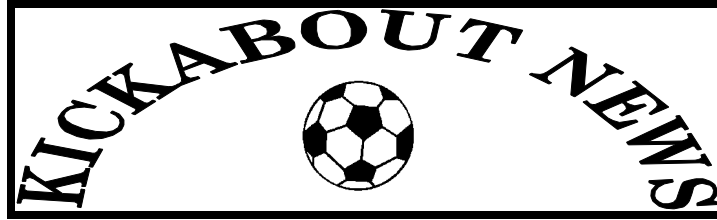

### SESSION NINE

#### Explorers X1 MAKE IT EIGHT!

**Explorers XI** clinched their eighth league title in emphatic fashion with a commanding 3-0 victory away at **South Sea Rover**, a result that underlined both their quality and their manager Lawton's knack for delivering when the stakes are highest.

Knowing that victory would secure the championship, Explorers arrived determined to impose themselves despite difficult conditions on a muddy pitch. South Sea Rover, rooted to the bottom of the table, were not without resistance and their goalkeeper Maayong Buntag produced a magnificent performance, repeatedly denying the visitors to keep the contest alive early on.

The breakthrough came after twenty minutes when Rudanovsky reacted quickest inside the penalty area, pouncing on a loose ball and smashing it beyond the keeper to give Explorers the lead. From that moment the visitors began to control proceedings, their midfield pairing of King Boo and Kolchak dictating the tempo while the attacking line continually stretched the Rover defence.

Although South Sea Rover attempted to respond through creative sparks from Idol and FIDRA, they struggled to translate possession into genuine chances. Explorers' defensive structure held firm, with sweeper Chimpanzee providing cover behind the back line and allowing the side to maintain control.

The decisive spell arrived late in the second half. In the 57th minute captain King Boo rose above the defence to nod home a well-worked header, doubling the lead and effectively putting the title within touching distance. Just two minutes later Kolchak added the third, calmly side-footing the ball home after another incisive attacking move that cut through the tiring Rover defence.

With that goal the outcome was beyond doubt. Explorers' goalkeeper Marco Polo enjoyed a flawless afternoon between the posts while the attack continued to threaten until the final whistle. Rudanovsky, Kolchak and King Boo all played starring roles, but it was a complete team performance that sealed the victory.

When the final whistle sounded, Explorers XI had done exactly what was required. A 3-0 triumph, three goals from key players, and the league crown secured. For manager Lawton it marks yet another remarkable achievement, guiding his side to an eighth league title and reinforcing Explorers XI's status as the dominant force in the division.

At the bottom five sides are at risk of going down, only three will survive. **Panglao** give themselves a chance after a derby win over Hebrides. **Vulture Street** could be on the move in more ways than one. **Mountain High** will have to overcome the celebrations at Explorers and **Allotmentees** will surely not concede enough to send them down???

#### OVERLI BACK IN THE BIG TIME

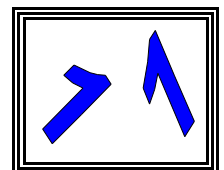
While Explorers XI were sealing the Division One crown, there was also a title celebration unfolding in Division Two as Overli's **Dross Island** side wrapped

up the championship with a dominant 5-1 victory over already-relegated **Ofah United**.

Ofah United actually struck first and briefly threatened to spoil the party. In the 15th minute Marlene Boyce stepped up to deliver a superb precision free-kick that beat Sargeant Wilson and gave the home side a surprise lead. For a moment it looked as though the

champions-elect might face an awkward afternoon.

The response from Dross Island was immediate and emphatic. Just a minute later Tano levelled the match, meeting a cross with a simple but effective header to restore parity. From that point the momentum swung decisively toward the visitors, whose attacking trio began to overwhelm the Ofah defence.

Johnny English put Dross Island ahead midway through the first half, cleverly flicking in a cross from close range after another well-constructed move. The visitors continued to dominate possession and territory, forcing Ofah's goalkeeper Tony Driscoll into a string of outstanding saves that kept the scoreline respectable for long periods.

Despite Driscoll's remarkable performance between the posts, the pressure eventually told again in the second half. Tano grabbed his second goal of the afternoon in the 67th minute with a clever lob from the edge of the area, stretching the lead and effectively putting the contest beyond reach.

Areglico Fuchs then added a fourth with a beautifully flighted strike from outside the box in the 77th minute, before Johnny English capped an impressive display by side-footing home late in stoppage time to complete the scoring.

Ofah United battled gamely, with Reg and Boyce offering flashes of quality in attack, but they were ultimately overwhelmed by a confident and clinical Dross Island side. The 5-1 scoreline reflected the visitors' attacking dominance, even though Driscoll's astonishing goalkeeping display prevented an even heavier defeat.

At the final whistle the celebrations belonged to Dross Island. Overli's team had done what was required in style, securing the Division Two title and confirming their promotion with a performance that showcased both their attacking firepower and their championship credentials.

Fc Costa Diego go up too but who makes that third spot? **Blazing Saddles** or **Anatra City** who have nightmare sessions while dark horses are in form **Isla Teja**.

At the bottom **Paroot Habshan** look odds on to join **Ofah United** and **Barbary Coast** in relegation as they Blazing Saddles to contend with whilst **FC Westeros** have hapless **Barbary Coast**.

## HOBO'S FIND A NEW HOME

Division Three produced its own dramatic conclusion as the title was decided in a do or die clash between **Guybrush Threep** and **Hobo Central**. In the end it was Breznitz's Hobo Central who rose to the occasion in emphatic style, storming to a 4-1 victory away from home to secure the championship.

Hobo Central approached the match with an ultra-attacking setup, packing their forward line and accepting defensive risks in pursuit of goals. The gamble paid off almost immediately. Just five minutes into the match Razorcrest struck the opening blow, calmly side-footing the ball home to give the visitors the perfect start and quiet the home crowd.

Guybrush Threep struggled to cope with the relentless attacking pressure that followed. Hobo Central's forward line, led by the powerful combination of Big Bob, Enormous Fred and Miles Dyson, repeatedly sliced through the defence. In the 21st minute Enormous Fred doubled the lead with a thundering volley, and the visitors were only just getting started.

Six minutes later the game was effectively decided. Miles Dyson ran onto a perfectly weighted defence-splitting pass to make it three, and before Guybrush Threep could regroup he struck again moments later with a spectacular 30-yard drive that crashed past goalkeeper Rand. The four-goal blitz inside half an hour left the home side stunned.

To their credit, Guybrush Threep did not completely collapse. Midfield leader Mooncow fought hard to drag his side back into the contest and Bongo eventually found a late consolation in the 79th minute, running onto a flicked header to beat Qos Banks. By then, however, the outcome had long been settled.

Rand produced an astonishing performance in goal for the home side and prevented an even heavier defeat, but Hobo Central's attacking firepower proved overwhelming. Miles Dyson's brace, along with goals from Razorcrest and Enormous Fred, ensured a commanding victory.

When the final whistle blew it confirmed Hobo Central as Division Three champions. Breznitz's bold tactical approach had delivered on the biggest stage, sealing promotion and the title with a performance full of attacking intent and ruthless finishing.

## VALDER STEPS IN

Division Three also saw a new chapter begin at **Burbage Moors** as Simon Valder took charge of the club, the Coldean resident stepping into the managerial hot seat for what many consider the biggest challenge of his career so far. The early signs, however, were encouraging as his side battled to a respectable 1-1 draw against **Real Anatra FC**.

Valder's second match in charge came with a few complications. Burbage Moors were forced into changes after Toureh picked up an injury, while the visitors also lost Scusi before kick-off. Despite the disruptions, the hosts settled into the contest well, with the midfield trio working hard to keep the game competitive.

Real Anatra enjoyed plenty of possession and produced the majority of the attacking play, but Burbage Moors

showed resilience and discipline. Goalkeeper Lukic delivered a solid performance between the posts, while the defensive unit absorbed long periods of pressure from the visitors' midfield engine room led by Smith and Sos Lukash.

Against the run of play, it was Burbage Moors who struck first. In the 36th minute Smith A produced a clinical finish, calmly side-footing the ball home to give the home side the lead and reward their determined effort. The goal lifted the crowd and gave Valder's men renewed belief as they tried to hold on.

Real Anatra continued to push forward throughout the second half and eventually found a breakthrough late on. With nine minutes remaining, defender Sono surged forward and unleashed a powerful drive from a tight angle that beat Lukic and brought the visitors level.

Both sides searched for a late winner but neither could find the decisive moment, leaving the match to finish all square. For Simon Valder it represented a promising start to life at Burbage Moors. Taking a point against a capable Real Anatra side may not secure headlines, but it offers a solid platform as the new manager begins the task of rebuilding and guiding the club forward.

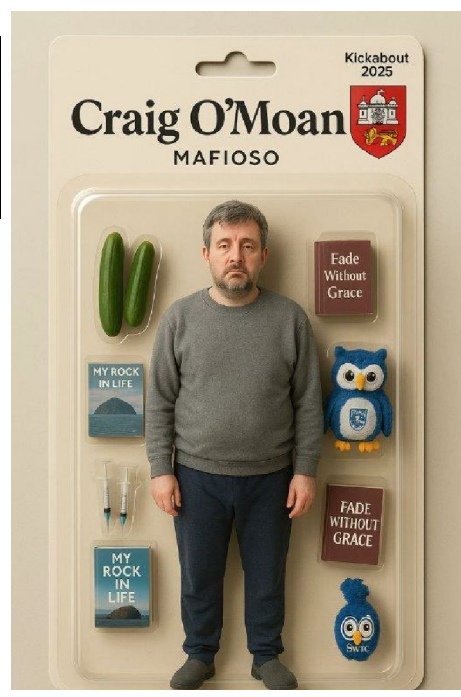

It will start on Session 2, and continues on S5/7/10/12

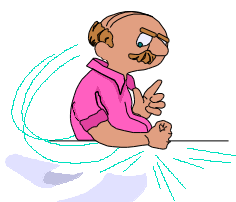

## MARKING UPDATE



We have worked out a system to check on anybody who is using last season's marking numbers for the current season. Basically the program will save a list of all valid marking successes each session and if somebody cries foul, that he has been marked by somebody who hasn't scouted him, we can check and say yea or nay.

**So from now onwards if you use last season's numbers then you will be found out AND if guilty the result of the game will either be reversed or decided against you.**

# CONTRACTS UPDATE

---

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

**I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE**

---

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

---

## **NOTE THIS WELL ALSO**

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an \* by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an \* by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb
