SCAYNES HILL have a very good, though overlarge, squad that's P/S and he already has 6 stars including his captain, and with some youth being trained, they should also be strong next season too. There isn't much cash on hand for any improvements and the wages are a little high, but they have a well funded academy, as well as a sold out stadium every week. **INCIPIENT UTD** are Scaynes nearest challengers, albeit 6 points adrift, as usual manager Macauley has a very good squad with 4 players having starred, but they could do with maybe 1 more. They do have a couple of decent youngsters, a well funded academy and the best wage structure in the league, as well as cash in the bank? will they stay second, only time will tell. **REEBOK WANDERS** have a strong squad but could do with star status hitting the right players, they do have 2 stars already as well as some very good young players already around the team, and have just bought Riva to add to them. They are a P/S team with plenty of cash on hand, with a very well funded academy system, although that wages might have to come down a bit.

GILLINGHAM FC are unbeaten so far but they have drawn half of their games so they need to find a way to turn draws into wins. They have a mixture of young and old players in their squad but are yet to receive a visit from the star fairy which needs to change. They have cash available should the manager need it (like for ground extensions perhaps), their academy is well funded and they don't overpay on the wage front. **WESTHILL AFC** have a very good team that's also P/S, they are beginning to show their age though but at least they have 2 stars including new signing Brooks, problem is that they only have 1 youngster to coach. Even after spending over 3 million, they still have money in the kitty for any additional additions and plenty invested in their academy but they might want to reduce their wages a touch. **EXCALIBUR FC** have a good squad, though it is starting to age but the manager will be happy to have signed up 4 players for next season, including their captain. There is some youth in the squad but they have a long way to go before they are ready to play, so

they need the academy to start supplying them some players. They have cash to spend if required, but would have more if they lowered the wage bill.

R.S.RAIDERS, like the teams below them, have plenty of work to do to ensure they don't get dragged into the relegation places. On a positive note, they don't concede many, but equally they don't score many either leading to too many draws. Scottie does have a decent side but they're yet to get a star which 'may' be an issue, especially as the academy has only produced 1 player that's currently being trained. As with many teams, the wage bill needs to come down, especially as the Raiders bank balance is almost at a Stevens-like level. **WEXFORD WRAITHS** with the team Dag has, he really should be higher than 8th, the Wraiths have 3 stars but as yet the star fairy has avoided the players he wants/needs. They are slightly in debt which restricts their activities both in the auction as well as investing in their academy, then again it has only supplied 1 player to the manager so far. **COMEDY GENUS FC** seem to be suffering second season syndrome, but their manager is hoping he can survive. They do have a decent squad, with 4 stars including their captain, there is something to build on, there are a couple of youngsters coming through and will be ready for next season. They need to raise cash if they want to spend, but they have apps they can sell, the wages need addressing as does the lack of youth investment.

LAIZY TOWN the Doc does have a solid core of good players with one of them having starred, the academy has supplied the team with a couple of players but only Gundersen is ready to play. The youth investment has supplied City with a generation talent that can lead the team for decades. The manager does have cash in the bank although the wages they are paying out for Yksi are really putting a drain on that balance, they currently have the worst wage bill in the league. **SOUTH YORKS WAN** KP has built a decent team, but they some older players, including their captain though he's one of 2 players that have starred. The academy has provided the manager with a couple of starlets that are being coached but should they need to buy reinforcements, they cash there to buy them. **METROPOLE IF** may be bottom, but they have put together a very youthful as well as a pretty talented squad which does all the running for the 2 experienced players so if they do get relegated, they will be in a great position to come



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straight back up. Manager Hudson has money to use if he wants, though some of that could go towards expanding the stadium, and some of that cash could be raised by being more frugal with their wages.

LIVERPOOL STARS have built a very good team, that is also young so they should be quite strong next season too but they only have 1 star at present and would like 1 or 2 more. Manager King has cash in the bank ready for next season, they also have a good academy that has supplied a couple of players for the manager to train they would like to lower their wages a little though. **TRENT VALE FC** young Jack has a very good team at his disposal with 2 excellent stars, they have a lot of creativity in it and that is a good reason for them being second, with a clear gap to Bo in 4th. They really do need some youth coming through as their academy has given them nothing so far this season so far, despite good funding, their wage bill really needs addressing as it's too big but they do have good cash in the bank. **REAL KICKAVEG** Spud has put together a very useful team, it has 3 stars including their captain and has some decent youngsters in and around the team and another excellent youngster being coached. They invest heavily in their youth academy, which has proved to be fruitful, a good wage structure and have money in the bank to improve further, but they do need to increase their capacity.

ARTOF NOISE FC with the team Big Bad Bo has, and I've said it before, they really should be higher in the table, they have 3 stars, including their captain and once Quito hits top form I expect them to get promoted. They are being hampered by drawing too many games and picking up too many DP's, their academy may not be well funded, but they already have 3 excellent youngsters in the team, then if they need it, there's also money in the bank for BBB. **ROXLEY FOXES** are still the home of the FWS, they have 2 good stars but they do have some youth coming through, including a replacement for Southall who's getting close to retirement. They don't have much of an academy but they do have a fair

bit of cash to use for whatever takes his fancy but he might want to lower his wage bill first. **ROYAL ASTON** are a bummer of a team to play, hard tackling with players that can mark opponents out of the game but their solid squad only sports 1 star and that could prove to be a problem especially as the cupboard is pretty bare on the youth front which is strange as they have a well funded academy though they do have cash in the bank.

SOLARIS SAINTS have a good squad but it only has 1 star at the moment and they really need it to hit important players as their squad is getting on a bit. There's plenty of cash invested in youth but at the moment only Ronnie has come through for the manager to coach and if that isn't enough they have money in the bank for improvements.

ROSINBORG FC do have some very good players led by Sleepy Jo, but he's coming close to retirement, and with 1 star on an ordinary player, next season could be a little trickier. They need to focus their efforts on players they intend to keep and use, they have 2 youngsters that are being coached but a long way from being ready. They have money in the bank to improve their team/squad, they also have a well funded youth system but it needs to supply the manager with players to coach. **MIDNIGHT HEROES** will be hoping to get back to old glories, but that certainly won't happen this season with the club sitting just 4 points outside the bottom 3. They haven't got a very big squad but at least their captain has starred, and with their other players not being very old, I expect the Heroes to be fighting for promotion next season. Like others, they have a very good academy that has already given Engslav 3 players that can be used in the match day squad but if that's not enough, they have cash available in the bank.

Despite a very good academy, it has only supplied the manager with young Elizabeth but thanks to those stars they shouldn't age too badly, Hails does have the wages under control as well as cash in the bank should he need to use it. **FC GARVOCK** may be in the relegation zone but that doesn't mean they have a terrible team, they have some excellent players including a most useful star. There are some generational talents hidden in their squad, but it won't be until next season when they come



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to fruition and the squad is quite young which will help them next season. They are in credit but one of their players wages are really putting a drain on that balance, but that should improve by season's end. **GONDOR CITY** have had a really rough season, they are under caretaker management now so things may get better, though it's too late to save them this season. They have quite a weak squad, though do have 3 excellent midfielders to try to mitigate any damage but what they don't have is a youth policy as only Nickel has come through the system and he's far from ready. What they do have is a bank balance that can help them on this score, whether it's this season or next.

The one issue I see is that they don't have much of a youth policy on show, the academy certainly hasn't received much in the form of investment which may bite them in the arse next season especially as there isn't much available for purchases in the bank. **TOLPUDDLE** have put together an excellent team, they have 2 stars so far and their squad has some very good youngsters, with another couple begin coached up. They have a well funded academy, one of the best wage bills in the league and cash available for them next season if required. **AFC KARORI** have a strong team, that has some of the best youngsters in the country, in that team is only 1 star but it happens to be their captain. Manager Mansell has a magnificent academy with 2 players already in the team, as well as 2 others that are slowly being coached for the future, and they have added a young sweeper to the squad, just a shame he's on such a huge wage. There's not much cash in the bank, as said before the wage bill is high and they really do need to increase their stadium.

Burbage haven't

invested much in their academy, but they at least have their wages under control as well as plenty of money in the bank. **A.S.WORG** need to stay in division 3 so they can rebuild properly next season, some of their players are getting old so getting more than the 1 star they currently have would be nice. Daffyd's replacement is ready to be trained and with a couple of youngsters coming through, then next season could be good for them. They ARE actually in credit, but only just, though they do have some players they can sell to raise more capital for the manager, but at least he has wages under control. **GALWAY LOFTUS**'s management need to get a hold of the coaching now, as they have some youth they have to coach including their new winger. Only have 1 star at present, but could do with their captain signing up for next season, they have cash available for next season should they want to strengthen, good thing is that they at least have their wages under control.

The academy has produced a couple of interesting prospects but it might be an idea to cash in on 1 or maybe both of them so they could raise cash for any future purchases and they could also do with lowering their wage bill a little. **PORT NOIR UTD** have an OK team that needs to decide whether to be skill or power, with none of their players being anything special but they do have some creativity in the squad, with one of those players being a star. The Southend based Picasso has cash at his disposal, money invested in youth and a decent wage bill, so next season could well be better.

The star fairy has been conspicuous by her absence so far but there's plenty of time for that to change.



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The manager has money to use if he wants though he does need to sell those he cannot coach by the end of the season and the wage bill needs addressing too. **BANKS ALLSTARS** if Buckkeep don't have much of a team, then Banks are really bugged. Jeorgie Bast is trying his hardest but there's only so much 1 man can do, especially when they are weaker than all of division 2, at least things will improve slightly when the schoolboy is coached. Next season could be interesting, especially if Hails decides to start using the warchest he has at his disposal.

They are just over 500k in debt so they might need to start pruning their squad a bit, but at least their wages are OK. **THE CONSORTIUM** have a pretty sparse squad but it does have a decent mix of youth and experience, ably led by captain Kropotkin, but they need to avoid injuries

or suspensions because of that fact. They are only slightly overdrawn so no real problems there, added to that fact is one of the best wage bills in the league, good job really as there's no youth policy.

While the bank balance can improve, wages are no problem so that's something.

Wages are 2nd highest in the league but this is purely down to Sementish's obscene wages, but on the flip side, captain Huevo is on a blinding wage, good job too as there's nothing in the coffers.

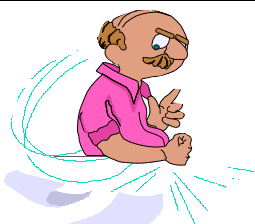

CONTRACTS UPDATE

So from now onwards if your prized player is on the last week of his contract

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

Then there is a wage that if offered he will ALWAYS accept.

This has to be calculated by you (Oh shite!!)

The formula is as follows :

3 X basic wage where the basic wage = player level X PS Bonus X Div Bonus X POS Bonus X Type bonus

player level is obvious

P/S bonus increase the basic wage by 20%

Div Bonus - 125% for div 1/ 110% for div2 / 100% for divs 3/ 75% for div 4

Pos bonus refers to STARS/FUT/SBY which require 50% uplift

Type bonus is equal to the players expected wage rates , ie MF/A/D x3 - **Df/A X 2 / UT/WG/FWS x1.5** / GK SW X 2/ FW/MF/DF X 1

AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

as an example a DIV ONE 20/12 PS MF/A/D STAR would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage (81K) X 3 to accept unconditionally , i.e. 243K+ per week

or a 20-10 DIV THREE S DF/A would require a wage offer of **OVER** basic wage(20K) X 3, i.e. 60K+

On the last week of the contract there is no optimum length of contract though we suggest you opt for four weeks so you have time to bid again

I REPEAT - AND THIS ONLY RELATES TO THE LAST WEEK OF HIS CONTRACT PLEASE NOTE

One last change to note as well. In future at whatever stage of the contract negotiation you are at with a player, the min he will now accept is one third+ of his basic wage

so in the MF/A/D example a bid under 27K+ will be rejected, the DF/A minimum is 6.66K+

NOTE THIS WELL ALSO

In the calculations above where it refers to WAGES, this also refers to wages + any experience the player as. This means that you are NOT ever sure about the calculation. Not that important for a normal player who does not have an * by his name, but where specialists are involved it can be important. So we suggest that when offering a contract to a player who is a specialist or has an * by his name, you add something extra to the calculation. I would say 5k is a good rule of thumb

MANAGERS NEEDED

We have some teams that badly need a guiding hand on the tiller so to speak. Something to keep you busy during the summer and when your footie interest is piqued by the world cup.

All come with a season's free credit and to wet your avaricious appetites if you send cash for ONE other team at the same time we'll double it. (any one other team that you run, can't be bad can it soldiers!



PREMIER LEAGUE - **DARLINGTON** - First division outfit, not challengers but they do have nearly seven million in the bank to spend. Different kind of league Can you pilot them to the Champions Trophy and beat Real Madrid_

ROBSON LEAGUE - with the demise of KP, he has left two teams in this league vacant.

SMITH ATHLETIC are near the bottom of the third but have eight plus mill in the bank but

LEEDS UNI - are in line for division three promotion and have twelve mill plus in the bank, this is surely a side to whet the appetites?

STARTING OUT TIPS

If you are lucky you may have a couple of million in the Bank but that won't be enough to turn things around in a couple of sessions. You need to be committed to be in this for the long haul.

?Have a plan. Base your coaching on getting 2 SPS per session. If you get a few more along the way as the season progresses then great either cash them or coach an extra youth player. Aim to coach your APP's & SBY's to level 12's by seasons end. Better to have 3 17/18 yr old level 12's than 5 level 8's.

?Clear out the 24-4's etc. to get them off the wage bill as they will be on relatively high wages. Either sell them to other managers at below NL price (you will still benefit vs selling to NL due to wages). If you can't get a buyer then hold on to them and run their contract down before selling to NL by session 10 - sales to NL go to half price after that.

?Play 2 APPS or a SBY every game unless you have a realistic chance of winning but try to win your derby games. Keep your MP's for derby games, matches against fellow strugglers and for (hopefully) a bit of a run in the Bowl.

?Build up your cash balance. Keep building this until you have at least circa £8m. Try to pick up bargains (below NL value) from the auction so you can then sell them on at a profit.

?Invest money in youth. Don't rely on this producing multiple MF specialists, unless your name is Morten. What you will hopefully get is a few FUT's which you can coach at 0.5 SP per level or sell for cash. This is a good way of increasing your teams' skill level quickly.

?Choose a category for the team and aim to get all the players of the same category (P, S or P/S). Having a power team is easier to build up quickly as there are more of them, there are plenty of 95 BW's around and are cheap to buy. However, longer term you will need to change the category of them team as power teams don't become super teams.

?If you have players that don't match your chosen category look to trade them for another player who is. It is rare your team will be full of P/S players so if you have any it may be best to move them on to build up your cash balance or trade for another player.

?Look to get a good quality GK and SW. You may not win many matches but two level 12's at the back could bring in some extra SP's through 0-0 draws.

?Don't coach anyone over the age of 18 unless there is a really good reason to do so e.g. 23-10 MF specialist.

?You need a captain so you can afford one player over the age of 19 _ hopefully your captain will star or get rejuvenated.

?Within 2 seasons you should have a team full of level 12's and a decent cash balance as a solid platform to start your ascent to being the next KA super team.
