found a way past **Gola** in the 85th minute. **Roxette** got them the equaliser, cracking home a loose ball following a corner, and **Gessle** then found the winner, with a long range effort that went in off the post, in the 89th minute.

Can they make the same effort at **Wycombe** in the replay it might go all the way to penalties? ***** **FC Barca** would probably have been beaten by double digits if not for some strange refereeing, **Laissez-Faire** winning 8-0 without even having to get out of 1st gear. ***** Not much entertainment at **Royal Spurs**, where they host local rivals **Faarevejle Utd**, both teams more concerned with keeping it tight at the back than with goalscoring. ***** At **Univ. Nanterre** it is **Rustin** that dominates, but as they can't find any goals, be it in cup or league, it is the hosts that win the match 2-0. ***** **Walsall Swifts** can't find a way past non-leaguers **Hastings**, can they up their game at the non-leaguers in the replay? ***** **Sporting Stars** also play 0-0 against non-leaguers, but as they played at **Welling**, will probably manage to get a win in the replay at home? ***** **Barnet** ease to a 2-0 at **Alfreton**. 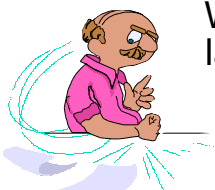

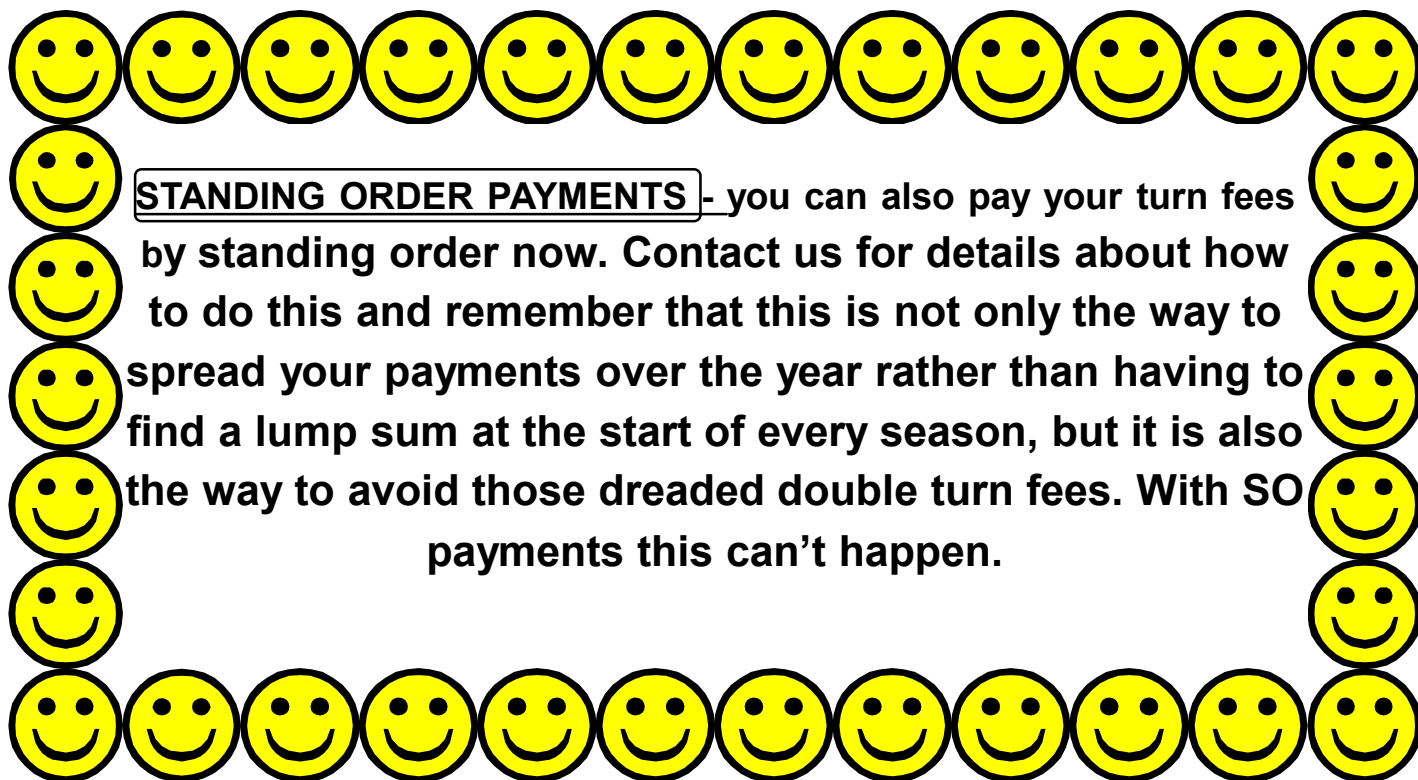

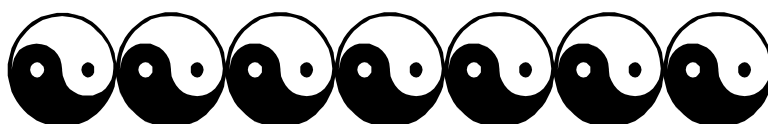

Time to revisit the offside rules

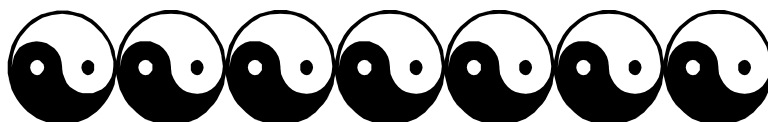
- 1) Cannot be played if you play a SW as a SW
- 2) Cannot be played if you play diamond
- 3) Playing offside reduces the shot chances of the opposition FWline, but you also need to have a stronger MF than them. If not you stand the chance of their midfield decimating you.
- 4) If your opponent has a WG or DFA in his team they can break down your offside trap, the higher the level of these players the more effective they are in breaking your trap.
- 5) The more players that the opponent has in their FWline the more effective (generally), the offside tap is, though many factors affect this.

Basically try not to play offside against a team with a stronger midfield than yours (in levels) no matter how strong his FWline might be. The offside tap can work well if you know your opponents team and plan accordingly BUT it can be a disaster if you don't. SCOUT and read newsletters to find out what he has

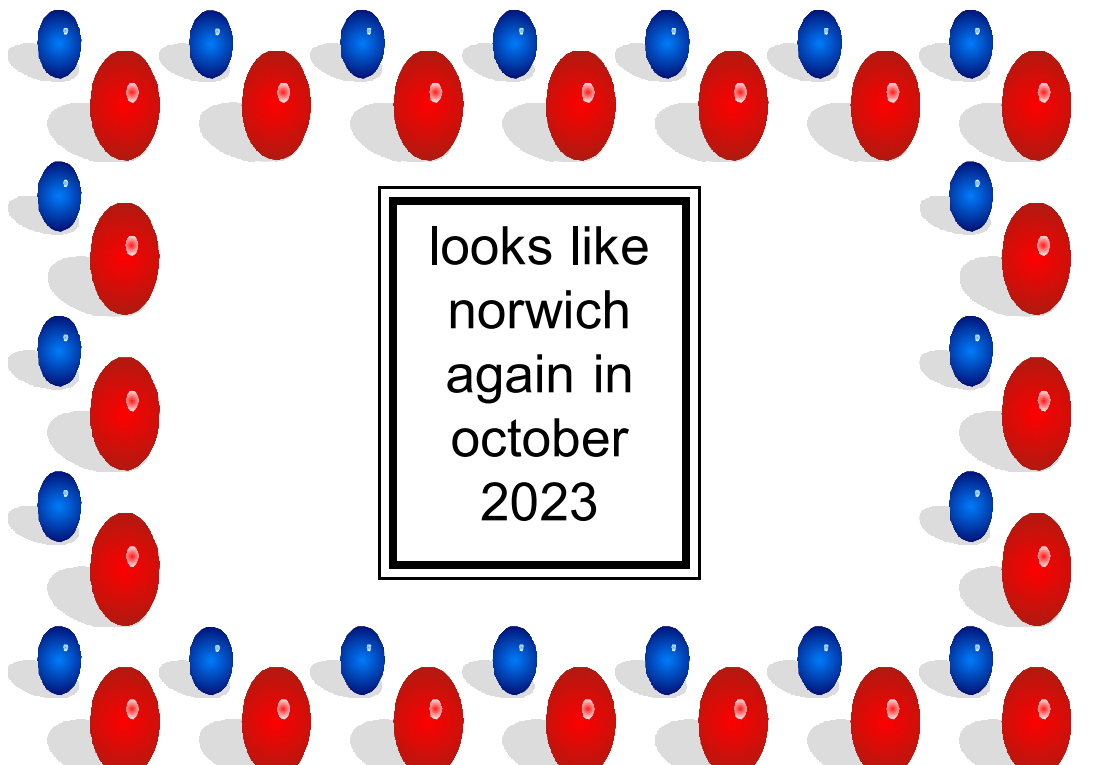

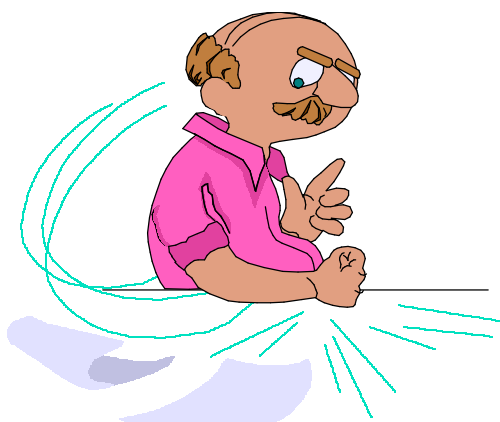

STARTING OUT TIPS

or, what do I do faced with a new team to manage!!

If you are lucky you may have a couple of million in the Bank but that won't be enough to turn things around in a couple of sessions. You need to be committed to be in this for the long haul.

Have a plan. Base your coaching on getting 2 SPS per session. If you get a few more along the way as the season progresses then great either cash them or coach an extra youth player. Aim to coach your APP's & SBY's to level 12's by seasons end. Better to have 3 17/18 yr old level 12's than 5 level 8's.

Clear out the 24-4's etc. to get them off the wage bill as they will be on relatively high wages. Either sell them to other managers at below NL price (you will still benefit vs selling to NL due to wages). If you can't get a buyer then hold on to them and run their contract down before selling to NL by session 10 _ sales to NL go to half price after that.

Play 2 APPS or a SBY every game unless you have a realistic chance of winning but try to win your derby games. Keep your MP's for derby games, matches against fellow strugglers and for (hopefully) a bit of a run in the Bowl.

Build up your cash balance. Keep building this until you have at least circa £8m. Try to pick up bargains (below NL value) from the auction so you can then sell them on at a profit.

Invest money in youth. Don't rely on this producing multiple MF specialists, unless your name is Morten. What you will hopefully get is a few FUT's which you can coach at 0.5 SP per level or sell for cash. This is a good way of increasing your teams' skill level quickly.

Choose a category for the team and aim to get all the players of the same category (P, S or P/S). Having a power team is easier to build up quickly as there are more of them, there are plenty of 95 BW's around and are cheap to buy. However, longer term you will need to change the category of them team as power teams don't become super teams.

If you have players that don't match your chosen category look to trade them for another player who is. It is rare your team will be full of P/S players so if you have any it may be best to move them on to build up your cash balance or trade for another player.

Look to get a good quality GK and SW. You may not win many matches but two level 12's at the back could bring in some extra SP's through 0-0 draws.

Don't coach anyone over the age of 18 unless there is a really good reason to do so e.g. 23-10 MF specialist.

You need a captain so you can afford one player over the age of 19 _ hopefully your captain will star or get rejuvenated.

Within 2 seasons you should have a team full of level 12's and a decent cash balance as a solid platform to start your ascent to being the next KA super team.
