DAGGERS DENIED ONCE MORE

DAGGERS FC 1-5 FC SPROUT

Once again this season, these 2 sides meet in a cup final and once again, **Daggers** manager BARRETT had to try to find a way to beat the machine known as **FC Sprout** and he bravely went with a change of tactic from their League Cup defeat to try and take their opponents by surprise, this time playing with a big midfield in an attempt to control the game from the centre.

Once again though, **Sprout** take full control of the game despite their opponent's tactical changes and with wingback RICTER breaking the **Daggers** offside trap almost at will, it wasn't long before **Sprout** had taken the lead through who else but SPUDEYESASHCINS as he gets on the end of a far post cross from RICTER, who had torn down the line to deliver an inch-perfect ball. Just a minute later, he is on the scoresheet once again, this time his long-range effort taking a deflection before finding it's way into the bottom corner and things are starting to look desperate for **Daggers**.

A third from VEN GLYND in the 51st makes it safe for **Sprout** and despite **Daggers** pulling one back just before the hour-mark, a comeback never really looked likely and it is **Sprout** who end the game strongly, scoring 2 more before the final whistle to make the final score 5-1 and bringing them one step closer to another treble-winning season.

BOTAFOGO GO CLOSE BUT SPROUT HOLD OUT

Final game of the final session and it is tied at the top, with only goal difference separating the top 2 and if **Botafogo** had any chance of snatching the title, they would need to get something out of their game while hoping that somehow **Sprout** were going to lose away or perhaps at least are held to a draw at **Borussia Wigan**.

Botafogo completed the first half of that challenge as they won by a single goal away to **Club Paradisio** who made it very difficult for the hopeful champions and could well have won the game, with manager PRESLAND quite rightly stating afterwards that they were certainly worth a point out there today but a headed goal by defender MILLER was enough to take the spoils for **Botafogo**.

A completely different scenario for **Sprout** in their game though as they emphatically lay claim to the title with a 10-0 drubbing of opponents **Borussia Wigan**. From the first whistle, this one never looked in any doubt as one again it's that man SPUDEYESASHCINS who starts the landslide, scoring after just 3 minutes to send his team on their way. **Wigan** never got a look in to be honest as **Sprout** make sure of this one and lift the trophy in style. Well done, Mr SMITH on another outstanding campaign.

Commiserations to manager STEADMAN whose **Botafogo** side pushed **FC Sprout** all the way this season, with very little separating the 2 sides apart from perhaps SPUDEYESASHCINS being the difference, he has been a talisman for **Sprout** for the last couple of seasons and it makes you wonder what might have been if STEADMAN had bought him rather than SMITH getting his hands on him?

Saints were also another free-scoring side this session as they put 7 past a **Wycombe** side who have been no pushovers for most of the latter part of this season. Injuries to key players hampered both teams this session but it was **Saints** who were able to better fill the gaps and they dominated this one from the off.

With both sides playing big midfields, the middle of the park was somewhat congested at times but **Saints** adapted better and won the battle here which allowed them to pile on the pressure. GIANNINO opens the scoring after just 5 minutes, perfectly reading a headed flick-on to put him through on goals, 2 minutes later he pops up again to score his second and, before the half time whistle, he has claimed his hat-trick with an own-goal from COSTA (A) making the scoreline 4-0 to the away side.

COSTA (A) who had obviously been having a bad day, then gets his marching orders soon after the re-start as **Wycombe** threaten to implode and **Saints** take full

advantage, scoring 3 more before the final whistle. **Wycombe** pull back a consolation goal with 2 minutes left but that was the highlight of their afternoon and manager READ will want to forget this performance as soon as he can.

Confirmation this session also, of **Immortals FC's** miraculous escape from relegation which leaves **Inter Walls, Wymondham** and **Santos** playing 2nd division football next season.

PROMOTION NOT REQUIRED?

Neck and neck in the second also as **Centurions** and **Sofia** take it down to the wire and with both sides winning the status quo doesn't change. **Centurions** go up as champions while **Sofia** have to settle for runners-up spot solely by dint of goal difference.

Trujillo grab the third promotion place despite taking a battering against **Hawtonville** who beat them 7-1 to finish the season in 4th and it does seem that nobody really wanted that 3rd place finish but it has fallen to **Trujillo** who may well find themselves coming straight back down?

Another fine win for **Snowdonia** this session against **St Helen's Town** who certainly weren't helped by some awful marking jobs but it isn't enough for them to escape the clutches of relegation. They have had a little bit of a purple patch towards the end of the season and manager HAILS has done a good job putting together a decent squad here. However, there are a few players who are starting to feel the years and while I think that **Snowdonia** may be much more competitive next season, just how much more is going to depend on the close-season ageing for sure.

Olympics fall for second consecutive season, despite given a "free pass" in their game against **Sunderland** but will be a lot more competitive next year that's for sure. Manager CRANFIELD also has quite a tidy sum still tucked away and if it's spent wisely, a possible return to the second may not be beyond their reach?

Not such good news for **Hobbiton** though I am afraid, recently taken over by the esteemed BUTLER, they are going to struggle again next year I think but at least now they are being given an overhaul, there is a core of youth to build on, there is also some cash to spend as well and so it's not all doom and gloom.

CITY BOYZ BOUYED UP

Much more competitive in the 3rd with all the promotion spots eagerly contested and it's **City Boyz** that are

going up in top spot, an achievement fully deserved this season. They have led the table from the very beginning and the side is looking in excellent shape to face the challenges of division 2 next season.

Separated only by goal difference, it's **Forest Island** and **Marseille** who go up with them. Some excellent work by manager LAWTON done to the **Forest** squad this season means that they should be competitive next year but, as always, there is that caveat on which player rejuvenates and if the right one does, I see no problems for them in division 2 next season.

Marseille couldn't take advantage of **Forest Island's** draw this session to nick second spot as they lose to **Edoras** but I don't think that's going to worry manager SCOTT too much. What should be of more concern is the overdraft, which is starting to mount up and could see what is an excellent side have the heart ripped out of it to pay off debts.

If SCOTT can keep his side together then I can see them being very competitive, a lack of cash may well hinder a serious title challenge but who knows?

Hutnik being relegated this season is a bit of a shock for me, I certainly didn't see that one coming but it's a very competitive 3rd division and somebody had to go down, I suppose but the words "too good to go down" are certainly floating about in my head. The good news is that there's plenty of talent in the squad and some money available as well.

Dragon, cruelly abandoned by their manager and left to the tender mercies of the newsletter writer before once more finding a manager, also drop but the good news is that the side is now fully re-built with a bucketload of cash to spend as well so things are looking much rosier for this side next year.

IFK Didi also face the drop, unmanaged until very recently, they are still very much a work in progress but there is progress being made slowly and now with WELLS at the helm, this club can look forward to a revival in its fortunes.

HEROES CLEAR

A strong division 4 also meant that the promotion place competition went down to the wire with multiple teams involved right up to the end.

Harleys top the group and were always going to win it, manager LAWTON has built a really good side here that should remain very competitive for a number of seasons to come yet and I can see them winning the 3rd next year as well.

Second place between **Red Star Karova** and **Sandwich Town** was only settled by goal difference in the end, both teams winning this session as they needed to if they weren't going to be pipped by 4th placed **Purley Kings**, who have had a great season.

Karova's manager ABRAHAM has done a great job here this season but will be sweating on the rejuvenation of one or two players come close season if they are to have a truly great season next year and a decision on TRUST will have to be made next year as well I think?

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

NB In teampick trophy games come after League Cup it appears. Please realise that they don't. In the fullness of time the temapick maestro will change this

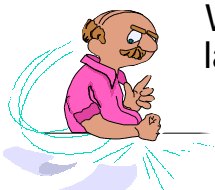

MARKING UPDATE

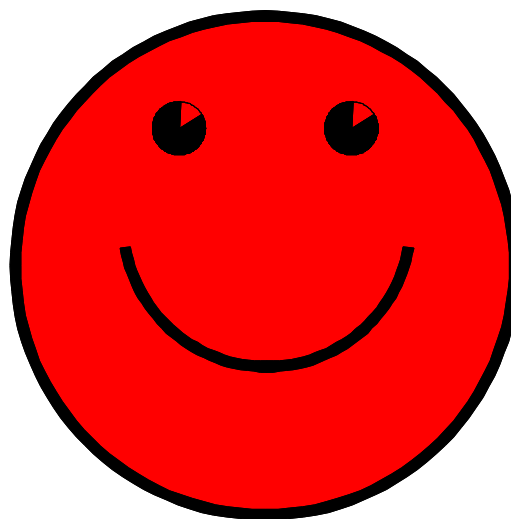

Teampick is a program available for all PC owners who have windows on their machine. It allows you to manipulate your team on screen to look at differing formations and conditions. This automatically works out the factors which will affect your team, helps prevent errors, and all sorts of things into the bargain. It also prints out your team sheet, and you can then get the program to format an Email team sheet for submitting instead of the normal order sheets, if you so choose. The program also has an on-line rulebook, i.e., you can dial up the relevant section of the rulebook at the click of the mouse and read that part of the rules while selecting your team. If you can't remember how the weather affects things, when your captain moves onto an extra level, or the formulas that govern transfer negotiations and marking, well just ask the computer! Subscribers also get a .kik file which upgrades your team details every session as well making it even easier for you. Even better news is that the program is FREE to all players who sign up for Shomatch.

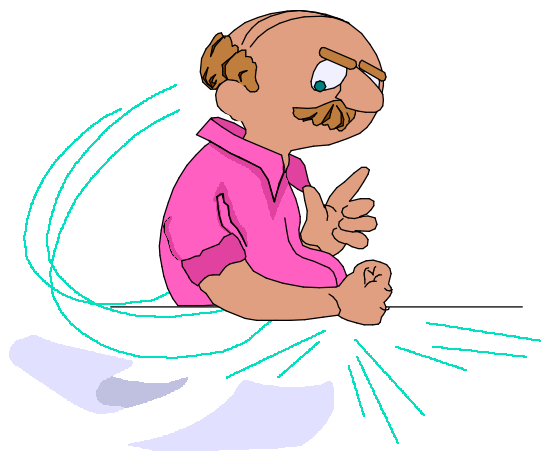

SHOMATCH

For those who don't already know Shomatch is our very own tele-printer in which you get the results, the newsletter and league tables on it, plus a minute by minute printout of the state of your game. Nail-biting to watch if you've got a particularly important game to play. Far better, and definitely more nerve-wracking than just tearing the newsletter open and seeing your fate decided in the flash of a micro-second. This is only available to those who have email players as everything is sent to you as an email which shomatch interprets and displays to you on your PC screen. But not only do you get the tele-printer printout and the league tables, but we send you a number of extra files which include the results, suspensions, Euro results, international results, rep results and the like. All of these can be displayed and watched as they tick through minute by minute as well. Thanks to the programming skills of Paul Sutton, shomatch now runs under windows, with pictures, sound effects and the like making it an even more gripping experience for the real masochists amongst you!!

If you are playing the game from abroad by Email, and who doesn't receive any hardcopy newsletters (mainly those who are playing from outside of continental Europe, MUST purchase shomatch as it is via this that we send your results, newsletters (in PDF format now), and the like. It's up to the rest of you whether you subscribe to this and get your results earlier than the hardcopy comes out. But for the overseas player it is a boon allowing them a little bit extra time to complete their orders - something that they were always moaning about in the past!

What is the cost then. Well you have to pay a single fee of £17.95 which covers a season of sign-ups for Shomatch. For this you get all the information above, and for this one fee you can request shomatch and related details for any league you want to. If you need to re-do a team for some reason then all you get is 100 levels + 100K, , please contact us before you re-do any team to talk about it.
