CAGEY

CHARLATANS 0:1 BLACKBURN RVRS

A good 1st Division side against a good 4th Division side, not much between them, similar style management too! Both sides employed sweepers and **Blackburn** decided to play safety first and try and grab something on the break, **Charlatans** tried to pack the midfield, and overwhelm the 4th division upstarts. In fact chances were remarkably equal, with **Charlatans** perhaps edging the midfield battle. KING however does not need midfield domination, and it was a direct ball from the back as he ran past the two central defenders and past the despairing dive of DODGE to slot home late in the first half. **Charlatans** did try and drag themselves back into it, but found themselves prevented by STARK or, when they finally got past him, frustrated by CRUSADER. A fine victory for the 4th Division leaders.

RAPIDE ESCAPE

Bolton Wands already champions, and **Croydon** maintained second, both will be strong contenders next season too, though **Bolton** are perhaps stronger than ever and will look to dominate next year.

Rapide Rapace pick up a good point away to **World News** who were the more creative of the two sides, but could not translate that into dominance. The visitors stayed in the game and it was actually **World News** who eventually scrapping for a point picked up the equaliser in 6 with just 9 minutes left. **World News** ending up probably disappointed with 6th position, but perhaps quite well placed for next season.

This meant that a win for **Cryogenix** could mean **Rapide** disaster. However the news was that **Whitestar** had continued their excellent form and dominated away to **Cryogenix** they picked up a 2:4 victory that frankly could have been a lot more convincing, but means they pick up 3rd spot in the top division, an impressive first season since promotion.

Charlatans beat **Belmont** 1-0 in a fairly even game of limited chances, which means they end up 4th, with Belmont finishing 7th, not bad since promotion at all. **Charlatans** do look like they may

be in a better position to challenge next season however.

Martino end up 8th, after a disappointing draw away to **Owlerton** who end up with an excellent 5th position after promotion.

Cryogenix, **Purple Hearts** and **Crusaders** all drop to Division 2, of those **Crusaders** will have the bigger rebuild, but the manager is clearly putting some good building blocks in place already. **Purple Hearts** could be a good bet for an immediate return to the top division.

HANNOVER SNEAK IT

Firstly away to bottom placed **Anfield Stars** the visitors **Hannover96** absolutely dominate, and criminally only come away with a three goal win. Then in their rearranged game, they welcomed **Red Star Cevile**, and although they still dominated it was fortunate that they scored as early as the 2nd minute, because try as they might they could not score another, but a win it was. That meant that despite winning at home **St Peters** who won by a single goal (again completely dominating the visitors) they came 2nd as their goal difference was just one shy of **Hannover96**. However, their rapid return to the 1st Division will have pleased their fans, and on paper they look well placed for the challenge of that division.



KICKABOUT NEWS

Final promotion spot goes to **Nelsoners** who had visited **St Peters** and put up such good resistance and they were already assured of promotion despite anyone else's efforts.

Istel Palace travelled to 11th placed **Wolfpack** and were beaten by two goals to one, but to be honest it could have been more, this meant that **Red Star Cevile** having lost their rearranged game could not get past **Istel** in the league whatever they did, which was lose to **Wycombe Town** anyway, though they made a much better showing in this game despite losing by two goals to nil.

The Family Cat end up 4th, with a decent home win against **Typhoon Loftus**, the visitors missing a couple of key players and not being able to match the home side's creativity. **The Family Cat** look quite well placed to go at least one spot better next season, promotion should be a must.

Wycombe Town will be disappointed in 6th, but they are very well placed to push on for promotion next season if things fall their way.

So **Wolfpack**, **Red Star Cevile** and **Anfield Stars** are relegated, with **Wolfpack** looking the hardest rebuild, **Anfield** have some cash stashed away.

PARIS PIPPED

Viking Raiders took the second promotion spot behind already promoted **Elegant Chaos**, they did this with a steady defensive display from visiting **Redden Court**, chances were minimal but **NKANTE** got a rare goal to grab 3 points and that second place.

Chiaroscuro visited **Trachloe Villa** and turned their dominance into goals, even missing **LEIF** they rained shots on goal and came up with 5, with no reply, **ZEFERELLI** grabbing a brace.

NEW ORDER

Holland Pk West snatch second from **Coral Sea City** courtesy of their win at home to bottom team **KU Clubbers**, a convincing 8-0 victory which could have been even better given their dominance.

Coral Sea City had a tough game away to **Blackburn Rvrs** and though they gave a good showing they were eventually comfortably dealt with by the unbeaten home side 6-3. All three should give a good account of themselves next season in the 3rd Division, with **Holland Pk West** possibly surprising themselves as to how well placed they may be.

Bluesville lost at home to an ever improving **Real Olivero**, though admittedly the home side were missing **BAKKON** who would probably have swung the game in their favour. **Real Olivero** with considerable backing available will be wanting promotion next season, and with an eye to building forwards for perhaps consecutive promotions.



Cougars lost to **Celtic Rangers** 0-2 and could only draw away to **KU Klubbers** in their rearranged game, but I do think that the **Cougars** could be a bit of a surprise package for next year as all the work being put in points to the corner having been turned.

Travellers FC could challenge next year if a manager can be located, they should be above average in what will be a very even division.

These are also the same levels which decide whether a player will go straight to N/L when out of contract rather than being put into the auction

AUCTION NOTES

From now onwards we would like you to always write, 'don't sell if he turns star in the messages to GM box EVEN IF HE IS A LEVEL TWELVE STAR, as well as ticking the relevant DON'T SELL box in teampick. NOTE THAT TICKING THE BOX IS THE MAIN DECISION-MAKER IN WHETHER A PLAYER IS SOLD OR NOT, the GM Message is just to help the GM as during the transfers we have no way of knowing whether a player has become level twelve in THAT SESSION.!

Also PLEASE DO NOT leave partially-completed transfers in your transfer section, i.e. leaving the team name or the player, etc., it is laziness on your part and might result in strange things happening to your team!!!

And you MUST spell the names of the players included in any deal correctly. If you don't then the program might refuse them and they don't go through, so be careful.

In future, you are allowed multiple conditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase just one item. However, you are also allowed multiple Unconditional bids from which the program will attempt to purchase all. teampick users just have to use the relevant boxes in the program, those who don't use teampick must ensure they stick to these rules and make it clear on their turns just what they want to happen in their bidding process.

LSO, be careful when doing deals etc. The program works on team order, which can cause problems. Best idea is NOT to have 25 players in your squad at the start of a turn and do deals and sell to NL, cos if the manager you are doing a deal with has a lower team number than yours, the program will say you have no space in your squad, even though you are trying to sell players to the non-league. His orders will be processed before yours!!

NB In teampick trophy games come after League Cup it appears. Please realise that they don't. In the fullness of time the temapick maestro will change this

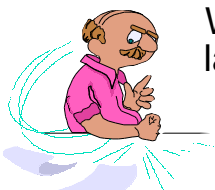

MARKING UPDATE

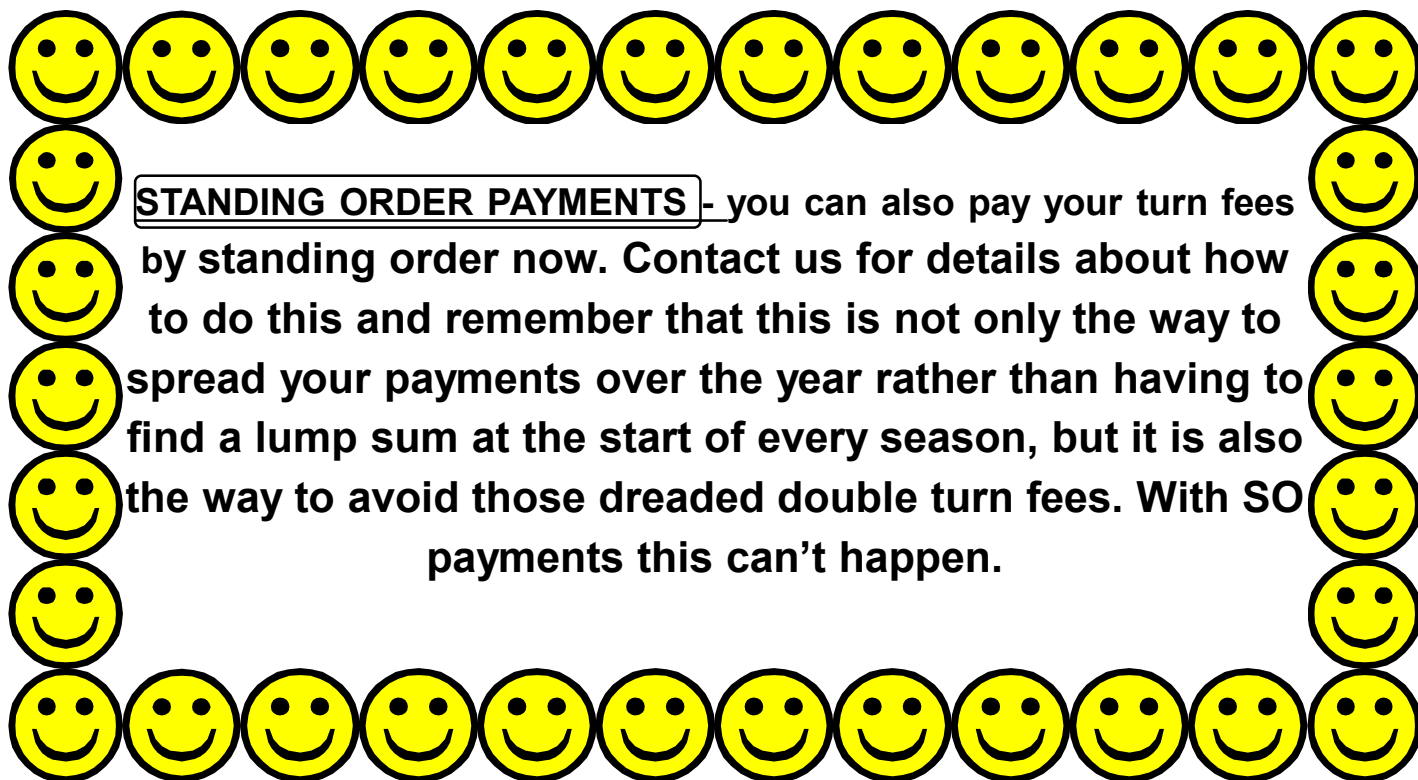

You will all notice a new stat on your turnsheets. In the space where BW/CR stats are listed there will be a X% number against all goalkeepers. This will rate your GK on his shot-saving ability and will be cumulative.

Two points to note. It does not include penalties and own goals, but does include friendlies. And before shouting that it is wrong, remember that all shots against you are tested against the sweeper for blocking them before the GK.

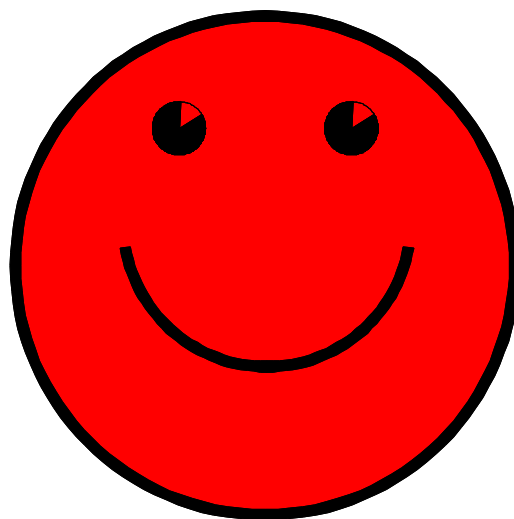

TEAMPICK

Teampick is a program available for all PC owners who have windows on their machine. It allows you to manipulate your team on screen to look at differing formations and conditions. This automatically works out the factors which will affect your team, helps prevent errors, and all sorts of things into the bargain. It also prints out your team sheet, and you can then get the program to format an Email team sheet for submitting instead of the normal order sheets, if you so choose. The program also has an on-line rulebook, i.e., you can dial up the relevant section of the rulebook at the click of the mouse and read that part of the rules while selecting your team. If you can't remember how the weather affects things, when your captain moves onto an extra level, or the formulas that govern transfer negotiations and marking, well just ask the computer! Subscribers also get a .kik file which upgrades your team details every session as well making it even easier for you. Even better news is that the program is FREE to all players who sign up for Shomatch.

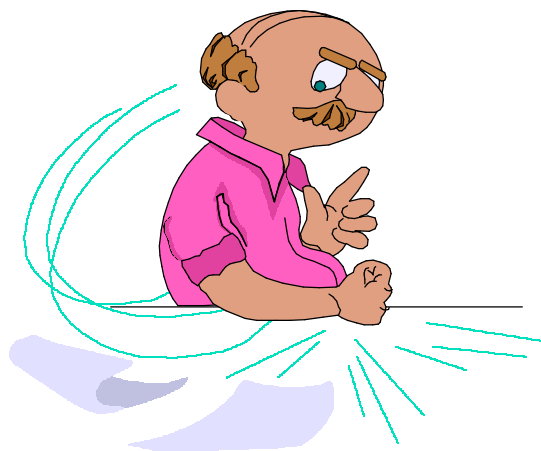

For those who don't already know Shomatch is our very own tele-printer in which you get the results, the newsletter and league tables on it, plus a minute by minute printout of the state of your game. Nail-biting to watch if you've got a particularly important game to play. Far better, and definitely more nerve-wracking than just tearing the newsletter open and seeing your fate decided in the flash of a micro-second. This is only available to those who have email players as everything is sent to you as an email which shomatch interprets and displays to you on your PC screen. But not only do you get the tele-printer printout and the league tables, but we send you a number of extra files which include the results, suspensions, Euro results, international results, rep results and the like. All of these can be displayed and watched as they tick through minute by minute as well. Thanks to the programming skills of Paul Sutton, shomatch now runs under windows, with pictures, sound effects and the like making it an even more gripping experience for the real masochists amongst you!!

If you are playing the game from abroad by Email, and who doesn't receive any hardcopy newsletters (mainly those who are playing from outside of continental Europe, MUST purchase shomatch as it is via this that we send your results, newsletters (in PDF format now), and the like. It's up to the rest of you whether you subscribe to this and get your results earlier than the hardcopy comes out. But for the overseas player it is a boon allowing them a little bit extra time to complete their orders - something that they were always moaning about in the past!

What is the cost then. Well you have to pay a single fee of £17.95 which covers a season of sign-ups for Shomatch. If you need to re-do a team for some reason then all you get is 100 levels + 100K, , please contact us before you re-do any team to talk about it.

Also, your subscription for Shomatch/Teampick will be taken from the first league that you receive a start-up for so please ensure you have enough to cover it
