



READ'S EMPIRE BOYS SETTLING IN NICELY TO THEIR NEW SURROUNDINGS

Almost a third of the way through the season and Lochend Thistle still find themselves top of the table although now they are having to start looking over their shoulders after losing their first league game of the season, 2-0 away to Sutton Rovers. ICI Bolton have now moved to within a point of the leaders after they became the latest team to put a dent in Uffington's good start to the season after they returned from their away game with a 3-1 victory, leaving them 1 of 2 teams still unbeaten in the division. Sun Inn move smoothly into third place in the table after a dominating 3-0 victory away to Vitoria XI side that had no answer to Sun Inn's marking or shooting accuracy. Empire City continue their rise up the table into 4th place, after an incredible away victory against Bignor Hill in which they had to recover from going 1-0 down, before they, and especially Neilsson, took control of the game with the aforementioned Neilsson scoring 5 goals in a crushing 7-1 victory. Ramsgate Utd move up a place into 5th after they managed to fight their way to a hard fought 1-0 away victory against their derby rivals Carleton City, though Seamy will be grateful to the fact that Brutus's strikers couldn't hit a cow's arse with a banjo as his keeper was given nothing to do in the game, but not all is rosy for Utd as they lose Taaarget for 4 goals after ironically, he is targeted to some hefty challenges.

Uffington FC are grateful to have picked up points in the first couple of weeks as they have now lost 2 league games in a row, and consequently dropped down the table from 3rd to 6th. Sutton Rovers sit in 7th at present but they have played a game less than the teams above them and are yet to lose a game, or even concede a goal. A goal late in each half saw Rovers ease to a 2-0 victory against Lochend Thistle and should Sutton win their game in hand, they could find themselves in 3rd. Red Star Rovers are in 8th and they really need to find a way to start scoring goals, they have a talented team but they just can't seem to create many chances. Saying that, they did manage to scrape a 1-0 victory away to Juventus, thanks to a Thai Sunn goal early in the second half. Vitoria XI sit in 9th and manager Pritchard will be dreaming of the days when his team had a solid defence, as they are beaten 3-0 at home by Sun Inn, certainly doesn't help that they have only scored once in 6 games. Brutus has had a really rough start to the season with Carleton City, a 1-0 loss against their derby rivals Ramsgate Utd but when Brutus uses his proper first team, they will climb the table. Bignor Hill sit in 11th after a 7-1 hammering by Empire City but in their defence they were missing 3 first team players so I do expect them to survive once again by season's end. Wooden spoon so far is going to Dag's Juventus who might be going for the record of how many times they can yo-yo between divisions 1 and 2, they do have some very good players but at the moment none of their players are playing anywhere near their true ability.

SCRAMBLED SCRUMBLE

Coming into this week's games, you could only separate Harold Wood and Highbury Corner by goal difference and everyone was hoping for a classic with first playing second in the table and both sides were at full strength for this top of the table clash. With so many good players in either side, there's no surprise to anyone that both sides opted for 5 men in midfield and while the home side just relied on home advantage and motivating their players, Highbury had Ba'Heid and Le Tissier mark Romani and Ezekiel out of the game and they were up for the challenge as well.

The match was a battle in midfield, with Highbury managing to close down any Harold Wood player when they got hold of the ball, as they were well aware of their player's ability to create chances out of nothing, but because of this and the offside trap Highbury operated, chances for either side were at a premium, leaving the crowd to start a Mexican wave going around the stands to attempt to relieve their boredom. It actually took until the 86th minute for the players on the pitch to give the fans

something to shout about, when Romani followed up on a Columbus shot to bundle the ball over the line for the winning goal.

In other news, Bolton Spartans pick up an easy 6-0 win against struggling AFC Scrumble while Olympiakos

made the most of the chances they created to run out 3-0 victors away to Ratcliff Rovers. The Heebies will be a little happier after their 4-0 victory against Red Storm as that's now allowed them a little bit of breathing room from the bottom 3.

ALE CAN CUT ROYAL OAK DOWN TO SIZE

Wigan Warriors have started the season well with Humphries setting the standard for other teams to follow and he has built a side that wouldn't be out of place in division 2, but today they were stifled by Ewood Eagles and it took an Iniesta goal just after the hour to give them a victory. Fellow promotes Confederates are right behind them but I'm not



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sure they'll stay there although the purchase of Serina might prove to be very shrewd business, this week's 3-0 victory against derby opponents Selsdon Utd certainly helps them in their aim of consolidating their position in the league as going for promotion may be a mistake. Newport Exiles are 3rd after their 0-0 draw against Comic City, this despite the fact that they have Sinatra & Morris orchestrating matters, but they were rendered toothless (as are many others) by City's massed defensive ranks. Ale Can City sit in 4th and with the players they have, they are more than capable of beating anyone, as Royal Oak found out to their cost with Ale Can beating them 6-4, with Royal Oak not able to cope with City's creativity. GKA Flugels are in 6th and while they are tight in defence, they find scoring goals next to impossible as is proven by the fact they have drawn 3 of their 6 games, including today's home match against Phoenix Reds. Ewood Eagles sit in 7th and like the Flugels, they are hard to score but they do have some class in their squad and if they get marked, like in today's 1-0 defeat to Wigan Warriors, they can get picked off though it still isn't that easy. Coniston Roves in 8th still need some competence in the manager's chair as the talented players in the squad need some guidance, and that was clear in today's 1-0 home defeat against Craigend Rovers. Royal Oak are 9th, and they are still getting to grips with their captain's retirement and they could have done with his calm head in their 6-4 defeat to Ale Can, they still have some talent so they'd hope to stay above the bottom 3 though it's going to be a challenge. Somehow, Phoenix Reds are 10th but I'm not sure why as for years now they've been challenging for promotion, but their team hasn't changed that much, though they are having issues scoring goals, as shown in their 0-0 draw against GKA Flugels. Comic City sit in 11th and it's easy to see why, they may have a strong defence, today's 0-0 draw against Newport Exiles proves that, but they have nothing else in their team to frighten opponents, but they will be grateful to see Hudson back in the dugout (as are we all) as they need strong management in the rest of the season. Oh how the mighty have fallen, Selsdon Utd sit bottom of the table, they have some talent in their squad but today they had no answer to the attacking talent and creativity of Confederates and can think themselves lucky that they only lost the game 3-0.

FIREFAL DULL THE SHINE OF THE GEMS

Since the start of the season, it has been pretty clear that Firefal Down FC have been the team to beat, not only do they score goals for fun, but anyone they play find them to be tight at the back as well and they ruthlessly exploited Redhill Gems weaknesses on their way to a 6-0 victory, though they've lost Sleepy Joe for a week after he twisted his ankle. Crockenhill Utd are currently matching Firefal stride for stride, but they don't have the same firepower the leaders have and are about

to come into a run of hard games so the question is, can they sustain this pressure, well as long as they can keep beating the weaker teams then they can go straight back up. Pacific Heights sit 3rd after a 1-0 victory away to Connaught FC, but they are going to need to be more clinical in front of goal as against a better side they could easily have dropped points today. Jakku Rebellion can be a bit hot and cold, but this week against Hawarden Castle, they were red hot on their way to a 5-0 win with all 5 goals coming in a 20 minute period straight after the break. In 5th are Barracuda Bay and after their 3-0 win against Bluorange Stars, they now are just a win away from the top 3 and the chance to finally rising back up the divisions and to revisit old glory times. Richmond Park sit 6th after a 5-0 thumping of Haybrook, and if they can a couple more players to the squad, then they could well fight for promotion, the talent is there. Northern Spark are in 7th after their 2-0 defeat against Crockenhill but they were missing a couple of players through injury and while they may still have lost, the score may have been closer. Redhill Gems are 8th but this is because they have no sort of creativity in their side but to counteract that, they are predominantly a ball winning side that knows the value of a good defence, they won't trouble the top 3 this season though but this week they were fortunate to finish the game with 11 men as they kicked anything that moved. The rebuilding Hawarden Castle sit in 9th with the manager slowly getting the team in the right state give them a chance of promotion next season. In 10th we have Bluorange Stars, and while they may not be bottom of the table, there's still work to be done here, but they are building from the back first to give them the chance of picking up points. Haybrook Ath have been ripped apart by their manager and are now in the process of rebuilding and as they are managed by Dave Hails, it's anyone's guess how long this might take but the signs are that they are improving. Connaught FC are rock bottom despite evidence to the contrary, they are showing some signs of improvement although it may take another season or 2 before they start challenging in the top half of the table.

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very tight game***Ale Can City will be wondering how they managed to lose 1-0 in their match against Craigend Rovers, as after Rovers scored, Ale Can had plenty of chances to get something out of the game but managed to spurn each and every one of them***Highbury Corner make short work of the tie against Red Storm as they dominate their opponents from the first whistle to the last and by the end of the game, they have run out 4-0 victors***another excellent victory for Firefal Down as earn themselves a seemingly comfortable 5-2 victory against Olympiakos, although the game was closer than the scoreline suggested***Uffington FC defeat Juventus 2-1 thanks to brace from Ymer with the goals coming at either end of the first half***Empire City take the scalp of derby rivals Lochend Thistle in their second round tie, scoring 3 goals in the first half as they strolled to a 4-0 victory, but they did lost Kompany to a late dismissal for a stupid challenge, taking a little of the sheen off the result***ICI Bolton ease their way to a 3-0 victory against Ratcliff Rovers with all the goals being scored in the first half. The matches between Jakku Rebellion/Comic City, Canine Rovers/Carleton City and Vitoria XI/GKA Flugels are all goalless and may well all go all the way to penalties.

This depends though on the relative levels of the players involved. A level two SW will get blown away by a level 12 FWT etc.

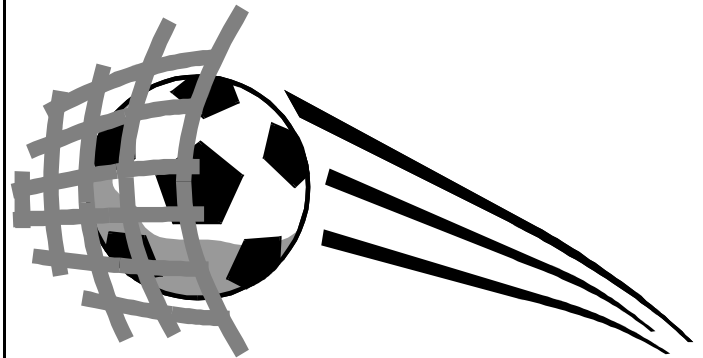

CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 /**
UT/WG/FWS x1.5 / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

· so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K
