DIVISION 1 ROUNDUP

In top spot we see **Netherton FC**, not tipped for anything at the beginning of the season, but looking good at the moment, although the league cup defeat will be a disappointment to manager Smith, who would have hoped for more. A talented midfield, including three star specialists as well as young FEDERER, the league's joint top scorer in MURPHY, and a mean defence, and things are looking very good here. There is the usual smattering of special youth coming through the academy, and wages are pretty good too. There is even some cash available for strengthening further, and I for one expect them to still be at the top come seasons end, and certainly up there fighting again next year as well.

Just behind them though are **Dore Utd**, Tipped to be champions, and rated as the best team in the league, they have slipped from the top spot they held for so long. However, they are only just behind Netherton, and so I am sure Craig won't be too worried just yet. What he might be worried about though, is the lack of star players, only two so far, and an ageing squad, one of the oldest in the league in fact. Their forward line of BLACK, DRAMVQUIST and CLARKE are brilliantly creative, scoring a pile of goals between them, but Dore are not as strong defensively as their rivals. The youth academy is gleaming, with some fruit to show from it, and wages are the best in the league, thanks to that early season wage negotiation purchase. It will be interesting, though, to see how that works out when more than half of the squad are trying to renegotiate contracts as the season draws towards a close. Manager Lawton may need to be at his wily best when that comes around.

Slipping slightly further behind come **Bugman Rangers** and manager Ashcroft. Losing to Netherton this week means they are now down to third, but this is still a highly encouraging season for the great allotmenteer. A team that likes to exploit the strengths of both power and skill, the midfield is strong, and has benefited from star fairy dust already. Already there are three 18 year olds playing first team football, with another one close as well. However, there is not much cash, and the youth facilities could do with a spruce up, but with so many matches being played, it is often hard to focus on all areas. However, this is a well-rounded squad with a bright future ahead.

In 4th, sneaking under the radar slightly, come **Northern Town** under the guiding hand of manager Craven. He has a large squad, which still needs a little sorting out, but they are performing well, the likes of goal poacher KIEV, and boss man in the midfield GOVERNOR INCCIE leading the way. Unlike some of their rivals, there is a great deal of youth evident in midfield, which bodes well for the future, though I wonder whether there is sufficient coaching time available for all of the talent that Craven has, though this week's derby win will help. This includes young keeper KRIEGER, coming through to replace CALLAGHAN, who could be seen really as the only weak link in this talented side.

Next up come **Danetown FC**, who thoroughly enjoyed their double header with Nacional this week, scoring 13 goals without reply in the two games. An extremely talented side this one, with no fewer than five midfield specialists. But the thing that really stands out looking at the squad on paper are the wages. True, this is really down to two greedy individuals, but you know how it is, once one gets paid 75k a week, they all want it. Manager Humphries will have to work to bring that wage bill down or he will be struggling to find any cash for future purchases. However, with the likes of SUNG-YOO and O'BONGO always in the goals, he probably won't worry too much just yet.

Completing the top half of the table, and I have to say, these are all incredibly talented teams, with an amazing array of talent on display every week, we have **Thomoslavia Utd**. Thommo has brought together a pretty well full power-skill team, built around the powerhouse that is DAVOS LECHEROIU after his recent transfer. The manager will be disappointed with dropped points against Ackworth this week, and will be looking for more ruthlessness from his squad in putting away the chances they get. They are not high scorers, and so some work may need to be done in this area. The stadium could also do with some expansion, as fans are being turned away from every home game at the moment. Other than that, the manager can be fairly satisfied with life at the moment.

Into the bottom half of the table, and first up it's **Geographic FC**, where it seems to be scoring goals that is the biggest problem. Only 9 goals scored in the league this season, with three of those this week, tells the story. There are a couple of stars, and a few teenagers coming through, but so far all of the key players have been left well alone by the star fairy.



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Keeper BELFAST and midfielder ASIF though have already signed up for next year, and the wage bill is being tightly managed, so definitely some positives here.

Just behind them in 8th place are **Elterwater Rovers**, and they are, to be fair, a bit of a conundrum. On paper, a hugely talented team, with a strong midfield quintet, yet, on the park, they just are not able to compete to the expected level. Some players just do not seem to be pulling their weight, or is it that the managers instructions are too complicated? Just to pick on one player - top striker JIGALO JENSON has yet to score a goal, despite playing 20 games this season. However, their problem probably lies in the fact they do not have a single box-to-box midfielder, despite the talents on show. Maybe, Mr Brooks, it is time to cash in on some of the fringe players, in order to make a real push for the type of player that is going to take the team to the next level?

In 9th place are **CFC Santos** and manager Steadman. Two defeats this week, including against close rivals Elterwater leave them slipping towards relegation. In truth though, they should be too good for that, but the manager needs to work on getting skipper BONSU back towards his best. It's a chicken and egg situation though. Without winning games, he can't be coached, but will they win games if he's not coached? A real head scratcher for the manager. However, a good number of stars, four in total, good wages and money in the bank all point to a bright future, if the manager can work out how best to use them.

Another manager with some thinking to do is Overli at **Nacional** who find themselves worryingly in the relegation spots, in 10th place. There is a small squad here, but with three top midfielders. The only problem is that two of them need serious coaching, and this weeks displays against Danetown show just how far short this team is of where they need to be. The squad is also not the youngest, and with their only star being a 19 year old, there is much in the way of thinking to be done. It may be that a couple of seasons in division 2 may help them to come back stronger?

In 11th we have **Aliens Utd** and Jason Reid. In truth, they don't look in such bad shape as their position would suggest, it is just that this is a very strong division. PADDY O'RILEY continues to lead the way, with a good number of talented star players around him, including the tempestuous target man DE STROY, who walks a tightrope very week, with the fear of a lifetime ban never far away. Despite the quality in the team, they have only scored 1 (yes, one) goal in the league this season, and so look destined for relegation. The overdraft also has the bank manager nervous, but it will soon be cleared by selling off the youth team!

At the foot of the table, then, coming **Ackworth** and manager Moore. How the giants have fallen, when this once great

Martin Dakin team now sit at the bottom, pointless before this week, and pretty well relegated already. The manager continues to strive for improvement though, busy in the transfer market, trying to change the team's fortunes. However, with only 10 fit players to choose from, it is no wonder that they are struggling to even draw matches, let alone win them. But there was a draw this week, so let's celebrate that, a first point of the season. Continue to focus on the youth, and next season may go better for you, Mr Moore.

Wow, what a season **Dumnonia City** are having, leading the way in division 2 and taking a famous scalp in the league cup this week as well. Three top class midfielders hold it all together, goals galore from golden duo , CALVET and ROMA and one of the tightest defences in the division all bode well for manager Read. I can't see them being caught this season, unless skipper MCSTAY, holding out for a new contract, goes through with his threat to walk out on the club unless he gets the new jaguar that he wants as part of his new deal. Will the manager loosen the purse strings enough to keep hold of the top man? There is good youth being developed here in MCGETTEY, MCBRIDE and SALFORD, but will it all fall apart? Should he MCSTAY or should he MCGo?

And second place, and some way second, come **Glasgow Celtic**, ably led by manager Presland. Old man GANST continue to lead the way, weighing in regularly with his goals from midfield. Two other midfield specialists and goal-getter MCAVENNIE mean that promotion is well within their grasp. However, there is not much youth to be seen in the squad, only one youngster anywhere near the first team, and stars few and far between. I hate to say it Kev, but promotion may bring it's share of pain next season.

Just behind them come the talented **Yorkshire Rams**, but with a game in hand over the teams above them. Some key players have already starred, including talisman BENKAT, and now that FRED is back and available, things are looking very bright for the Rams. There is a fair blend here of youth and experience, but Manager McAuley will want to be doing more to develop the youth squad further. Otherwise, a great job being done.

Next up, in 4th place are manager Armstrong and his **FC United Boys**. They are pushing the top three hard, but may



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just lack the edge of quality that the teams above them have. NEWMONT and FAARAGE are their keys in midfield, both recent arrivals to the squad, but Colly could do with adding to that midfield in some way. It would also be good to have a captain with more experience, as NEWMONT isn't always able to gee the team up as well as an older player might be. That said, they are a tough nut to crack, with the best defence in the division, so will remain there or thereabouts this season.

In 5th place are **Anfield Rovers**, tipped for the top, but so far falling short. Their manager has invested well in the youth academy, and apart from one notable exception, got wages well under control. Young LEHMANN is the main source of goals, being well-supported, when able, by attacking wingback VAN WILDRODE, but could really do with some more support. Maybe a winger might also help the team to score more goals? A few too many journeymen hanging around the squad that could be moved on, but looking fair for mid-table safety.

In 6th, in this congested part of the table, are **Uranium Youth** under the oversight of manager Napier. Some quality players here, most notably in the centre of the park and in the forward line, but again, too many hangers-on who need to be shifted out to allow the young blood to come through. Young Dakha has made it into the first team, but keeper SHOKKA lives up to his name too often, and surely a replacement needs to be found soon.

In 7th come **Limetrees Utd**, a team who surely should be higher than this? There are a couple of stars and already three 18 year olds playing regular first team football which all bodes well. Wages are tight, AMSTERDAMMER looks like a good player for the future, but there is a distinct lack of other coachable players in the squad at the moment. Maybe it's time for manager Cranfield to enter the transfer market for more youth to add to this tight squad.

Next come **Bedford House**, where manager Symonds has taken a real gamble, bringing in injury prone midfielder ZACYNTHUS. It will be interesting to see how the manager is able to nurture him through the rest of this season, especially with that near million pound overdraft hanging over him. CRODARSHAN and FROND continue to call the shots, and are both so impressed with this manager and this club that they have agreed to carry on playing next year as well. With the likes of CULLINAN and COOLONGOLOOK also coming through, the only way is up for this team, and I expect them to finish significantly higher than 8th.

In 9th, and starting to look in some trouble, are **Grafar Mill FC** and manager Miller. DIABLO JNR continues to lead the team here, though on occasion seems somewhat out of his depth. There is a mix of skilful and powerful players in the squad as well as some good youngsters being introduced. As with all of these teams towards the bottom, the defence is porous, letting in 8 goals in two games this week. On the plus side, there is some cash stored away, in this somewhat cash light league, which could be used to further strengthen and to help with the push away from the bottom.

In 10th place are **Temple City**, deeply overdrawn, as one would expect from Mr Stevens, but with a large squad that can be trimmed to cut the debt. This is a team that likes to attack, and two attacking midfielders bolster this attacking ploy. However, there is only one star, so the manager Stevens will need to increase his youth development, as well as praying for more stars, otherwise next season will be very painful.

Sliding below, and now down to 11th are **AFC Broadway**, a team who seem to already be preparing for life in the third division. There has been a great push for youth, with THORNE, SHEEP, BREITNER and MCALLISTER being brought into the first team over recent weeks, and more on the way. No cash, and lots of mid-level players tells a grim story and the manager is going to need to be imaginative to turn this around.

Bottom placed **Kirkdeen Utd** are beginning to worry the teams above them, picking up a 5-2 win this week, to give them just their second win this season. They have quality players in NEILO BADDIO and QUIZCRANS HOOPLA and if the likes of CHILLI and ROBERTS can be brought on quickly, there may well yet be time for Kirkdeen to preserve their 2nd division status.

Pushing them though, are **Marx Men** in 4th place. Tipped to do well, and having recently beaten Margate Beach, manager Mansell can be happy with progress here. The purchase of midfielder PASTEUR will further bolster them, and if he can be quickly brought up to speed, he maybe able to lead them in an end of season push. PADDYBOYO and KIPKOECH are the key men in the squad, and Mansell will be hoping for at least one of them to star before the end of the season as well. Promotion is probably beyond them this season, but fairly well set for next (I hope!!!!)

Young SERDAL is coming through to replace REICH in goal, while everything else that goes on in the team revolves around (D)BEECH. Other than that, there are warning signs for sure. The squad is ageing, there is not much youth to be seen, and not much cash either. I think maybe a period of rebuilding might be needed.

Colour Athletic are in 8th place, another Paul Stevens team, with another sizeable overdraft. There are also lots of young players in the squad, some of whom are being brought through the replace the older players who can be sold off to clear the debt. YAMAHA is still the kingpin here, but he is getting older, and the manager will be hoping he is still around next season to guide the younger blood in learning their trade. Mid-table again Paul I am afraid.

In 9th are **Denmrak Arsenal**, where manager Dempsey has managed to build a full P/S team, and so there is obvious talent on show. Unfortunately, there is not enough to really bring about the results that are demanded by this club. From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

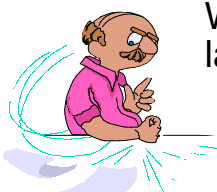

For others you do the same except put the league, name with Ka- in front of +subscribe.

One thing to note about subscribing to the list, we post a regular schedule of where every league is in the processing schedule, when it is sent out, when the latest return-by-date is. This is of great help and if you have email you should really be receiving this.

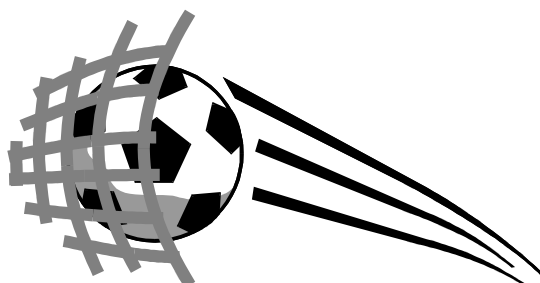

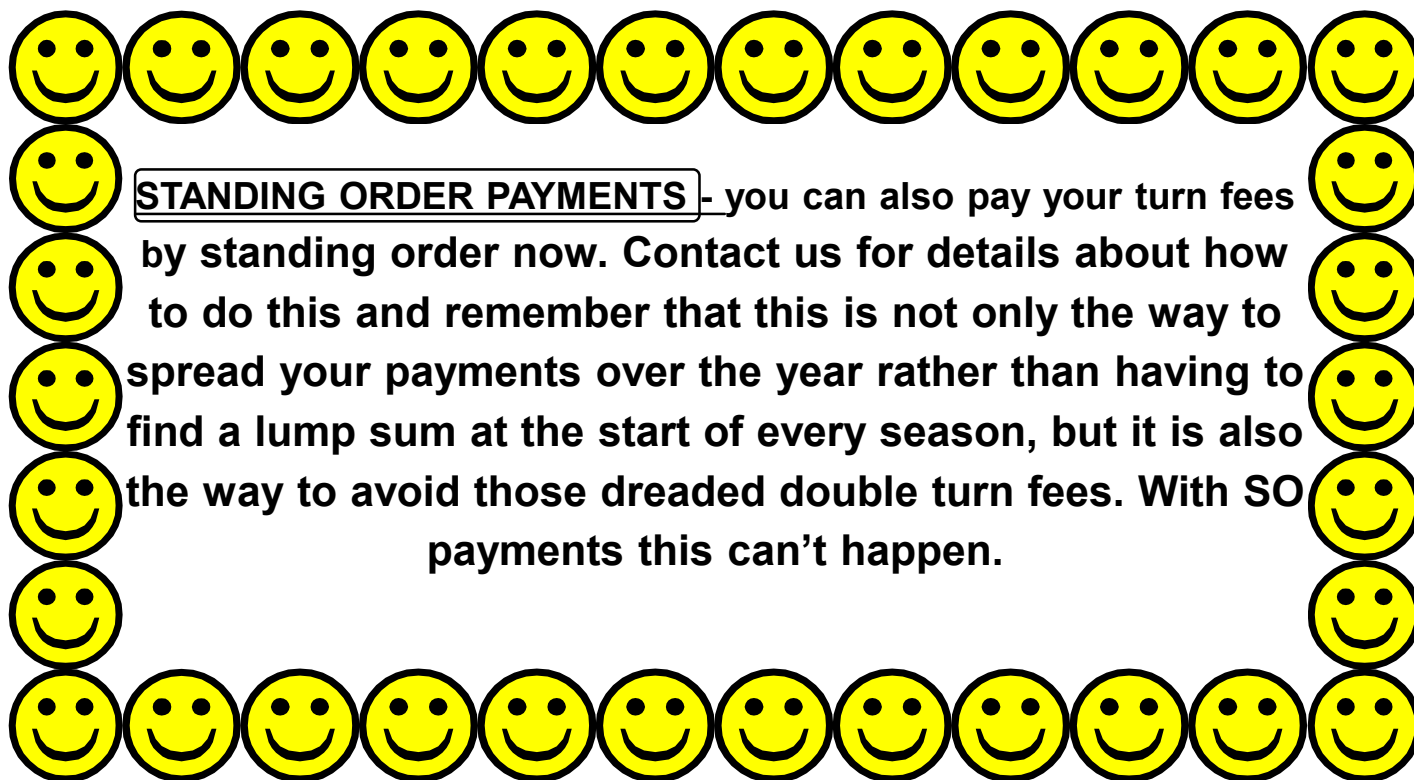

THE WADDERS ADVICE COLUMN

There is a very full description of each specialist player in the rulebook, and perhaps it stands re-reading very now and again, lest we forget what they all do and how to get the best out of your team. Everything has to fit. How many of you have decided to play positive and five-man attack and then included a SW and MF/A only to find that both these players don't play to their full potential?? How many of you have a team full of midfield specialists and find that there is no room for those DF/A's to speed up and down the flanks cos there is no room for them to play?? .

FADERS - these players should be considered as those common real-life types, the injury-prone' footballer. The Darren Anderton and Jon Woodward type of player, always beset by injury. In effect a fader doesn't add experience every time he plays, he loses it, so gradually, unless trained, his performance level will reduce. Obviously this raises a different set of problems for the manager. Do I train him, where do I train him too, and when is his level going to reduce (galling indeed when you rain him and the same session he loses that level). It's even worse if he is a specialist who costs more levels to rain in the first place. Still, faders often cost much less to buy and put into your team, and aren't to be dismissed out of hand like some do. Remember as well that once they get to level twelve they **DO NOT** fade any further as long as they don't get injured.

A problem arises though if they go star as fading will start again and when they do fade they will go to a level eleven as losing a level has to reduce their performance level by one, and you can't have a level eleven star thus the star status goes. Training them to thirteen is always a good idea, but this might be an on-going thing as they lose a level at various times during the season! Better though to have a level 13 fading star than a level six ordinary player??

Another thing to remember about faders is that they **ALWAYS** stay faders. There are five levels of fader, from low fader to 'do you really don't want one of them' type of fader. At the end of every season a fading star slips down from where he was to the next worse level so over time a fading star is going to become worse and more difficult to handle. When he reaches the bottom rung he stays there for the rest of his career, hugging the bench and taking his wages, so to speak, until you get rid of him. Of course, every now and again there are different times in the auction that might well assuage these problems, but that's in the lap of the Gods isn't it??.

RISERS - risers, of course, are the type of player that everybody wants. This type of player rises automatically with games played in terms of performance levels. In effect he receives an enhanced experience game every time he plays which means his level will rise much faster than through normal experience. As with faders there are five separate levels of risers, Every season a riser will decrease one level from his starting level and when he gets to the lowest level then the following season he will revert to a normal player and lose any rising status that he had. It is important to remember this when buying a riser, even worse there is no way to know what level a riser (or a fader) is currently at when you buy him. Through the auction you are given 'some' idea but often it isn't very clear.

Please realise with both risers and faders that the amount of added experience that a player gains or rises each turn is random, modified by his age and fader/ riser level. Thus rising and fading will never be a fixed, quantifiable amount, it is bound to vary. The number of moans about 'my riser has stopped rising', or "my fader has started to fade twice as fast as earlier in the season' are easily explained if you keep this in mind.

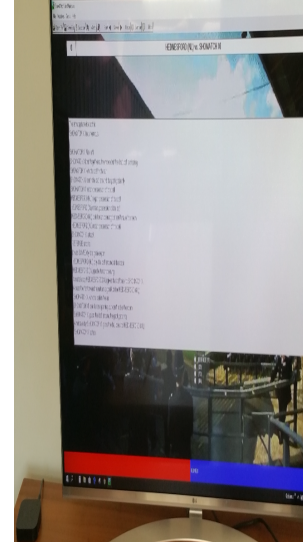

KICKABOUT MUSINGS & MEANDERINGS

During the course of the veterans ageing there was alot of discussion regarding how the ageing works. Obviously few of you have any idea, those who have had it explained at weekends have forgotten it, others just pick numbers out of the ether.

Well ageing works as follows:-

Each player has two factors. One is his skill level, the second is his experience quotient (which unless he is a fader, will go up each session. I.e., a player looks to you as if he is, say, a level 9, but hidden from you is his experience fraction, so he might be a level 9.2 or a level 9.8.

When we get to the dreaded ageing. The computer takes his skill level, i.e. the 9 part, and performs the ageing percentage decrease on this. , for example perhaps the skill level drops to 6.75.

THEN, and this is important, it adds the experience level back to this figure, so you don't actually lose the players experience.

Let's say this player was 9.2, this would make him a 6.95. But if he were a 9.8 it would make him 7.55.

So you can see that it is not really possible to know what a player's aged level will be because of experience (OK, you can make a guess perhaps if he has an asterisk by hi name, i.e. his experience is high and about tor rise and reckon that he might well be 7 rather than six but you never know
