Currently sitting at the top of the league are **Saints**, a side that for a number of years has often been the bridesmaid and not the bride but is this finally their year? Unbeaten so far, this side looks like it might finally come good on their promises. A few players have already starred this season for them which bodes well for next year as there is not an awful lot of money to spend and there are a couple of youngsters coming through but an awful lot is going to depend on GEMILL's fitness to see what kind of success they may garner next year I feel.

Second and still in with a good shout at taking the title, we have **Daggers** who have done really well this year also. Darker clouds ahead possibly for BARRETT next year as ageing could hit him quite badly and there's not an awful lot in the pipeline currently. On the bright side a few players have starred, FREARS amongst them and there is some cash available for replacements. The rejuvenation of LITVENENKO is going to be the pivotal factor here I think.

Third place is currently occupied by **Sunderland FTM** who have had an absolutely unbelievable last few years and are continuing that trend into this year. Manager HUMPHRIES has built a small but very talented squad with a couple of stars in it but unfortunately for him, not the right players and this could be a concern for the future especially as funds are low as well and this season could be their zenith but you can't write this man off so wait and see is definitely the watchword here.

Sprout on paper should actually be doing better than they currently are and although not the force they have been in previous seasons manager OVERLI seems to be building a side that once more will be feared and although they are 10 points off the lead at the moment, I feel they may be capable of closing that gap in the second half of the season. Wages at the club are excellent, there is cash to spend if needed but a few more stars would be a welcome boost here, especially to the older players as there is not a hell of a lot of youth coming through the ranks.

Top of the "mid-tablers" are **Paradisio** managed by the legend that is KP. A more than half-decent side, they definitely deserve to be where they are at the moment if not perhaps a

little further up the table. Wages are currently of some concern here but that aside things are looking good, cash in the bank and main man PELE MUGABE has starred. One or two more visits from the star fairy wouldn't go amiss though but overall KP should be happy with the way things are going.

Immortals FC are in 6th and the squad is taking shape nicely here as they seem to be finally fulfilling their potential. Wages are good and most players are approaching optimum performance levels although there's still a little bit further to go. No stars as yet and not much in the way of youth coming through so a visit from the star fairy is going to be high on manager THOMPSON's wish list but there is some cash available to spend.

Wycombe are in 7th and are, I feel, slightly under-achieving at the moment. READ has built a good squad but one that seems to be stuttering a little for some reason. Youngster LLORIS is starting to come through and CALRISSAN is almost the finished product with a couple of other youngsters who are possibilities but are a long way off as yet. He does have cash to spend either this season or maybe next as the star fairy has been a bit stingy with him so far and it may be needed to buy replacements next year.

City Boyz come next in 8th and have done well this year to be on course to avoid the drop after last season's promotion to the top flight. Definitely needs a further visit from the star fairy if they are hoping for a good season next year but their youth system has produced a little gem and they need to get him up and running in preparation for next season also loads of cash to spend and if divested wisely they should be in good shape not only to avoid relegation this year but to remain competitive next year as well.

Ninth, and flirting dangerously with relegation are **Trujillo**. Really should be doing better than where they are at the moment and the reason for this is the lack of any sort of goalkeeper. They have youngster SANBUCH coming through but he is nowhere near ready and running a deficit, they are not really in a position to buy anyone in so it's a few more sessions of misery for **Trujillo** at the very least. Goalkeeper woes and cash deficit aside, the squad is looking OK although DUCHOV needs to get over his injury asap if they are to have any chance of avoiding the drop.

Tenth and in the relegation zone are **Toto Albini** and I am struggling a little to understand why as they are at least as good as a number of teams currently above them. Arguably unlucky to have had 2 draws this session, performance levels are still well below par but these results do show they are capable of competing and if manager SMITH can string a few wins together in the second half of the season, I fancy them to survive. Wages are good, there is cash to spend, more youth should be a priority and a few victories in the coming weeks wouldn't go amiss.

In 11th place is another side that on paper at least shouldn't perhaps be in this position. A decent squad with a very talented and experienced manager at the helm, I can only surmise that the beer is finally getting to ASHCROFT! Elsewhere he has everything under control; tight wages, oodles of cash to spend but results just don't seem to be going his way and while certainly not world-beaters I don't think this side should be in the position they currently find themselves in. There is still work to do in the squad and some more youth wouldn't go amiss.

Without a doubt the weakest squad in the division, **AS Centurions** currently occupy the bottom spot but manager READ is starting to weave his dark magic and has already amassed a fairly impressive war chest. Not much quality in the squad but a couple of key players have already starred and there are some signs of youth starting to come through. Still very much a work in progress and will continue to be for some time I think but there is a plan and you can see that plan starting to take shape albeit slowly.

The three newly-promoted teams from last season all look to emulate the feat again this season as they all currently occupy the promotion places.

The squad is in great shape and MCAULEY is bringing through a number of youngsters which he will need to do as lack of funds at the club means no big purchases for a while yet methinks.

Burnden Villa are the third side in the promotion places hot off their successes of last season and looking good to continue that this season. HAILS has a good squad at his disposal and the right players have starred for him so far. Not a great deal in the way of youth coming through tied in with a lack of funds may be a cause of worry for next year. Wages are also far too high and it may be these economic factors more than anything else which drag the club down next year if not sorted sharp-ish.

Some youth coming through with ACHTUNG ready to claim a regular spot in the side and if a couple of the right players star this season they should be looking good.

Sofia currently lie in 5th place and are currently un-managed which is a shame because the squad is looking pretty good and with a manager at the helm could be a tidy side. Even with being un-managed, wages are currently OK, not lots of cash to splash but they have a couple of stars and even a youth player coming through.

Aqua Sulis are in 6th and Manager STEVENS has a pretty good squad in the making here. Surprisingly, the club is in credit and again just as surprisingly are struggling at the moment to score goals, a fact not often associated with a side managed by STEVENS and that is probably the main cause of them sitting mid-table as they are better than their current placing suggests. Quite a lot of youngsters already brought up to speed and commanding regular places and if a couple of key players would star then the future would be looking pretty good.

In 7th are **Hawtonville** with a solid squad. Should avoid relegation this year and end up comfortably mid-table but there is some work that needs to be done if they are to progress including trimming the wage bill which is a tad high.

Inter Walls currently find themselves in 8th and manager **SAMSON** will definitely feel his side are under-achieving so far this season. Definitely need to strengthen their defence urgently as they are conceding far too many goals and a few more scored upfront wouldn't go amiss either! That aside, the squad is looking good overall and wages are under control but will need a few players to star before season's end as there is a lack of developing youngsters coming through. They should be comfortable this season and I don't see them being dragged in to the relegation battle.

Botafogo are occupying 9th in the division which is probably about right. Manager **STEADMAN** to his credit has managed to steady the ship somewhat and they have an absolute pearler in the shape of **BENAYOUN** coming through but training him up to the exclusion of other youngsters may cause some issues although there is cash to spend so the manager does have some options. Wages aren't too bad and a few players have starred all in all things are looking pretty good here.

Borussia Wigan are 11th in the division and still very much a work in progress and I just cannot see them avoiding the drop this year. is the core of a decent squad here which, if correctly handled may give them some hope for next year but with no manager the only direction they are going to continue to go are down

Ninth and dangerously close to the drop zone are **New Caledonia** who are also unmanaged. Not many positives here at the moment and the lack of a guiding hand at the club is plain to see and it just looks like pain and misery is the forecast here for the foreseeable future.

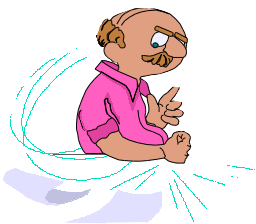

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb

MANAGERS NEEDED

We have some teams that badly need a guiding hand on the tiller so to speak. Something to keep you busy during the summer and when your footie interest is piqued by the world cup.

All come with a season's free credit and to wet your avaricious appetites if you send cash for ONE other team at the same time we'll double it. (any one other team that you run, can't be bad can it soldiers!



CLOUGH LEAGUE -- **RED STAR UNITED**. First division stalwarts get in near the top with this team. Something to build up from?

PREMIER LEAGUE - **DARLINGTON** - First division outfit, not challengers but they do have nearly seven million in the bank to spend. Different kind of league Can you pilot them to the Champions Trophy and beat Real Madrid.

ROBSON LEAGUE - with the demise of KP, he has left two teams in this league vacant.

SMITH ATHLETIC are near the bottom of the third but have eight plus mill in the bank but

LEEDS UNI are in line for division three promotion and have twelve mill plus in the bank, this is surely a side to whet the appetites?

Palace Rule what?



STARTING OUT TIPS

If you are lucky you may have a couple of million in the Bank but that won't be enough to turn things around in a couple of sessions. You need to be committed to be in this for the long haul.

?Have a plan. Base your coaching on getting 2 SPS per session. If you get a few more along the way as the season progresses then great either cash them or coach an extra youth player. Aim to coach your APP's & SBY's to level 12's by seasons end. Better to have 3 17/18 yr old level 12's than 5 level 8's.

?Clear out the 24-4's etc. to get them off the wage bill as they will be on relatively high wages. Either sell them to other managers at below NL price (you will still benefit vs selling to NL due to wages). If you can't get a buyer then hold on to them and run their contract down before selling to NL by session 10 - sales to NL go to half price after that.

?Play 2 APPS or a SBY every game unless you have a realistic chance of winning but try to win your derby games. Keep your MP's for derby games, matches against fellow strugglers and for (hopefully) a bit of a run in the Bowl.

?Build up your cash balance. Keep building this until you have at least circa £8m. Try to pick up bargains (below NL value) from the auction so you can then sell them on at a profit.

?Invest money in youth. Don't rely on this producing multiple MF specialists, unless your name is Morten. What you will hopefully get is a few FUT's which you can coach at 0.5 SP per level or sell for cash. This is a good way of increasing your teams' skill level quickly.

?Choose a category for the team and aim to get all the players of the same category (P, S or P/S). Having a power team is easier to build up quickly as there are more of them, there are plenty of 95 BW's around and are cheap to buy. However, longer term you will need to change the category of them team as power teams don't become super teams.

?If you have players that don't match your chosen category look to trade them for another player who is. It is rare your team will be full of P/S players so if you have any it may be best to move them on to build up your cash balance or trade for another player.

?Look to get a good quality GK and SW. You may not win many matches but two level 12's at the back could bring in some extra SP's through 0-0 draws.

?Don't coach anyone over the age of 18 unless there is a really good reason to do so e.g. 23-10 MF specialist.

?You need a captain so you can afford one player over the age of 19 _ hopefully your captain will star or get rejuvenated.

?Within 2 seasons you should have a team full of level 12's and a decent cash balance as a solid platform to start your ascent to being the next KA super team.
