

COPENHAGEN LEAGUE - MID-SEASON REPORT

At the halfway stage of the Copenhagen League season, clear narratives are forming across all three divisions. Promotion races are tightening, underperformers are emerging, and the underlying club data (finances, squad strength, and management) adds an extra layer to how the second half may unfold.

DIVISION 1 - TITLE RACE & SURVIVAL BATTLE

Top of the Table: Tight and Competitive

Club Cruzeiro lead the way on 24 points, but their advantage is far from secure. Their strong goal difference (+9) and balanced record suggest consistency rather than dominance. Backed by solid club value (262) and good attendance figures (~43k), they look structurally sound.

Just behind them:

” **Trento** (23 pts) - efficient and defensively strong (+14 GD). With a disciplined setup and steady finances, they are arguably the most “complete” side. In form and just look at their Euro form

” **Skank Town** (22 pts) - statistically strong, but their lower balance and resources compared to rivals may become a factor later in the season.

Chasing Pack: Still in It

Teams like:

” **23A Swan Hill** (19 pts) (Star-filled)

” **Mailers** (17 pts)

” **Papeete** (16 pts)

remain within striking distance.

Mailers are particularly interesting:

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” Highest attendance in the division (~42k)
 ” Strong overall rating (620)
 ” But underperforming relative to squad value (260)
 They look like a classic “should be doing better” side.
Papeete, meanwhile, combine strong squad value (255) with good finances (cash positive), making them a potential second-half surge candidate.

Mid-Table Stability

Paris SG and Nakuru Rangers are steady but inconsistent. Paris SG's high rating (489) and strong squad value suggest they could still climb.

Relegation Zone: Real Trouble

” **Dynamo Avuton** (10 pts) - poor goal difference (-12) despite decent rating (487)
 ” **Royal Racers** (10 pts) - underachieving given solid infrastructure
 ” **FC Sportsmen** (10 pts) - low balance and limited momentum
 ” **FC Newark** (3 pts) - clearly struggling
 FC Newark stand out:
 ” Very low points total
 ” Weak squad value (193)
 ” No manager (vacant)
 They already look destined for relegation unless something drastic changes.

DIVISION 2 - DOMINANCE AND DISPARITY

Promotion Race: Two Clear Leaders

” **Clapham Common** (29 pts)
 ” **Taitung Terrors** (28 pts)
 Clapham Common have built their success on balance and efficiency.
 Despite a modest rating (392), they are overachieving through results.
 Taitung Terrors, however, look stronger on paper:
 ” Higher rating (500)
 ” Strong youth/value indicators
 They may be better equipped for the long run.

Strong Contenders

” **Oild Masters** (27 pts, +35 GD) - the most explosive attacking side
 ” **Bespin City** (20 pts) - financially stable and balanced
 (Both could do well next season, with their squads)
 Oild Masters stand out statistically with a huge goal difference, they are scoring goals for fun, but the bank manager is sniffing again
 but their negative cash position and average squad structure could hinder consistency.

Mid-Table Cluster

A large group sits between 18-15 points:

- ” **Black Hills** (needs to get his axe out
- ” **Thermidor Ath** (Bank manager is already at his door)
- ” **FC Zotte** (building for next season?)
- ” **Famagusta Kids** (Hudson the man with the plan)

These sides are inconsistent, with mixed financial and squad indicators.

Bottom End: Major Struggles

- ” **Gooners Etal** (9 pts)
 - ” **KA Keroes** (5 pts)
 - ” **Dynamo Dresden** (0 pts)
- Dynamo Dresden are the most concerning:
- ” 0 points
 - ” -82 goal difference
 - ” Despite a high rating (631), results are catastrophic
- This suggests either tactical issues or severe imbalance in squad performance.

DIVISION 3 - OPEN AND UNPREDICTABLE

Top Contenders

- ” **Newark Athletic** (28 pts) -
best defensive record and strong
structure
- ” **R.P.F. Foxes** (19 pts) -
consistent but not dominant
- The oldest team in the league but the
manager seems to be able to manage
aged players and keep them chug
chugging along as am sure he will do for
next season
- ” **Johnson Fold** (18 pts) -
strong financial backing (huge cash
reserves)

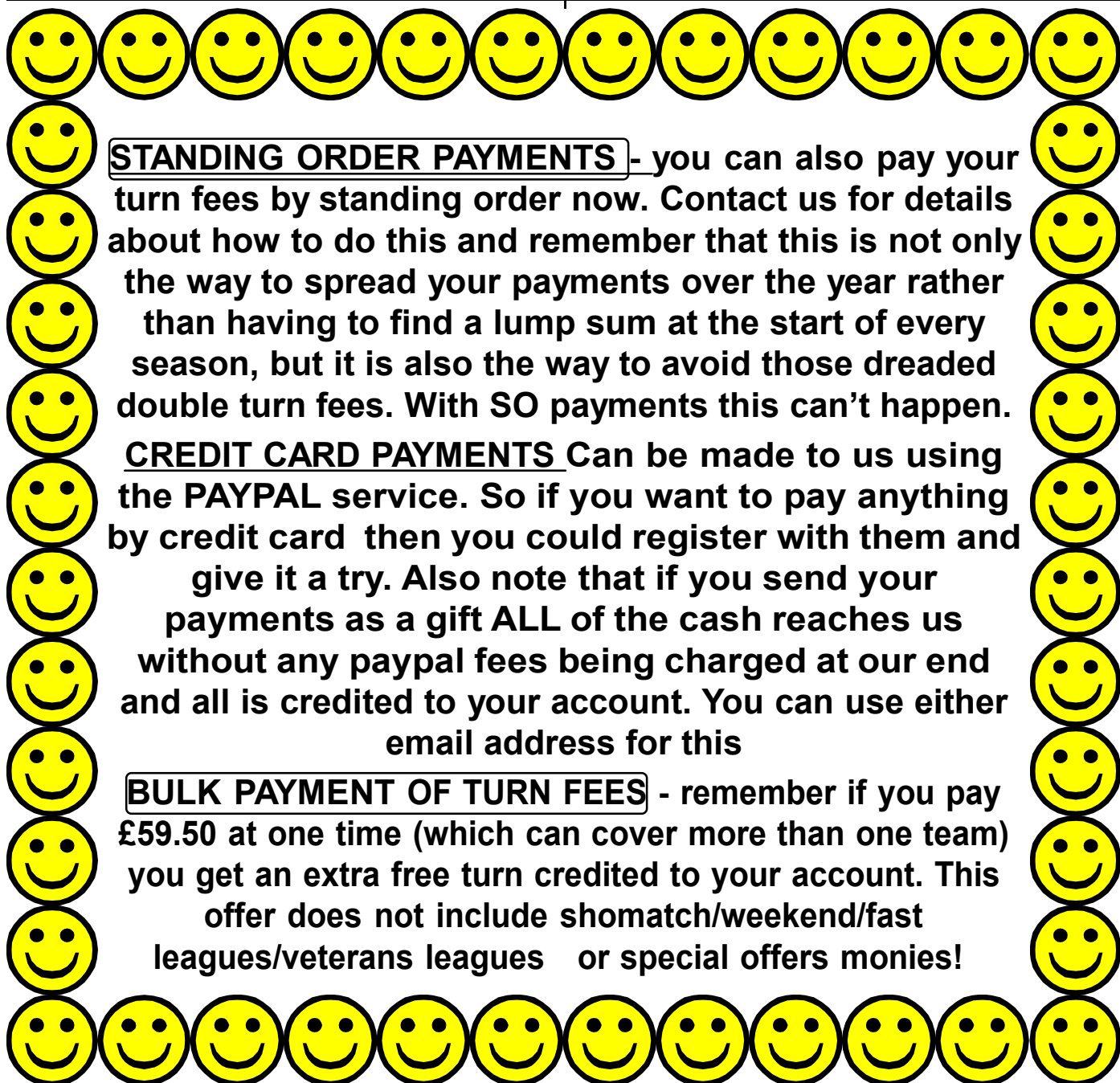

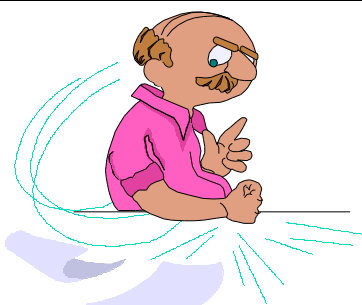

One thing to note about subscribing to the list, we post a regular schedule of where every league is in the processing schedule, when it is sent out, when the latest return-by-date is. This is of great help and if you have email you should really be receiving this.

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb
