



DAGGERS LOOKING SHARP

A mid-table clash between **Daggers** and **Paradisio** provided an enthralling encounter for both sets of fans as both sides looked to improve their current table positions and make a push to challenge for the top spots this season.

Paradisio, playing away from home came with a plan to contain and counter while **Daggers** also looked to keep it tight at the back, deploying sweeper SHAKY, who certainly was today and his performance must have given BARRETT the jitters all game.

However, it was **Daggers** who had the better of the first half nonetheless and they finally breach a determined **Paradisio** rearguard on 39 minutes as defender COLLINS flicks in a near-post corner to give them the lead. They double their advantage just a few minutes later from a MONTPARSNNE free-kick to take a 2-0 lead in to the half time break.

A stern half-time talk from manager PRESLAND produces immediate results as a fired-up **Paradisio** respond immediately after the re-start to pull 1 back through TEXARA, the midfielder side-footing home after some excellent approach play from the visitors but unfortunately for them, they can't capitalise on this excellent start and **Daggers** are able to re-group and settle down back in to the game, despite the visitors having the better of the possession for the remainder of the game.

Further chances fall to **Daggers** in the second half as they make better use of their time on the ball and their creative players start to turn on the style but some good goal-keeping from MIGNOLET keeps them at bay.

The game comes to end with the scoreline remaining unchanged and **Daggers** probably edged it and just about deserved the victory. This win sees them move up to 4th in the table, ahead of **Wycombe** courtesy of goal-difference and a promising season for them looks in the offing.

Trujillo continue their impressive start to the season. Newly promoted and tipped to be comfortable, they are certainly living up to early season expectations as they record an impressive victory over strugglers **Sofia Utd** although it took them until very late on to make the game safe as a stubborn rearguard action from the away side did very well.

Trujillo completely dominated this game and were on the front foot from the off but found the defence of **Sofia** a tough nut to crack and when they did open them up, they found themselves up against an inspired YARLOVO between the sticks who denied them again and again.

It took them until mid-way through the second half to turn their dominance in to something tangible, midfielder PEETERS finally beating YARLOVO at his near-post with an effort that the 'keeper will be disappointed he let in, in all truth. **Sofia** continued to defend stubbornly without offering anything up front to try and pull themselves back in to this one and a tiring back four are eventually breached once again late on in the game as forward IALYSOS finishes from close range to give his side a well-deserved victory.

A solid win for the home side today and manager SYMONDS will be delighted with his side's performance so far as they start to shape up nicely and I can see them achieving a comfortable mid-table finish this season with no problem.

A HEAVENLY HAT-TRICK FROM PRIEST

New Caledonia provide the shock of the session as they put **FC Crazy Town** to the sword courtesy of an inspiring performance by forward PRIEST.

Caledonia's attacking stance perfectly suited their star man today as he was given the freedom and the opportunity to showcase his skills as he stuns the opposition with a goal scored in the opening seconds of the match to send the home sides fans beserk.

His strike partner HOOIJDONK makes it 2 20 minutes later and **Caledonia** are on fire, attacking at will as **Crazy Town** completely fail to deal with them. Both players add a further goal apiece, a penalty converted by PRIEST after a hard and illegal tackle brings down winger COHEN on the edge of the box and **Caledonia** take a commanding and thoroughly deserved 4 goal lead going in to the break.

Crazy Town manage to rally somewhat in the second half but find it hard going to make any real impact in the game. However, a fine move just after the hour mark gives them a consolation effort when forward VETOKELE is put through, he calmly sidesteps the 'keeper before slotting home into an empty net.

Despite this, **Caledonia** continue to dominate proceedings and they are

rewarded for their efforts late on as **Priest** wraps up a fine performance, teasing the tired **Crazy Town** defenders before calmly sidefooting home.

Crazy Town just didn't turn up today and manager JORGENSEN is just going to have to take this one on the chin and hope his players put in a better performance next time.

Elsewhere, poor finishing and poor discipline sees **Inter Walls** drop points on their travels to **St Helens Town** who themselves couldn't take advantage against 9 man **Walls** as 2 red cards, one at the beginning of the game and one right at the end, dent their hopes of a victory.

Despite losing 2 players, **Walls** always looked the most likely to take the points here but a mixture of profligacy and a good performance from ELISHA between the sticks means that **Town** held on for a draw. **Town** did have their chances though and could have perhaps sneaked a win and this result is probably not going to please either manager but is probably fair considering all factors.

It does allow **Sunderland** to re-take the top spot though as they make no mistakes with their finishing and put 5 past a spiritless **Spiritus Santos**. The home side were always going to be up against it in this one, especially with OPUS DIE missing through suspension and **Sunderland** capitalised on this in no mean fashion. The score could have and perhaps should have been more but manager HUMPHRIES will be pleased with the result nonetheless.



OLYMPUS MAY HAVE FALLEN BUT OLYMPICS ARE RISING

Loftus Olympics take another small step on their journey back to the very top of the game. In a very even contest, played in the most appalling of conditions, it was **Olympics** who found a way to win. Both teams struggled to find consistency as they battled the elements as much as each other in this one and the conditions had a big part to play in the opening goal as a slip from defender LARSON, under pressure from forward GARDA, allows him to steal the ball and poke it home to open the scoring.

Edoras respond to this early set-back with determination and deservedly draw level, BOLOV finding the back of the net with a header as he moves to 5 for the season so far. An equal second half saw both sides create some good opportunities despite the conditions and this game was there for the taking for either team but it was **Olympics** who finally made the breakthrough, midfielder WISLOKA crashing home a header in the 85th minute to give **Olympics** the points.

Tough result for **Edoras** manager MCAULAY as this game could have gone either way and he will feel they deserved something at least from today. For **Olympics**, it does point to the fact that they have finally steadied the sinking ship and although still a long way from port, it is an encouraging sign that they are back on track and heading once again in the right direction.

Harleys continue their seemingly unstoppable march towards 3rd division dominance with a blistering 6-1 victory away from home against **Hobbiton**. The home side went in to this one missing 2 important players through injury and the timing couldn't have been worse for them to be honest.

Forced in to playing a youngster at the back and another one in midfield, they were simply overwhelmed, the gulf between the 2 sides more apparent given that **Harleys** were also bereft of 2 key players but this fact didn't slow them down at all as they simply tore into their opposition. Goals from all sections of the team and from 6 different players, highlight the quality at their disposal at the moment.

SASKATCHEWAN, already on 13 so far this season, opened the scoring for them but perhaps the most impressive of all their goals was the last one from LUBI-LOUB LEWIS, latching on to a delightful through-ball, he finished with composure and style, a fitting end to a complete performance. **Hobbiton** did manage a consolation goal in the 78th minute as BLOIS manages to poke one home after a rare display of sloppiness from the home side but that was all it was ever going to be.

A disappointing result for manager BUTLER, recently appointed to the helm but it's not all doom and gloom as some real progress has already been made at the club and things are starting to improve and I don't think it will be too long again before the fans have something to sing about.

Down at the bottom, **Snowdonia** take a vital 3 points against **Red Star Korova**, a result made more significant as it was away from home to move them out of the relegation places. Set up not to lose, they made one opportunity to score early in the first half a long, dipping drive from PETROV catching the **Korova** 'keeper by surprise and never ventured forward again!

Korova did have some opportunities to level the game but never really did enough and manager HAILS will be delighted with the result.

TOP TEAMS KEEP IT TIGHT

Four out of the top 5 teams in the division won their games this session and not only won but did so comfortably to perhaps highlight the gulf in quality that is becoming more and more apparent in this division between the top and bottom halves.

The only top side to lose were **Hutnik AS** who took on leaders **Cheam Chargers** in the one-to-watch match of the session. **Hutnik** tried to shut down their opponents by employing a zonal marking system which, though effective, simply wasn't enough here today to curb a **Cheam** side on top of their game.

With the home side seemingly unwilling to come forward, it was left down to **Cheam** to do the attacking and, although they found it tough going, they still had enough quality to create chances. It took them over half an hour to finally make the breakthrough though as MARKEL opens the scoring for them with a powerful drive from the edge of the box.

Despite this set-back, **Hutnik** were still unwilling to throw men forward and the defended doggedly, not allowing their opposition many clear cut chances at all but were breached again in the second half on 55 minutes when HOLTZ makes it 2 with a long drive taking a wicked deflection to wrong-foot the 'keeper.

Following this, **Cheam** continued to press and **Hutnik** could do little more than continue to defend, finding it very difficult to commit men forward to try and rescue the game. This inevitably led to a 3rd goal being scored for the away side as HAALAND scores on the death with a snap shot.

A deserved, if somewhat flattering victory for **Cheam** here as **Hutnik** certainly didn't deserve to concede 3 but **Cheam** did deserve to win.

Perhaps "The Best Of The Rest" accolade may belong to **Sleeping Woods** this year. Granted, they didn't pull up any trees this session but are looking far better than they did this time last season and still managed a creditable draw against **NLP Redstox** despite having three out through injury.

Redstox have yet to find the form that I was so sure they would capture this season and didn't do enough here against **Sleeping Woods** to win the game as neither side really looked confident in coming forward, taking a few risks and capturing all 3 points.

No real chances to speak of and although both teams were competent at defending and did well to nullify their opposition, they were distinctly poor at pushing on, a factor I can understand from **Woods** given their selection woes.

Granted, **Redstox** also has some selection worries but they were still able to field a very competitive side and I am failing to understand manager STOCKS' mindset at the moment.

So the game ends in a goal-less draw, a result which out of the 2, manager BUTLER will be the most pleased with I am sure.

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CONTRACTS UPDATE

We have listened to the moaners who in contract negotiations have lost very good players cos they cannot get them to agree to a new contract. Galling to see their prized possession in the expired section of the autumn. Ok you will no doubt get some recompense for him, but the reserve bid is always painfully low and you never never know who might snaffle his arse with a cheeky bid do you.

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **DF/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

We suggest that you always add 1K to your bids

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K
