

BITTESWELL BLASTED IN DERBY WEEK

The crunching derby that everyone wanted to watch this week was the game between Bitteswell and Salvation FC. It is safe to say that these two teams have no love for each other and this game will live long in the memory for both sets of fans, although the Wannabees may wish to forget it! A 60k sell out capacity crowd at the Valley Storage Ground may not have enjoyed the dour goalless affair of the first half, but passions were soon lit after the kick off when a rare shot from Ronalfigo rebounded off the post and into the net in the first minute after the break. Uproar in the stands as the Priests fans taunted their counterparts and a few prayer books flew past the dugout and Manager Jensen's head. Jens did not look amused as Lariaux at the opposite end was looking hard to beat. Matters only got worse for the home side when Salvation were awarded a penalty. BonBon attempted to put Rebrov off by offering him a jelly baby but Rebrov ignored the antics and calmly despatched the ball from the spot. Game over. *** Another derby was also taking place at the Desert where Karakal hosted Moha. Although Moha slightly edged the game they could not capitalise or recover from a freak opening goal that swerved in bizarrely from a Foof cross in the second minute. *** Palace Rovers and Gdanski Baltyk meanwhile were involved in an exciting end to end encounter. Deservedly so really as they were good for a point. *** Moha meanwhile picked up a home win against Bracknell with Baldinsky cracking home a good strike from open play.

DYNAMO SENSIBLE STIFLED AT LAST

Dynamo Sensible travelled to Llangollen this week which was a real test for the League leaders and one they proved up to, but not perhaps in their usual swashbuckling style. It worked too, as the Nats could not find away past Boas in goal and spurned their chances in another goal less draw. *** O Donovan Rossa were at home to Cachusaismochyn and once again the fans were sad to see so few chances, although at least in this game there were a few shots on goal. No shots got past the two experienced keepers on show here though. *** Much more excitement was to be found at Castle Park where Hubbard got the home side off to a flying start heading in off the post. Despite having the better of the play FC Warbreck though hung on and eventually got an equaliser from Gorrie heading home shortly before the break. CREATIVE/ BALL-WINNER

HOW DOES IT WORK?

SO WHAT DO THE NUMBERS MEAN?

The new statistics are aimed at a simple game mechanic - they are used to give a side additional chances of scoring during a game or they are used to nullify efforts created by the opposition; it doesn't take a genius to work out which does which.

The individual statistics of each player are only the "base value" for each formulae that uses them. The figures shown are modified by any number of different conditions before they are given a final rating, which is used to determine if he directly effects the match in any way. The kind of players he is playing with, the number of players in his part of the pitch, the weather and the team's formation are all mitigating factors in how this base value is modified.

Ball Winners are players that thrive in the heat of battle, that love to mix it with the opposition and find their talents easier to use when in packed areas of the pitch. They are primarily defensive players and tend to have more effect if the overall stance of the side is weighted in that direction. For each element of this make up that goes their way, they receive a bonus on their ball-winning ability, along with a subsequent penalty to their creative skill. So, if the

Batty of our example starts the game with figures of 75/25 then he will be completely happy playing in a full Power side, with a 4-4-2 formation that uses a negative style. If the weather is cold and the pitch muddy then he has about everything he can get in his favour. The only way of bettering this if for him to be playing in a five-man midfield, but then you lose the negative advantage and his figures won't look all that much better. Each one of the factors in his advantage will add a certain percentage to his abilities and in the example shown it would not be a surprise to see Batty's eventual stats change from 75/25 through to perhaps 105/10 or so.

Creative players like the opposite end of the scale, as you can imagine, and they like warm days with a good surface to play on, they like space to play in and a style that allows them to attack the opposing goalmouth. It doesn't take too much to work out what sort of formations and playing positions will get the best from them.

It may well become apparently that there are more opportunities in the game for ball winners than there are for creative players - this is a fact. The balance to this is that when a BW or CR affect kicks in, it only kicks in at the position the player is located. A BW gain by a player in midfield will kill off a shot from the opposing midfield area for example, while a striker picking up a creative chance will do so from his forward position. The creative chances always result in an additional chance where as ball-winners need to have something to stop if they are to be effective. If a side adds an extra four Ball-winner stops to their midfield and the opposition isn't creating anything in that area, then these efforts are wasted. Thus, while there are many more ways of aiding your ball-winning players, their abilities are not always as valuable as the creative players

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus = 125% for div 1 / 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K
