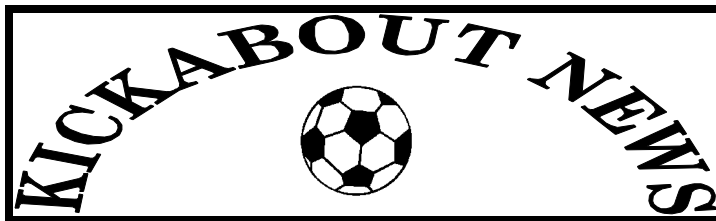

DIVISION ONE - MATCH OF THE DAY

Baboon Foxes 2-0 Isle of Doom

(Venue: Foxes Stadium - Attendance 7,163 - Wind: Light - Pitch: Hard)

Baboon Foxes continued their remarkable rise up the Division One table with a composed 2_0 home victory over **Isle of Doom**, marking their second win of the session and completing a jump from 8th to 3rd place. The Foxes impressed from the outset, with their forward line producing wave after wave of pressure. Suker opened the scoring on 16 minutes, bursting through the Doom defence with a superb solo run and finish. The visitors struggled to respond, despite strong midfield output from captain Drake, who registered the only significant creative spark for Isle of Doom. The hosts remained in control after the break. Their creative heartbeat Kyrialkov delivered a standout performance (rated 10/10), continually opening channels for the Foxes' attackers, while defender Crocani produced a key chance-blocking intervention that prevented Isle of Doom from gaining momentum. The result was sealed in the 65th minute, when Gos Bale curled a beautifully flighted effort from outside the box, beating Wadlow at full stretch for 2_0. Both goalkeepers performed strongly_Pampagna reaching a flawless 100% save rate_but Isles lacked the attacking precision to threaten a comeback. With the team's attacking quadrant of Kos ta Blanca, Suker, Ned and Gos Bale all contributing creatively, the Foxes were simply too sharp. Isle of Doom, meanwhile, created few meaningful chances and were unable to break Foxes' defensive structure.

DIVISION TWO - MATCH OF THE DAY

FC Costa Diego 2-0 Paroot Habashan

(Attendance: 13,830 - Pitch: Wet - Wind: Light - Derby Game)

FC Costa Diego secured an impressive 2_0 derby victory over **Paroot Habashan**, Costa Diego emerging deserved winners through precision finishing and midfield dominance.

Costa Diego controlled the game from midfield, with LIMATO, Le Freu Freu and Agutbong producing a string of high-quality creative actions. Paroot Habashan defended gamely_particularly through Lombata and

Topsirlion, who produced two key blocks_but their reduced midfield output left them unable to compete in central areas. On 30 minutes - Fir Shields made the break through with a simple header following a well-constructed wide move. Le Freu Freu made it two with a powerful long-range strike that flew beyond Trowel. After these two blows in quick succession, Paroot Habashan never looked likely to claw back the deficit. Their two-man forward line was heavily punished by offside, losing 60% of shots, while Costa Diego's defence was protected by excellent holding play from Shearney and the outstanding LIMATO. Goalkeeper Oos van Flaps, produced a flawless 100% save rate.

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DIVISION THREE - MATCH OF THE DAY

Hobo Central 9-7 Showaddywaddy

(Att: 4,789 - Pitch: Wet - Wind: Calm)

Division Three served up an extraordinary spectacle as Hobo Central defeated Showaddywaddy 9_7 in one of the wildest matches ever witnessed in the lower divisions. The league leaders maintained their 100% record, extending their gap at the top to five points, but they were pushed to the edge by a Showaddywaddy side who refused to go quietly (!) What unfolded was less a football match and more a 90-minute fever dream of relentless attacking, defensive chaos, outrageous finishing and scarcely believable shot totals.

FIRST HALF: A GOALSTORM WITH NO LET-UP

Hobo Central started fast - SOS-UACY opened with a spectacular bicycle kick on 8 minutes. Razorcrest added a dipping drive a minute later. Showaddywaddy hit back immediately through Vacio (8') and Pele (11'), making it 2_2 in just over ten minutes. The tempo remained absurd. Knickknack Jim struck twice in the 34th minute_first smashing in a loose ball, then calmly side-footing home moments later. Miles Dyson powered in a header at 35'. Sunrise danced round the keeper for 3_4 at 28'. Coccoas squeezed in a bizarre shot-come-cross on 46'. By half-time it was barely clear what was happening, only that neither defence could cope with either attack.

SECOND HALF: A FRENZY TURNS TO CARNAGE

The second period followed the script of chaos. Hobo Central, powered by their ferocious five-forward setup, kept piling on shots_over 70 combined attacking attempts were generated. Big Bob rifled one from distance (53'). Sukum hammered a 30-yarder for Showaddywaddy (56'). Miles Dyson added another with a clever flick (82'). Sunrise smashed in yet another loose ball (80'). Pele grabbed his second at 87'. But it was Razorcrest who delivered the decisive blows: A brilliant solo run for 44', and a towering 90th-minute header to complete his hat-trick and seal the match at 9_7. Both keepers_despite conceding 16 goals between them_were graded as

magnificent/astounding under the match model due to the sheer number of shots faced. Qos Banks still managed a 69% save rate, while Moon somehow registered 65%.

Decided to add a League Cup to the schedule for next season.

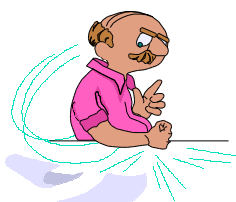
It will start on Session 2, and continues on S5/7/10/12

STANDING ORDER PAYMENTS - you can also pay your turn fees by standing order now. Contact us for details about how to do this and remember that this is not only the way to spread your payments over the year rather than having to find a lump sum at the start of every season, but it is also the way to avoid those dreaded double turn fees. With SO payments this can't happen.

MARKING UPDATE



We have worked out a system to check on anybody who is using last season's marking numbers for the current season. Basically the program will save a list of all valid marking successes each session and if somebody cries foul, that he has been marked by somebody who hasn't scouted him, we can check and say yea or nay.

So from now onwards if you use last season's numbers then you will be found out AND if guilty the result of the game will either be reversed or decided against you.

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb –
