



IMMORTALS CONTINUE TO IMPRESS

A season for **Immortals** that so far is turning out better than anyone could have predicted as they notch up another good win which sees them sitting solidly in the mid-table rankings. Granted they were facing lowly **AS Centurions**, a side struggling at the moment and one which manager READ is going to have his work cut out with but you can only play what is in front of you and they did the job with no shortage of aplomb.

READ came with a plan to frustrate and shut out but this was blown out of the water inside the first minute when **Centurion's** GREENING flicked in a cross from close range to open the scoring, further misery follows just 7 minutes later as ROMARIO is forced to turn the ball in to his own net after some excellent pressure from the home side. Further misery follows for them just a few minutes later as they concede a third and READ's game plan is in tatters.

The home side get 2 more in before half time to go in to the break with a 5 goal lead and you could have expected them to take it easy in the second with the game already won barring a miracle but manager THOMPSON's half time talk had obviously contained dire warnings about complacency and his side came out with the same sort of fire we saw in the first half.

JONATHAN HART makes it 6 within just minutes of the restart with a little bit of a lucky deflection from just inside the penalty area, KATSU adds a seventh from midfield midway through the period and LOKI nods home with just 5 minutes to go to seal a comprehensive victory and round off a fine 90 minutes performance from the home side.

A solid victory for **Immortals** and one that will no doubt please manager THOMPSON immensely. They will no doubt face much sterner opposition throughout the course of this season, a fact that the manager will be more than aware of but this confidence booster can do them no harm whatsoever.

High-flying **Sunderland FTM** are held to a surprising draw at struggling **St Helens Town** who have failed so far this season to show the form of last year and while this draw doesn't really change their situation it will be a massive confidence boost for the whole side.

As expected, **Sunderland** completely dominated proceedings here but some surprisingly lacklustre finishing saw them only scoring 1 goal in this match which, although disappointing should still have been enough to give them all 3 points and manager LAWTON must have been pretty confident of seeing this out but a moment of sheer magic from defender PIMBLETTs clawed the **Town** back in to the match as the defender rose head and shoulders above everyone to power home a header from the edge of the area.

Town somehow manage to hang on for the next 35 minutes as they faced an almost continuous onslaught and **Sunderland's** frustrations with their day boil over, CUNNINGHAM receiving his marching orders minutes from the end of the game for a reckless challenge on defender RHSKOOL which could have seen him seriously injured.

This draw allows **Saints** and **Daggers** to open some daylight for themselves at the top, both sides winning comprehensively this session, **Saints** putting in an impressive and dominating performance in front of their own fans as they brush aside **Club Paradiso** who were fortunate to only concede 2 on the day.

Daggers also looked impressive in their 2-0 victory over **FC Sprout** although they were far from comfortable at times in this game and manager OVERLI can perhaps feel a little aggrieved they didn't get something out of the encounter but **Daggers** were clinical in front of goal when it mattered and deserved the victory overall.

EDORAS TOP SCORERS

Having a fantastic season, **Edoras** continue to perform and have emerged as one of the sides to watch this season with a most impressive record in front of goals, scoring an average of 3.3 goals per game so far this season.

This session saw them face a tricky away tie against a **Hawtonville** side that has also been in fine form to date and to be fair did a pretty good job of containing their opponents but a disastrous performance from goalkeeper GREEN proved to be their undoing in this one.

Edoras go ahead just inside quarter of an hour played as midfielder LIXANDRU scores from 10 yards out, seconds later they make it 2 as they rob the ball from **Hawtonville** straight from the kickoff and a neat through ball puts striker ABREU in and he makes no mistake from the finish. GRUBER makes it 3 with a volley 4 minutes later and it seems that every time GREEN is called in to action to make a save, he fails to get anything on it at all.

Hawtonville also have their chances this half and possession-wise the game is fairly even but unlike his opposing number, keeper VERNYDUB is in fine form and deals comfortably with anything **Hawtonville** can conjure up.



KICKABOUT NEWS

Edoras catch **Hawtonville** on the break to score a 4th just before the half-time whistle and go in to the break with a comfortable lead. **Hawtonville** do eventually manage to get one past **VERNYDUB** early on in the second half as **ALBERTZ** nods home to reduce the deficit slightly but **NUNEZ** restores parity in the 75th minute with a header that once again **GREEN** completely fails to deal with.

No more chances of note were created by either side as the game peters out, **Edoras** content to protect their lead and manage out the game as they successfully frustrate **Hawtonville** for the last 15 minutes or so and the game ends 5-1 to **Edoras**.

Inter Walls drag themselves out of the relegation zone as they record a crucial win against fellow strugglers **Botafogo** in what could well be a season-defining moment for them. Dominant in this one, they finally show some flashes of the potential they are capable of and the decision by manager **SAMSON** to go with an unorthodox 2-4-4 formation certainly paid dividends for them.

Despite looking a little bit light at the back, **Walls** comfortably controlled any threat from the **Botafogo** front runners while their 4 men front line caused nothing but trouble for their opponents all game. An opening goal from midfielder **ETNA** settles them comfortably in to this one and they start to exert almost constant pressure but they fail to capitalise on their superiority and it must have been a very frustrated **SAMSON** who takes them in to the changing room at half time.

A similar second half again sees them dominate proceedings but finding scant reward for all their endeavours and it wasn't until late on that they finally found some reward for their efforts as the eventually double their lead as **UMBALI** pokes home then, just like buses two appear together as they score a third minutes later to seal the win David crashing home a 30 yard blockbuster.

A much-needed 3 points here from **Walls** today and, perhaps more importantly, a good performance to boot which has been lacking from them somewhat this season.

At the top, despite missing some players in key position, **Harleys** maintain their unbeaten record as they record a crushing 4-0 victory over strugglers **Borussia Wigan** and the victory goes to show the depth and quality of their squad as they barely missed a beat even with a couple of first team regulars missing.

TIGHT AT THE TOP

Two points separate the top 4 in this division and some further twists and turns this session continue to make predicting the eventual winner of this one almost impossible at the moment.

The stand-out encounter of the session has to be between **Purley Kings** and **FC Porto**. As expected, this was a tight game between two very in-form sides and neither was giving away much in what was a hard fought battle.

With neither side creating much, it took a moment of intervention from the officials to swing this one as **Kings** defender **WULF** is sensationally sent off in the 36th minute in what can only be described as a very controversial decision.

The **Kings** side rallied magnificently though and it was hard to tell at times which side had actually been reduced to 10 men as **Porto** couldn't seem to take advantage of their extra player however this effort from the **Kings** players couldn't be maintained indefinitely and you could certainly see their energy levels draining away as the game progressed.

The breakthrough came on the hour mark as tired legs led to a mistake at the back and forward **GHOULASH** was allowed to go through and stick the ball into the back of the net, a cruel blow to a side that had battled so hard for so long.

Porto immediately shut shop after this breakthrough and pulled 11 men behind the ball at every opportunity to make sure that **Kings** couldn't find a way back in to this one and the game eventually ended 1-0 to the visitors.

Full credit must go to the 10 men of **Kings** who defended valiantly for the whole of the 90 minutes and if they had kept 11 men on the pitch, this result could have just as easily gone the other way.

This result sees them slip off the top and with their other nearest rivals, namely **Cheam Chargers** and **Flowserve** both winning it sees them slip down to 4th in the table while it's now **Flowserve** who sit proudly at the top of the division tonight.

BORDERING ON THE RIDIDIOUS

Well who could have predicted this result? Not me for sure as a 11 goal thrill-fest is the highlight of the 4th this week.

In a top of the table clash, **IFK Didi** host leaders **Western Raiders**, now you may have been forgiven for thinking this was going to be a cagey affair with neither side wanting to give away too much and perhaps just hoping to sneak a win by the odd goal well you couldn't have been more wrong!

Didi came with a formation straight out of the **STEVENS** play book and threw caution to the wind with a 5 man frontline while **Raiders** looked to dominate the game through the middle of the park and what a game this produced with chanced galore for both sides.

Fairly even possession-wise, the game soon settled in to a pattern of **Didi** hoofing it forward at every opportunity and **Raiders** countering through keeping the ball on the floor and passing their way forward. **Didi** stun their opponents early on with 2 goals in quick succession as they pressure the opposition defence with some accurate long balls before **SASKATCHEWAN** pulls one back for the visitors but **Didi** don't stop and the pressure is relentless at times and they are rewarded for their bravery with 2 more goals before the break to make it 4-1 before **SASKATCHEWAN** again pulls one back for the visitors on the brink of half-time to reduce the deficit.



KICKABOUT NEWS

Two swift goals follow early in the second half to give the home side a commanding 6-2 lead as **Raiders** simply fail to deal with the pressure exerted upon them. Despite this lead, **Didi** continued to push and were further rewarded when **MORELOS** completes his hat-trick, finishing neatly from 10 yards out before **DUMITRESCU** adds an 8th with little over 10 minutes to go.

Raiders do pull one back through **SASKATCHEWAN** who scores his third of the game also to round off a fine performance for him but far too little to late to make any difference to the outcome.

Elsewhere, **Red Star Karova** put some pressure on 3rd placed **Redstox** who can only manage a draw away to **Dragon** in a rather insipid affair leaving **Karova** an opportunity to close the gap with a victory over **Walsall Town**. Completely dominant in this one, despite **Walsall** getting men behind the ball at every opportunity, **Karova** produced a number of good chances and only poor finishing made the result look more even than it actually was.

Allowed to control this game, **Karova** created a number of fine chances and deservedly took the lead on the half hour mark through defender **ASUDILLO** who had been allowed to push forward and he finishes off a flowing move with some aplomb, thumping the ball home.

Further chances for the home side appeared at regular intervals throughout the match but they failed to capitalise on their advantage and couldn't stick another one in the net. Never really threatened at all throughout the 90 minutes, one goal was always going to be enough here to win the game but I am sure manager **ABRAHAM** will be disappointed with his side's poor performance in front of goals and would have liked to see a few more go in.

That aside, it was a good win for them and does now put them within striking distance of the promotion places so he will at least be pleased with that.

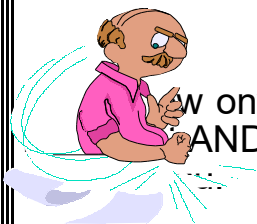

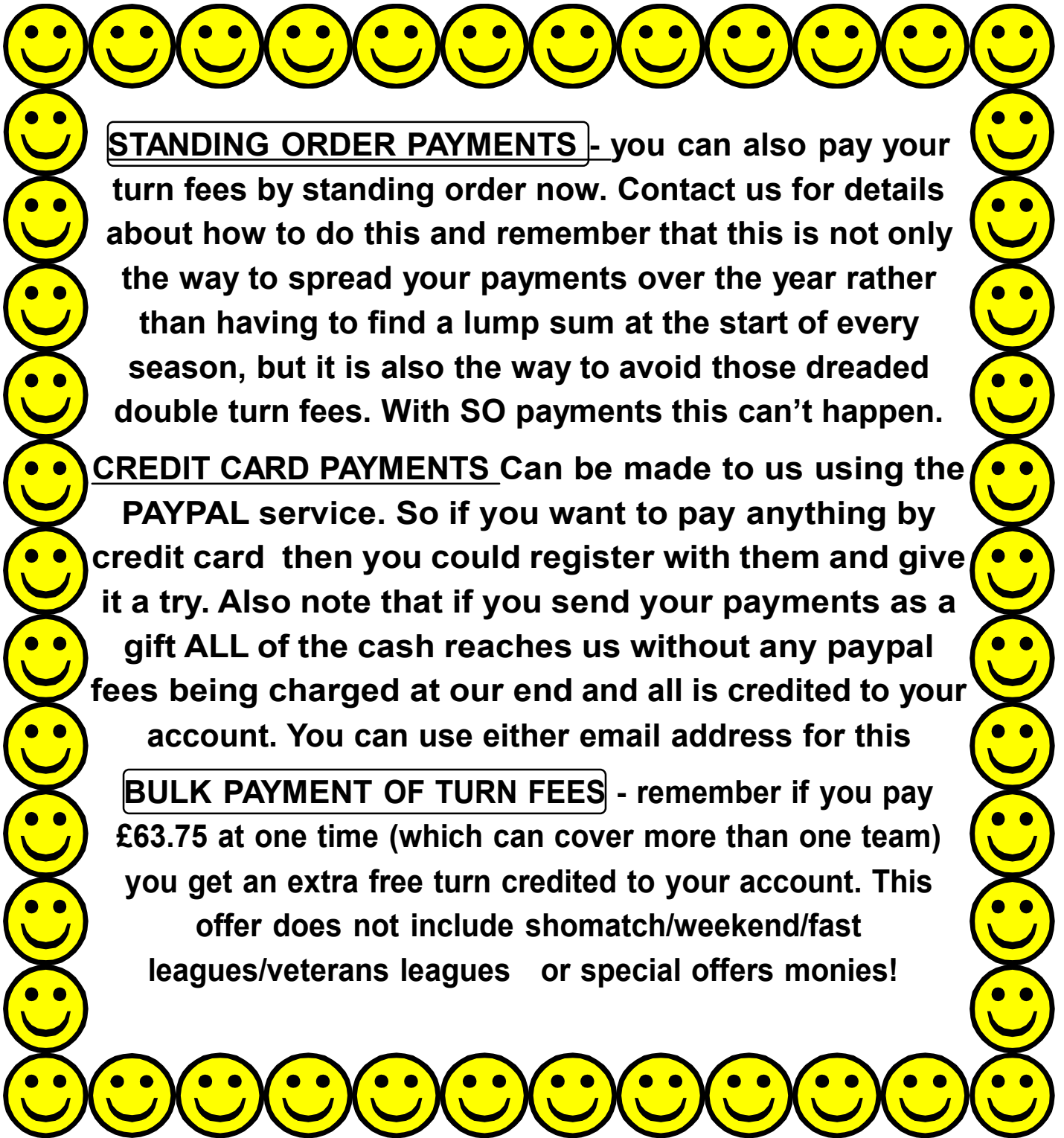

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb

MY TEAMS

A team you love, a team you have had success with, a team that frustrates you, anything, even a team you had in the past. We don't want a novel just a few lines or so about that team. Have asked the newsletter-writers to start the ball rolling, but open to all of you?

My Most Frustrating Team (by Dave Hails)

I have many teams across the leagues. Some of them I am really happy with, some are really frustrating, and some I just don't understand what is going on! Some are challenging for honours, others are in various stages of rebuild. But the team I am currently most frustrated with is AFC Europa in the Raleigh league. Tipped to do well this season, they are currently bottom of division 3 with no wins in the league yet. The start of the season was OK, dominating matches, but struggling to get shots on target. Then the injuries kicked in! 7 injuries so far, in 6 session. 7 injuries, and none of them training injuries. They were all incurred in matches - so all involved lost levels and players unavailable. Time and again, I have been unable to field my best team, because of injuries. Aargh! Oh well, I think I have them all back fit again now - at least I will do once I've dealt with the potentially career threatening injury to my SBY! Now all I have to do is train them to actually get shots on target. It's a bit like watching Brighton play! Lots of possession, but no end product.
