Isle of Doom roar into top four as Baboon Foxes slump deeper into trouble

Baboon Foxes 1-3 Isle of Doom

Isle of Doom finally turned promising performances into a much-needed first win of the campaign, coming from behind to beat **Baboon Foxes** 3-1 and climb to 4th place with five points from a possible nine. For Baboon Foxes, meanwhile, this was another afternoon of frustration. After taking an early lead, they collapsed badly and now sit 9th in Division One with just a single point, second bottom and already looking over their shoulders. Baboon started brightly and looked dangerous going forward, with their heavily stacked frontline causing problems from the opening whistle. Their early pressure paid off in just the 9th minute, when Kos Ta Blanca struck first with a sharp snap shot to send the home crowd into delirium. At that stage it looked as though Baboon's attacking gamble might finally deliver, with creative sparks flying everywhere through Kyrialkov, Suker, Kyle Reese, and Kos Ta Blanca. On paper they generated a huge volume of attacking opportunities, but crucially lacked the cutting edge to truly punish Isle of Doom. That wastefulness would come back to haunt them. Despite seeing less of the attacking territory, Isle of Doom were calm, clinical and far more ruthless when chances came. The turning point arrived just after half-time in a devastating two-minute spell. First, defender Sos Help bundled home from a chaotic goalmouth scramble in the 48th minute to level matters at 1-1. Before Baboon had even reset, Isle of Doom struck again a minute later when Scora reacted quickest to poke home and complete the turnaround. Baboon were suddenly shell-shocked. Their confidence evaporated and Isle of Doom smelled blood. On 67 minutes, the visitors delivered the killer blow as Tos Ser timed his run perfectly to latch onto a defence-splitting pass before finishing coolly beyond Pampagna. From there, Isle of Doom controlled proceedings professionally. A major factor was the outstanding display of goalkeeper Robert Wadlow, who posted a superb 90% performance rating and repeatedly frustrated Baboon's previously dangerous attack. With Baboon firing plenty of shots but finding no way through, Wadlow was effectively the difference between a tense finish and a comfortable away win. In midfield, Drake once again underlined his growing importance with another commanding display, earning a perfect 10 rating and helping Isle of Doom weather Baboon's pressure before taking over the contest. For Baboon Foxes, it was a familiar story: lots of attacking ideas, not enough end product, and defensive lapses at the worst possible moments. They have now taken just one point from three games and their early optimism is rapidly fading. However, Jondahl spends big in the auction and signs Peter Brooks who brings a wealth of ability and fans too.

Hobo Central hit five to go top as Hargraves' Hebrides sink deeper into crisis

Hobo Central 5-0 Hebrides

Hobo Central surged to the top of Division Two with an emphatic 5-0 dismantling of struggling **Hebrides**, whose miserable start to the campaign continued as they remain rooted to the foot of the table with zero points and a dreadful -10 goal difference. For Hobo Central, this was a statement win. Clinical, relentless and utterly dominant, they now sit proudly on seven points from three matches, setting the early pace in the promotion race. For Hebrides and manager Hargraves, however, the outlook is increasingly bleak. Recently joining the Asbfar Ultras, Hargraves will surely be hoping some of that famed passion and noise can somehow inspire a turnaround, because right now his side look completely overwhelmed at this level. Hobo Central were on the front foot immediately, their aggressive forward-heavy setup overwhelming Hebrides' zonal defensive structure. The breakthrough came after just four minutes, when the unstoppable Miles Dyson turned smartly on the edge of the box before firing home from outside the area. That early goal opened the floodgates. Hebrides were barely able to string attacks together, generating virtually nothing of note across the match. Their two-man frontline was isolated, their midfield overrun, and their zonal setup looked increasingly fragile under pressure. Dyson doubled the lead in the 43rd minute, glancing in a near-post cross with a trademark striker's finish to send Hobo into the break fully in command at 2-0. If there was any faint hope of a Hebrides response, it evaporated after the interval. Dyson completed his hat-trick in the 66th minute, pouncing amid a chaotic goalmouth scramble, before adding a fourth nine minutes later with another poacher's finish from close range after flicking in a cross. By this point, it had become a personal exhibition. Not content with four goals, Hobo added a fifth on 78 minutes through Big Bob, who finished a slick quick one-two move to cap off a miserable afternoon

for the visitors. To Hebrides' credit, goalkeeper SOS Shite somehow emerged with a perfect 10 rating and an astonishing 81% performance, which frankly tells the whole story: without him, the scoreline could have resembled a cricket total. Hobo registered overwhelming attacking numbers, creating 28 forward chances and completely suffocating Hebrides, who finished with essentially zero attacking output of any consequence.

As usual division two is tight and all the other sides draw their games. **Isla Teja** drop to second with a 0-0 bore draw with **Anatra City** who have now drawn all three of their opening games. **Midnight Wolves** and **FC Westeros** also fail to find the net and share the spoils. **Phonetic FC** and **Guybrush Threep** draw 1-1 in a bad tempered derby. Alderaan levels with a minute of the game left as **South Sea Rover** deny **Panglao** their first win under the management of Canvin.

Barbary Coast stay perfect as Presland's men make it three from three

Manager Presland's Barbary Coast are quickly becoming Division Three's early pace-setters after grinding out a disciplined 2-0 away win over **Paroot Habashan** to remain unbeaten with three wins from three. This was not a flowing attacking masterclass from Barbary Coast, but it was the kind of mature, controlled display title-chasing sides often need. Despite Paroot actually generating more raw defensive pressure and shots on paper, Barbary Coast were simply far more clinical and composed in key moments. The visitors struck first midway through the opening half when defender Silver arrived at the far post to convert on 33 minutes, finishing off a well-worked move to give Presland's side a deserved lead. Their opener was aided by a slice of fortune too, with Flatiron turning the ball into his own net on 25 minutes to put Barbary Coast ahead before Silver doubled the advantage. At the other end, goalkeeper Gibbon was immense, delivering a 100%

magnificent performance and completely shutting the door despite Paroot creating dangerous situations through Sottofillet and Pad Thai, both of whom earned featured shots. Gibbon's clean sheet was arguably the platform for the whole result. Paroot will feel frustrated. They had opportunities, especially from defensive territory, and their midfield pairing of Lomo and Pad Thai both performed strongly. But they lacked cutting edge in the final third, with only one modified forward shot surviving the calculations by full time. Their structure generated pressure, but almost none of it translated into meaningful finishing. For Barbary Coast, this was another example of balance over brilliance. Their back line stayed organised, Silver not only scored but a strong over all display, while captain Lombata quietly kept the midfield ticking over. Even without huge attacking numbers from Ros Samson and Doubloon, they got the job done.

Showaddywaddy continue their decent start and hold out for a point at **Real Anatra** and sit second with Real in third. **Hookers Alley** get a decent point at **Ofah United** as their new signings bed in. **Chang Seuk FC** get off the mark with TAO scoring the all important goal at early strugglers **Tiggaki Redux**. **Dynamo Mario** also register their first points with Ogogi scoring a scorcher to condemn **Burbage Moors** to bottom place.

Decided to add a League Cup to the schedule for next season.

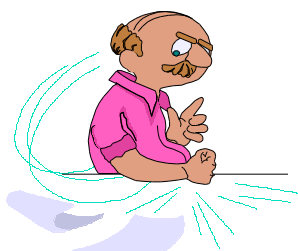
It will start on Session 2, and continues on S5/7/10/12

MARKING UPDATE



We have worked out a system to check on anybody who is using last season's marking numbers for the current season. Basically the program will save a list of all valid marking successes each session and if somebody cries foul, that he has been marked by somebody who hasn't scouted him, we can check and say yea or nay.

So from now onwards if you use last season's numbers then you will be found out AND if guilty the result of the game will either be reversed or decided against you.

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb
